

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SEASON TO PLANT



How open are we to hear the voice of our heavenly Father? What is the state of our heart? The parable of the seed and the good soil gives us an excellent meditation about how we receive the Word of God and how much it gives fruits of holiness in us. Let us review the types of soil and compare them with the receptiveness of our hearts to hear the Word of God. The seed, the Word of God, is the same for all of us.

The first type of soil (heart): "The seed sown on the path is the one who hears the word of the kingdom without understanding it, and the evil one comes and steals away what was sown in his heart" (Matt 13:19). This seed fell on dry soil, like dry clay, and it was impossible for it to grow;

people who have goodwill but never do good deeds. The Word of God has arrived in their ears, but they do not want to accept it as a way of life. They can quote the Word of God as part of the conversation, but it is not important to them.

The second type of soil: "The seed sown on rocky ground is the one who hears the word and receives it at once with joy. But he has no root and lasts only for a time. When some tribulation or persecution comes because of the word, he immediately falls away" (Matt 13:20-21). This seed fell on rocks with cracks and not too much soil. Those who are enthusiastic about a project or ministry in the Church but are not constant and fast get discouraged, and any problem or circumstance makes them stop and settle for just good memories of that moment in their lives.

The third type of soil: "The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word, but then worldly anxiety and the lure of riches choke the word, and it bears no fruit" (Matt 13:22).

Those who know very well that the Word of God is the fount of wisdom and light for life, but while knowing the love of God, their duties and the busy world cause them to neglect it. The time for prayer or reading the Bible is too short or inexistent. God is not a priority for them, and his word is not always the candle that illuminates their lives.

The fourth type of soil: "...the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold" (Matt 13:23). This group of people who live their faith as a priority, God is first in all their projects, they spend good time in prayer, and the Word of God is the primary source that can transform their lives and with their testimony help others to know God and to enjoy the goodness of the Lord. For as simple as a dream could be, they always place it into the hands of God.

What kind of soil and heart do we have? Great questions for this week.



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SAINT OF THE WEEK: MARY MAGDALENE



Except for the mother of Jesus, few women are more honored in the Bible than Mary Magdalene. Yet, she could well be the patron of the slandered since there has been a persistent legend in the Church that she is the unnamed sinful woman who anointed the feet of Jesus in Luke 7:36-50.

Most Scripture scholars today point out that there is no scriptural basis for confusing the two women. Mary Magdalene, that is, "of Magdala," was the one from whom Christ cast out "seven demons" (Luke 8:2)—an indication at the worst of extreme demonic possession or, possibly, severe illness.

Writing in the New Catholic Commentary, Fr. Wilfrid J. Harrington, O.P., says that "seven demons" "does not mean that Mary had lived an immoral life—a conclusion reached only by a mistaken identification with the anonymous woman of Luke 7:36." In the Jerome Biblical Commentary, Fr. Edward Mally, S.J., agrees that she "is not...the same as the sinner of Luke 7:37, despite the later Western romantic tradition about her."

Mary Magdalene was one of the many "who were assisting them [Jesus and the Twelve] out of their means." She was one of those who stood by the cross of Jesus with his mother. And, of all the "official" witnesses who might have been chosen for the first awareness of the Resurrection, she was the one to whom that privilege was given. She is known as the "Apostle to the Apostles."

Reflection: Mary Magdalene has been a victim of mistaken identity for almost 20 centuries. Yet, she would no doubt insist that it makes no difference. We are all sinners in need of the saving power of God, whether our sins have been lurid or not. More importantly, we are all "unofficial" witnesses of the Resurrection.

PACK THE CHAPEL (EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL)

FR. MATT SCHMITZ — JULY 5, 2023

One of the things that I love about priestly ministry during the summer months is the opportunity to watch our youth grow at the various summer camps offered throughout my Diocese of Crookston.

The summer of 2022 saw the second year of the St. Teresa of Calcutta camp for our ninth and tenth graders. The camp opened at St. Philip's in Bemidji with the Mass for Corpus Christi and the Year of Diocesan Revival kickoff for the Eucharistic Revival in the United States, along with our own diocesan celebration. Following the Mass, a Eucharistic procession took place along one of the main streets in Bemidji. Many of the campers took part and had roles within the procession (serving, cantoring, holding the canopy, etc.).



A Yearning for the Lord:

The previous year during the camp, there was some good-natured grumbling one night when we announced an earlier wake-up time the following day so we could make it to our service projects on time. I responded in jest by saying, "Well, you could join the seminarians and me for a Holy Hour at 5:30 AM." To my surprise, the kids cheered. (I'll admit that, for a moment, I thought to myself, "Why did I open my mouth?! That's my only quiet time of the day!") The next morning, we had about five kids join us to pray before the tabernacle in the chapel.

For summer 2022, we decided to extend the invitation to the youth every day of the camp. There would be no exposition, and nothing led—just come to the chapel and pray in silence before the tabernacle. The first Monday morning, seven campers joined us. On Tuesday morning, fourteen joined us. I was thrilled when, on Wednesday morning, twenty-five joined us.

On Wednesday evening, one of the campers started a campaign to "pack the chapel" on Thursday morning. I went to bed at 1:30 AM and set an alarm for 4:50 AM. I woke with a start, full of energy, and reached for my phone to check the time. It was 4:50 AM on the dot. My alarm had not gone off. I whispered a silent prayer of gratitude to the Holy Spirit for waking me up and started to get ready for the day. As I was getting ready, I had a sense there would probably be a lot of campers for the Holy Hour this morning, so I decided to go down a little early and set up for adoration. Once I had everything set up, I waited for the campers to arrive.

Over seventy campers and staff (out of eighty-five to ninety) voluntarily came to Jesus that morning and spent an hour of silent prayer before him at 5:30 AM. I believe it was the first fruits of the Eucharistic Revival to be harvested in our diocese!

Eucharistic adoration is available at many parishes across our country. If you've never gone to adoration before, I invite you to stop in for fifteen to twenty minutes. Or stop in during any day of the week and make a short visit to Jesus in the tabernacle. Simply come and speak to him from your heart and then listen, and just be with him.

Repasemos los tipos de suelo y comparémoslos con la receptividad de nuestro corazón para escuchar la Palabra de Dios. La semilla, la Palabra de Dios, es la misma para todos nosotros.

El primer tipo de suelo (corazón): "La semilla sembrada en el camino es el que oye la palabra del reino sin entenderla, y viene el malo y roba lo que fue sembrado en su corazón" (Mateo 13:19). Esta semilla cayó en tierra seca, como arcilla seca, y le fue imposible crecer; personas que tienen

buena voluntad pero nunca hacen buenas obras. La Palabra de Dios ha llegado a sus oídos, pero no la quieren aceptar como forma de vida. Pueden citar la Palabra de Dios como parte de la conversación, pero no es importante para ellos.

El segundo tipo de suelo: "La semilla sembrada en pedregales es el que oye la palabra y al instante la recibe con gozo. Pero él no tiene raíz y dura solo por un tiempo. Cuando viene alguna tribulación o persecución por causa de la palabra, inmediatamente tropieza" (Mateo 13:20-21). Esta semilla cayó sobre rocas con grietas y no demasiada tierra. Quienes se entusiasman con un proyecto o ministerio en la Iglesia pero no son constantes y rápidos, se desaniman, y cualquier problema o circunstancia hace que se detengan y se conformen sólo con buenos recuerdos de ese momento de sus vidas.

El tercer tipo de suelo: "La semilla sembrada entre espinos es el que oye la palabra, pero luego la ansiedad del mundo y el engaño de las riquezas ahogan la palabra, y no lleva fruto" (Mateo 13:22).

Los que saben muy bien que la Palabra de Dios es fuente de sabiduría y luz para la vida, pero conociendo el amor de Dios, sus deberes y el ajetreo del mundo les hacen descuidarla. El tiempo para la oración o la lectura de la Biblia es demasiado corto o inexistente. Dios no es una prioridad para ellos, y su palabra no siempre es la vela que ilumina sus vidas.

El cuarto tipo de suelo: "...la semilla sembrada en tierra fértil es el que oye la palabra y la entiende, el que da fruto y rinde al ciento o al sesenta o al treinta por uno" (Mateo 13:23). Este grupo de personas que viven su fe como una prioridad, Dios es primero en todos sus proyectos, pasan un buen tiempo en oración, y la Palabra de Dios es la fuente primaria que puede transformar sus vidas y con su testimonio ayudar a otros a conocer a Dios. y disfrutar de la bondad del Señor. Por más simple que sea un sueño, siempre lo ponen en las manos de Dios.

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
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
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
