THE REAL MIRACLE IS OUR SALVATION



The miracles of Jesus always cause admiration, and we, as people, are always looking for more. The miracles that Jesus performs attract people to Him, and more sick people come to Him because it is our human condition to try to extend our lives in this world. Healing our bodies is a joy that gives us more years in this present time.

In the Gospel today, Jesus curing the sick made more people seek Him for healing. After his disciples notified him about the number of people waiting for him instead of attending them, He left them and proceeded to the neighboring village to preach.

Jesus chose to evangelize by preaching directly and healing the sick. And we ask: "Why?" The reason is that people stopped looking for healing of the body only rather than spiritual conversion; conversion is the first step for all kinds of healing. Jesus must have noticed that many had come only to be healed physically. The people were missing the essence of His healing. Jesus knew His mission. He was focused on it. Thus, he decided to preach to the next town instead.

We must also ask ourselves. Who is Jesus to us? If we ask Him for grace, what is our purpose? Is He only a provider? Is He only a miracle worker? Or is He our Lord and Savior? There is nothing wrong with asking for healing or material graces. If they are given, thanks be to God. But we should not forget the very reason why Jesus came. We should not also forget who God is to us. Jesus came to save. He used healing, preaching, and miracles to proclaim His authority and mission. People with strong faith don't rely on what they receive or see to support their beliefs. Our real faith is placed in God's will, and whatever happens in this present time, we need to understand that it is his will, and we are more than happy to accept it. While there may be many miracles and great works of God in our world, our core desire will always be to find the true meaning of the miracle: OUR SALVATION!

OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

FOR CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS:

Those attending the first year of our two-year program, as well as students currently enrolled in our Kindergarten class and our 1st -Grade class:*

*As it is customary in the United States for students in the 2nd Grade to prepare for their First Communion, our current 1st Grade students should be enrolled in our 2024-2025 Sacramental Prep program to ensure they receive their First Communion in May 2025.

Registration period: Tuesday, February 20, 2024, to Friday, March 22, 2024. **After Friday, March 22, registration will be by appointment only.**

You may register your child while they attend class until 30 minutes after the class period ends or during the day on Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday: 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00-4:00 PM.

FOR STUDENTS NOT CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN OUR PROGRAM:

Registration for new students seeking Sacramental Preparation or Continuing Formation (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED) for the years in between will take place on weekdays during April 2024. (No Weekend Registration). Specific information about New Student Registration will be announced in late February or early March 2024.

Required Documents: This is the perfect time to begin your search for the documents you will need to verify the sacraments your child may have already received. You cannot register your child without presenting such documents!

[2024-2025 PROGRAM FEES FOR ALL STUDENTS \(Cash, Check, Credit/Debit Card\)](#)

The basic charge is \$50 per child.

There is an added fee for students preparing to receive a sacrament in the year 2025:

First Holy Communion: \$10 Confirmation: \$20 Receiving Both Sacraments: \$30

The Sacramental Preparation Fee is **NOT** a fee for receiving a sacrament. We **do not charge** to receive the sacrament. Unfortunately, preparing your child for the sacrament is not without cost.

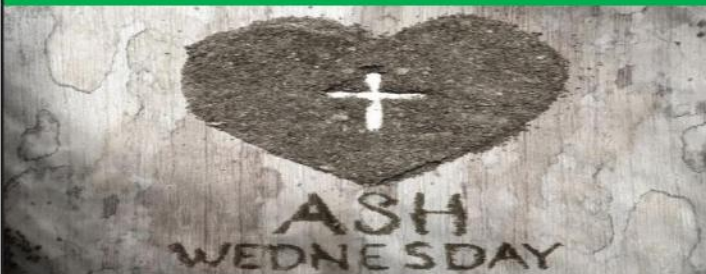

The Way of the Cross, or the Stations of the Cross, is a Christian devotion that commemorates the events of Good Friday, from Jesus being condemned to death to the moment He is laid in the tomb.



SAINT OF THE WEEK: AGATHA



As in the case of Agnes, another virgin martyr of the early Church, almost nothing is historically certain about this saint except that she was martyred in Sicily during the persecution of Emperor Decius in 251.

Legend has it that Agatha, like Agnes, was arrested as a Christian, tortured, and sent to a house of prostitution to be mistreated. She was preserved from being violated and was later put to death.

She is claimed to be the patroness of both Palermo and Catania. The year after her death, the stilling of an eruption of Mt. Etna was attributed to her intercession. As a result, people continued to ask her prayers for protection against fire.

Reflection:

The modern scientific mind winces at the thought of a volcano's might being contained by God because of the prayers of a Sicilian girl. Still less welcome, probably, is the notion of that saint being the patroness of such varied professions as foundry workers, nurses, miners, and Alpine guides. Yet, in our historical precision, have we lost an essential human quality of wonder, poetry, and even our belief that we come to God by helping each other in action and prayer?

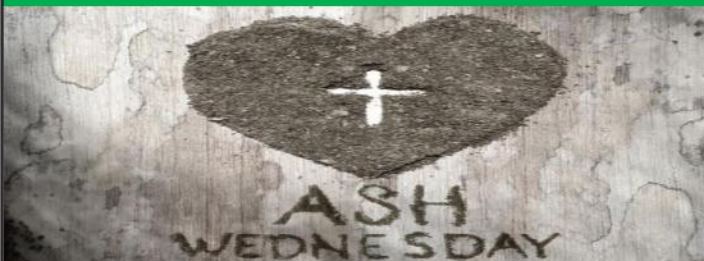
