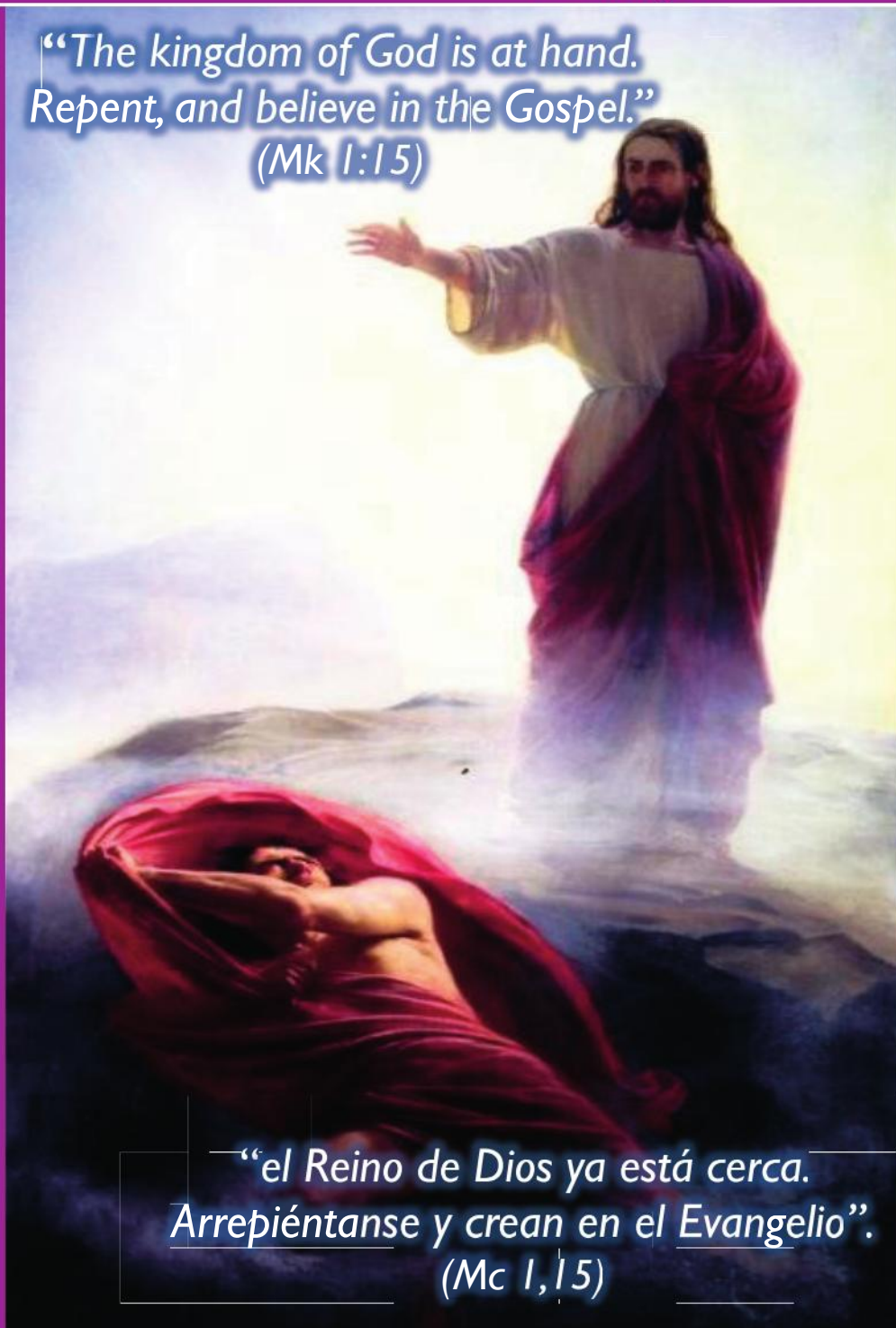

FORTY DAYS OF CONVERSION



During this first Sunday of Lent, Jesus is depicted in the Gospel as he prays and fasts against the devil's temptations in the desert. In a place like the desert, the idea of survival or having some comfort is a remote possibility. In the desert, we are vulnerable, and without food or drink, a person can die. Hot temperatures during the day and low temperatures in the evening, dangerous wildlife, and all kinds of needs can make a person weak and frail.

The desert is a place where Jesus can find the strength to overcome Satan's temptations and surrender to His Father's will.

Jesus was not alone; he was constantly praying with His Father. The angel was present to care for Him and give Him a sense of God's presence.

This is why, during this season of Lent, we exhort you to pray and fast. Their purpose is to bring us closer to God by rejecting the devil's advances. The devil will always be there to lure us to himself and to separate us from God. Through constant communication with God through prayer, we can better understand Him, love Him more, and serve Him better. Prayer keeps us connected to Him. We must never forget; much more, miss prayer.

Fasting leaves us to ourselves and God's power. The devil has many instruments to make us sin. If we allow the devil to take advantage of us, our faith will be greatly diminished. The human heart is the battlefield of sin. God will always triumph over the devil. We must not allow the devil to triumph over us. By focusing on God, we can conquer the devil.

After forty days and nights of fasting and prayer, Jesus comes out proclaiming His message of repentance. Jesus embarks on His strong, focused, determined, and bold ministry. Our prayers and fasting should be complemented by repentance on our part and proclaiming them at the same time. Conversion and salvation should always be in our minds and hearts. Conversion and salvation are what God wants for us.

FOR THE PARENTS OF CURRENT & FUTURE STUDENTS
OUR PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FORMAT
HAS BEEN CHANGED

ARE YOU READY FOR
REGISTRATION?

As a result of a lengthy and comprehensive discussion with our Pastor, Fr. Alfonso Cely, the following changes to the format of the Parish Religious Education Program have been approved **EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:**

Sacramental preparation **WILL BE REDUCED FROM TWO YEARS TO ONE YEAR** with the following exceptions:

- 1. Kindergarten and Grade 1 classes** will remain outside the Sacramental preparation process. However, the importance of starting your child's Faith Formation at either the Kindergarten or Grade 1 level has not changed and is highly recommended.
- 2. Grade 6 students requiring Sacraments of Holy Communion & Confirmation or Confirmation only** will remain a two-year preparation process. It is not proper to wait until your child is in Grade 7 to bypass this two-year requirement. Your child's proper formation in the Faith is at stake!

With our mandate to properly prepare all students, this format change has brought about the need to **add additional class days** to the immediate academic year for many of our classes. Please review the updated program calendar for these changes.

2024-2025 Registration for Current & New Students:

Current: Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 6 students, as well as Continuing Faith Formation for students in Grades 3, 4, & 5 who have already received or will receive their First Communion this year:

Weekdays: 10:30 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00-4:00 PM on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday until March 22, except March 12 as the Office will be closed.

Saturdays: February 24, March 2, March 9, and March 23 only - 9:15 AM until 12:30 PM.

New Student Registration will take place beginning in April. Details will be announced in the Sunday, March 10 Bulletin.

All Registration Fees have been updated and will vary by academic year and Sacramental needs. Please inquire at the Office of Religious Education about the current Fee Schedule.

BEGIN LENT BY PRAYING PSALM 51

Many of the psalms in the Old Testament speak to our human condition and our need for repentance. They are beautiful poems that recall our sinfulness while looking forward to Christ's redemption. In particular, Psalm 51, also called the *Miserere*, is a perfect psalm to begin the season of Lent. The Church even prescribes this psalm for the Ash Wednesday liturgy.

Pope Benedict XVI commented on this psalm in his homily for *Ash Wednesday 2012*.

The same Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead can turn our hearts from hearts of stone into hearts of flesh (cf. Ezek 36:26). **We invoked him just now in the Psalm Miserere:** "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me. Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your holy Spirit from me" (Ps 51[50]:10, 11). **That same God who banished our first parents from Eden sent his own Son to this earth, devastated by sin, without sparing him, so that we, as prodigal children, might return, repentant and redeemed through his mercy, to our true homeland.**

Here is an excerpt from Psalm 51 to help you start Lent off on the right foot.

PSALM 51

*Have mercy on me, O God,
according to your steadfast love;
according to your abundant mercy
blot out my transgressions.
Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity,
and cleanse me from my sin.
For I know my transgressions,
and my sin is ever before me.
Against you, you alone, have I sinned,
and done what is evil in your sight,
so that you are justified in your sentence
and blameless when you pass
judgment.
Indeed, I was born guilty,
a sinner when my mother conceived
me.
wash me, and I shall be whiter than
snow.
You desire truth in the inward being;
therefore teach me wisdom in my
secret heart.*

*Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be
clean;
Let me hear joy and gladness;
let the bones that you have crushed
rejoice.
Hide your face from my sins,
and blot out all my iniquities.
Create in me a clean heart, O God,
and put a new and right spirit
within me.
Do not cast me away from your
presence,
and do not take your holy spirit
from me.
Restore to me the joy of your
salvation,
and sustain in me a willing spirit.*

WHAT IS THE OCIA RITE OF SENDING / ELECTION?

The Rite of Sending offers the parish community an opportunity to acknowledge the spiritual progress the catechumens and candidates have made, express approval of their election or recognition, and send them forth to our bishop with assurance of the parish's care and support. To send a catechumen or candidate to the bishop means that a parish has discerned that the person is ready to enter the Catholic Church. The community, with godparents representing the parish, will wholeheartedly acclaim the participants' readiness. In Sacred Scripture, the Book of Revelation refers to a "Book of Life," in which are written the names of those who have



chosen to follow the Lord Jesus and be baptized. Those who are already baptized, as Catholics or in other denominations, had our names written in the Book of Life at our Baptism. In this Rite, those preparing for Baptism are invited to come forward and sign a book, which we call the "Book of the Elect," as a sign of their desire to be numbered among the chosen of God.

Then, across the world, Catholic bishops on this first Sunday of Lent will welcome those sent by the parish to gather with their godparents and sponsors in what is known as the Rite of Election. This Rite marks a key moment. For the catechumens, this Rite signifies that they have been called by Christ and attests to the reality that only those mystically claimed by Christ will enter Heaven. It is appropriate for the bishop to recognize them because he is the sign of unity of the particular Church, and it is the parish community's responsibility to bring those in RCIA into the fullness of the life of the Church. The decision of an RCIA participant to go through this Rite means that the judgment and decision-making (of both the catechumen and the parish) about whether to enter the Catholic Church has ended. From this point forward, they are no longer catechumens but are called the "elect." They have been chosen to enter into the final period of preparation for initiation, and called by the bishop, their shepherd, to the holy mysteries to be celebrated at Easter.

CUARENTA DÍAS DE CONVERSIÓN



Durante este primer domingo de Cuaresma, Jesús es representado en el Evangelio mientras ora y ayuna contra las tentaciones del diablo en el desierto. En un lugar como el desierto, la idea de sobrevivir o tener algo de comodidad es una posibilidad remota. En el desierto somos vulnerables y sin comida ni bebida una persona puede morir. Las altas temperaturas durante el día y las bajas temperaturas por la noche, la vida silvestre peligrosa y todo tipo de necesidades pueden debilitar a una persona.

El desierto es un lugar donde Jesús puede encontrar la fuerza para vencer las tentaciones de Satanás y entregarse a la voluntad de su Padre.

Jesús no estaba solo; él estaba constantemente orando con Su Padre. El ángel estaba presente para cuidarlo y darle una sensación de la presencia de Dios.

Por eso, durante este tiempo de Cuaresma, os exhortamos a orar y ayunar. Su propósito es acercarnos a Dios rechazando los avances del diablo. El diablo siempre estará ahí para atraernos hacia sí y separarnos de Dios. A través de la comunicación constante con Dios a través de la oración, podemos entenderlo mejor, amarlo más y servirle mejor. La oración nos mantiene conectados con Él. Nunca debemos olvidarlo; y mucho menos, que nos falte la oración.

El ayuno nos abandona a nosotros mismos al poder de Dios. El diablo tiene muchos instrumentos para hacernos pecar. Si permitimos que el diablo se aproveche de nosotros, nuestra fe disminuirá enormemente. El corazón humano es el campo de batalla del pecado. Dios siempre triunfará sobre el diablo. No debemos permitir que el diablo triunfe sobre nosotros. Al centrarnos en Dios, podemos vencer al diablo.

Después de cuarenta días y cuarenta noches de ayuno y oración, Jesús sale proclamando su mensaje de arrepentimiento. Jesús se embarca en su ministerio fuerte, enfocado, decidido y audaz. Nuestras oraciones y ayuno deben complementarse con el arrepentimiento de nuestra parte y su proclamación al mismo tiempo. La conversión y la salvación deben estar siempre en nuestra mente y corazón. La conversión y la salvación son lo que Dios quiere para nosotros.

Como resultado de una larga y exhaustiva discusión con el P. Alfonso Cely, nuestro Párroco, el P. Alfonso ha aprobado los siguientes cambios al formato del Programa Parroquial de Educación Religiosa que **ENTRARÁ EN VIGOR INMEDIATAMENTE:**

La preparación sacramental **SE REDUCIRÁ DE DOS AÑOS A UN AÑO** con las siguientes excepciones:

1. **Las clases de Kindergarten y Primer Grado** permanecerán fuera del proceso de preparación Sacramental. Sin embargo, la importancia de comenzar la formación de fe de su hijo en el nivel de jardín de infantes o primer grado no ha cambiado y es muy recomendable.
2. **Los estudiantes de Sexto Grado que requieran los Sacramentos de la Sagrada Comunión y la Confirmación o solo la Confirmación** seguirán en un proceso de preparación de dos años. No es apropiado esperar hasta que su hijo esté en séptimo grado para evitar este requisito de dos años. ¡Está en juego la adecuada formación en la Fe de vuestro Hijo!

Con nuestro mandato de preparar adecuadamente a todos los estudiantes, este cambio de formato ha generado la necesidad de **agregar días de clase adicionales** al año académico inmediato para muchas de nuestras clases. Revise el calendario del programa actualizado para conocer estos cambios.

Registro de nuevos estudiantes: se realizará a partir de abril. Los detalles se anunciarán en el boletín del domingo 10 de marzo.

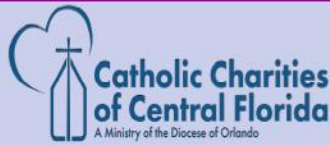
