FUTURE GLORY



The Lord intended Jesus' invitation to Peter, James, and John to be a powerful and moving experience for them. It helped them to strengthen their faith and understand that the way to glory always needs to pass through passion and suffering. They completely forgot about the other disciples, and the world stopped for them. The only thing that they longed for was to prolong that moment of glory and peace forever. Peter said, "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah" (Mt 17:4).

At the Mount of Transfiguration, Jesus did not really change. He allowed only Peter, James, and John to see Him as He truly is. Jesus opened their eyes for a few moments, and they saw exactly what Daniel saw in the first reading for today. They saw Jesus in His glory. They also saw Moses and Elijah. The event was an eye-opener for them. No wonder Peter writes in the second reading for today, "We did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were EYEWITNESSES of His majesty...."

During the consecration, we spiritually experience joy several times knowing that the Lord makes his real presence in the Eucharist. Our hearts contemplate the future glory while we continue our journey in this present time. I would like to remain in contemplation for hours. Like Peter, I would like to put up a tent there. The reality is that we have a moment of glory, but this is only the beginning of what we will see in heaven once the Lord calls us to be with Him.



BLESSED MICHAEL J. MCGIVNEY, FOUNDER OF THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS



The eldest son of an immigrant Irish family in Connecticut, young Michael left school at 13 to work in a brass factory making spoons. At 16, he began studies for the priesthood in Quebec but was obliged to leave to help support the family when his father died. Michael completed his education in Baltimore, Maryland, and was ordained for the Diocese of Hartford in 1877.

Assigned to St. Mary's Parish in New Haven, Fr. McGivney was very active in parish and civic affairs, serving as director of public plays and fairs. He volunteered to become the guardian of Alfred Downes, a minor whose father had died, leaving a large family in poverty. This situation, his own family's circumstances, and other immigrants impressed on Fr. McGivney the need for lay Catholic men to establish a mutual aid society

to provide financial assistance for their families if the primary wage earner died. Protestant fraternal groups already provided their members with this type of life insurance protection.

In 1882, Fr. McGivney formed the Knights of Columbus among a small group of St. Mary's parishioners to promote charity, unity, and fraternity, assisting widows and orphans. Because of the Knights' emphasis on serving Church, community, and family, the organization grew and did not remain strictly parish-based. Patriotism was added as a founding principle in 1900.

Fr. McGivney died from pneumonia in 1890 and was buried in Thomaston, Connecticut. Later his body was moved back to St. Mary's in New Haven, where it remains today. He was beatified in 2020.

Reflection: Michael Joseph McGivney was a genuine pastor who, in the words of Pope Francis, was unafraid to share "the smell of his sheep." He promoted families whose members were strong in their faith expressed through generous following of the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. In a decree read at the beatification Mass, Pope Francis praised Fr. McGivney's "zeal and the proclamation of the Gospel and generous concern for his brothers and sisters." These "made him an outstanding witness of Christian solidarity and fraternal assistance."

SAINTS OF THE WEEK: DOMINIC DE GUZMAN



If he hadn't taken a trip with his bishop, Dominic would probably have remained within the structure of contemplative life; after the trip, he spent the rest of his life being contemplative in active apostolic work.

Born in old Castile, Spain, Dominic was trained for the priesthood by a priest-uncle, studied the arts and theology, and became a canon of the cathedral at Osma, where there was an attempt to revive the apostolic common life described in Acts of the Apostles.

On a journey through France with his bishop, Dominic faced the then-virulent Albigensian heresy at Languedoc. The Albigensians—or Cathari, "the pure ones"—held to two principles—one good, one evil—in the world. All matter is evil—hence they denied the Incarnation and the sacraments. On the same principle, they abstained from procreation and took a minimum of food and drink. The inner circle led to what some people regarded as a heroic life of purity and asceticism not shared by ordinary followers.

Dominic sensed the need for the Church to combat this heresy and was commissioned to be part of the preaching crusade against it. He immediately saw why the preaching crusade was not succeeding: the ordinary people admired and followed the ascetical heroes of the Albigenses. Understandably, they were not impressed by the Catholic preachers who traveled with horses and retinues, stayed at the best inns, and had servants. Dominic, with three Cistercians, began itinerant preaching according to the gospel ideal. He continued this work for ten years, being successful with ordinary people but not with the leaders.

His fellow preachers gradually became a community, and in 1215 Dominic founded a religious house at Toulouse, the beginning of the Order of Preachers or Dominicans.

Dominic's ideal, and that of his Order, was to organically link life with God, study, and prayer in all forms, with a ministry of salvation to people by the word of God. His ideal: contemplata tradere: "to pass on the fruits of contemplation" or "to speak only of God or with God."

THE PURPOSE OF WYD LISBON 2023 & THE MESSAGE OF THE LOGO

Pope Francis wants World Youth Day Lisbon 2023 to be an occasion to evangelize, and the graphic image released on October 16 reflects that purpose, as Cardinal Manuel Clemente, Patriarch of Lisbon, considers it.

In the on-line event to present the logo of the world youth meeting in Portugal, Cardinal Manuel Clemente recalled a dialogue with the Pope about the next international edition of WYD in which he asked him for only one thing: "Evangelization."

He also pointed out that the WYD Lisbon 2023 logo "shows the world the will to fulfill what Pope Francis asked for." "That is what is expected of Lisbon, and that is also why the colors of Portugal are there: green can



represent hope, red joy. It is then about the joyful hope that Evangelization will transmit to all those young people who will come here and who will then leave with a strong experience that, in a certain way, resembles that of Mary."

The Cardinal Patriarch of Lisbon also said the graphic image "speaks of a young woman, Mary, who immediately after the Annunciation will take this Jesus that she had conceived and will go in haste."

The Pope even repeated: quickly, but not anxiously. She goes with a great desire to announce to her relative that Jesus that she, Mary, carried and that she represents all of us.

The graphic image of WYD Lisbon 2023 was publicly presented in an on-line event on October 16, marked by the investiture as Supreme Pontiff of St. John Paul II, creator of World Youth Day.

This is the 1st week of Itzamal and Xio at World Youth Day. Join us in prayer for these young women!

Nuestros corazones contemplan la gloria futura, mientras continuamos nuestro camino en este tiempo presente. Yo quisiera permanecer en contemplación durante horas. Al igual que Pedro, me gustaría montar una tienda de campaña allí. La realidad es que tenemos un momento de gloria, pero esto es solo el comienzo de lo que veremos en el cielo una vez que el Señor nos llame para estar con Él.
