## THE POWER OF FOUR WORDS



A leper came to Jesus, kneeling to beg and saying, “If you wish, you can make me clean.” Moved with pity, Jesus stretched out his hand, touched him, and said, “I do will it. Be made clean” (Mk 1:40-41).

“I do will it.” With these four simple words, Jesus performed a great miracle. It was amazing that Jesus’ heart was stirred with compassion, not just for the leper’s suffering but also for his strong faith shown when he placed his hope in Jesus’ hands.

The leper’s strong will is a great manifestation of his faith in Jesus. The suffering eventually ended, and the impossible was made possible through his confidence in Him and the love and mercy of God.

Certainly, it shows us His authority over nature. It shows His almighty power. It demonstrates that Jesus can heal any wounds we have in our lives. We can move God’s heart by seeing the glory of God despite our frailty or adversity in life. To do this, we must keep praying and understanding that everything happens according to God’s will.

First, the two words “I do” are sacred words used at various times in our liturgies and are used to profess faith and commitment. They are used in marriages to establish an unbreakable spiritual union; they are used in baptisms and other sacraments to renew our faith publicly; and they are also used in the ordination rite of priests as they make their solemn promises. To say “I do” is what one may call “action words.”

In this Gospel passage, Jesus’ words completely disposed of the leper. He was kneeling before Him as a sign of complete trust and submission. He was ready for Jesus to act in his life, and this openness, more than anything else, evokes these action words from Jesus.

The leprosy is a clear sign of our own weaknesses and sin. This is a clear indication of our weakened human nature and weakness. It’s a clear sign that we cannot heal ourselves. It’s a clear sign that we always need the hand of God in our lives.

The Registration period is Tuesday, February 20, 2024, to Friday, March 22, 2024. After Friday, March 22, registration will be by appointment only. Once registration starts, you may register your child while they attend class until 30 minutes after the class period ends or during the day on Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday: 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00-4:00 PM.

**FOR STUDENTS NOT CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN OUR PROGRAM:** Registration for new students seeking Sacramental Preparation or Continuing Formation (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED) for the years in between will take place on weekdays only during April 2024. Specific information will be announced in late February or early March 2024.

**Required Documents:** All documents that verify the Sacraments your child has already received: Baptism and First Communion.

**Alternative form of Documentation:** An electronically dated photo can be used to verify that your child has received the needed Sacrament(s).

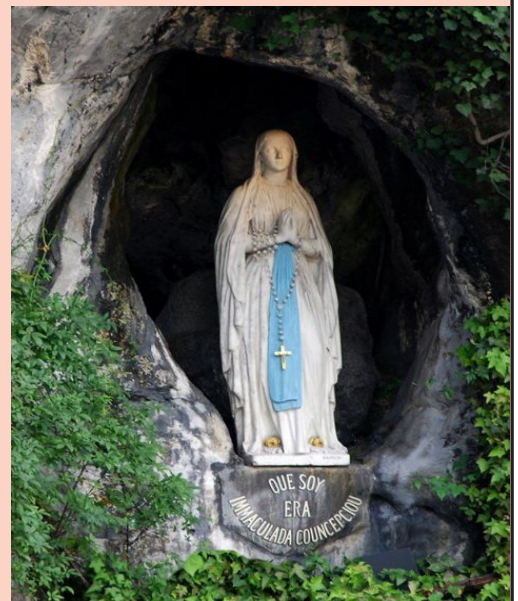
## SAINT OF THE WEEK: OUR LADY OF LOURDES

The celebration of the World Day of the Sick on February 11, the liturgical memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Lourdes, is an opportunity to devote special attention to the sick and those who provide them with assistance and care, both in healthcare institutions and within families and communities. The experience of sickness makes us realize our vulnerability and innate need for others. It makes us feel more apparent that we are creatures dependent on God. Fear and bewilderment can grip our minds and hearts when we are ill. Sickness raises the question of life's meaning, which we bring before God in faith. In seeking a new and deeper direction, we may not find an immediate answer. Nor are our relatives and friends always able to help us in this demanding quest.

Dear brothers and sisters, the commandment of love Jesus left to his disciples is also kept in our relationship with the sick. In a spirit of fraternal love, society is more human to the degree that it cares effectively for its most frail and suffering members. Let us strive to achieve this goal so that no one will feel alone, excluded, or abandoned.

To Mary, Mother of Mercy and Health of the Infirm, I entrust the sick, healthcare workers, and all those who generously assist our suffering brothers and sisters. From the Grotto of Lourdes and her many other shrines throughout the world, may she sustain our faith and hope and help us care for one another with fraternal love. To each and all, I cordially impart my blessing.

O Mary,  
You shine continuously on our journey  
as a sign of salvation and hope.  
We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick,  
who, at the cross,  
united with Jesus' pain,  
kept your faith firm.  
You know what we need,

## EL PODER DE CUATRO PALABRAS



Un leproso se acercó a Jesús, se arrodilló para suplicarle y le dijo: “Si quieres, puedes limpiarme”. Movido a compasión, Jesús extendió la mano, lo tocó y dijo: “Yo quiero. Quedad limpios” (Mc 1,40-41).

“Lo haré”. Con estas cuatro sencillas palabras, Jesús realizó un gran milagro. Fue sorprendente que el corazón de Jesús se conmoviera con compasión, no solo por el sufrimiento del leproso sino también por la gran fe que demostró cuando puso su esperanza en las manos de Jesús.

La fuerte voluntad del leproso es una gran manifestación de su fe en Jesús. El sufrimiento finalmente terminó y lo imposible fue posible gracias a su confianza en Él y en el amor y la misericordia de Dios.

Ciertamente, nos muestra Su autoridad sobre la naturaleza. Muestra su poder todopoderoso. Demuestra que Jesús puede sanar cualquier herida que tengamos en nuestras vidas. Podemos conmover el corazón de Dios al ver la gloria de Dios a pesar de nuestra fragilidad o adversidad en la vida. Para ello, debemos seguir orando y entendiendo que todo sucede según la voluntad de Dios.

Primero, las dos palabras “Sí, quiero” son palabras sagradas que se usan en varios momentos de nuestras liturgias y se usan para profesar fe y compromiso. Se utilizan en los matrimonios para establecer una unión espiritual inquebrantable; se utilizan en bautismos y otros sacramentos para renovar públicamente nuestra fe; y también se utilizan en el rito de ordenación de los sacerdotes cuando hacen sus promesas solemnes. Decir "Sí, quiero" es lo que podríamos llamar "palabras de acción".

En este pasaje del Evangelio, las palabras de Jesús eliminaron por completo al leproso. Estaba arrodillado ante Él en señal de total confianza y sumisión. Estaba listo para que Jesús actuara en su vida, y esta apertura, más que cualquier otra cosa, evoca estas palabras de acción de Jesús.

La lepra es un signo claro de nuestras propias debilidades y pecado. Esta es una clara indicación de nuestra debilitada naturaleza humana y debilidad. Es una señal clara de que no podemos curarnos a nosotros mismos. Es una señal clara de que siempre necesitamos la mano de Dios en nuestras vidas.
