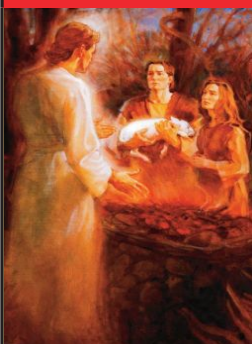

## OBEDIENT TO THE FATHER



Today is Palm Sunday, also known as the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ. This year, we hear the Passion of the Lord according to Mark. This Gospel contains many details that the other evangelists omitted, and their accounts contain different details.

The Gospel of Mark contains historical events, particularly the part about the Passion of the Lord recounted in one of the books written by the historian Josephus in the first century.

Mark describes Jesus' dramatic entrance into the Holy City of Jerusalem. Consider how he had wept for the city and knew that he would be crucified. We cannot imagine his feelings of being welcomed and proclaimed as king, knowing he would soon be condemned to death. Can you imagine what it feels like to enter the place where you will die? Divine as He was, Jesus was truly human, too. He felt the same way we would if we were in that situation. Considering the pain, brutality, and humiliation of execution in those days, it was even worse.

Mark's Gospel makes us think about his sufferings and walk with him in contemplation of how great his love is for us. Being God, he accepted humiliation and suffering for our salvation. He accepted his Passion with all kinds of offenses and aggravations that were included, but He was faithful to his mission and obedient to his Heavenly Father.

The Gospel has many characters who took part in his Passion and condemnation. Some of them walked and suffered with Him during that horrific part of His life, such as Mary, His mother, Simon of Cyrene, Veronica, the woman of Jerusalem, and Mary Magdalen. But others had a strange way of accompanying Jesus to Calvary, like Peter, who denied him. Some disciples disappeared entirely from the picture, and some became his accusers despite seeing his signs and wonders.

Let us ask ourselves, what kind of company will we be for Jesus on his way to Calvary?

**PARENTS OF CURRENT KINDERGARTEN, 1st GRADE, AND 6th GRADE STUDENTS NOT YET REGISTERED, MAY STILL DO SO BEGINNING TUESDAY, APRIL 9, 2024.**

**NEW STUDENTS REGISTRATION BEGINS ON TUESDAY, APRIL 9, 2024**  
Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday only: 10:30 AM-12:00 PM and 1:00-4:00 PM

#### SPECIAL NOTE:

**For parents of CURRENT 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Students:** Second Grade is the most appropriate grade for your child to receive their First Holy Communion.

**For parents of children currently in the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade:** It is strongly recommended that you enroll your child in our Special two-year Confirmation Prep program for those entering 6<sup>th</sup> Grade. Participation in a two-year program leading to the sacrament of Confirmation is the most appropriate way to prepare for the sacrament.

**For parents of children currently in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> Grade:** Do not wait until your child enters high school to have your child receive the sacrament of Confirmation, and, for some, this also includes Holy Communion. Your children's high school years are very busy. While receiving the sacraments should be a priority, many choose sports over receiving the sacraments. When pushed into such a situation, the delay in receiving the sacraments can extend into adulthood.

**For both our Current Students in Grades 2, 3, 4 & 5, as well as for NEW STUDENTS currently in Grades 2, 3, 4, & 5 who have already received their First Communion or will have received the sacrament prior to the start of classes in September 2024.**

## RECEPTION OF THE HOLY OILS

The reception of the Holy Oils: Oil of the Sick, Oil of Catechumens, and the Holy Chrism, which Bishop John Noonan blesses during the Chrism Mass, will be presented by our Deacons to Fr. Alfonso and our congregation before the Mass of the Last Supper of the Lord.



The oils will be reserved in a suitable repository in the presbyterium or near the baptismal font.

## EASTER VIGIL MASS

The rubrics of the Roman Missal remind us that this "mother of all vigils" is the "greatest and most noble of all solemnities, and it is to be unique in every single Church." On this holy night, the Church keeps watch, celebrating the resurrection of Christ in the sacraments and awaiting his return in glory. It is the turning point of the Triduum, the Passover of the new covenant, which marks Christ's passage from death to life.

We invite everyone to join us for this special celebration. As a reminder, there will be **no 4:00 PM Mass** on **Holy Saturday (March 30)**.

Instead, we will celebrate the **Easter Vigil Mass (March 30) at 8:00 PM (Bilingual)**.



## WASHING OF THE FEET (HOLY THURSDAY)



In this sacred celebration of the Last Supper of the Lord, the principal mysteries commemorated in this Mass are the institution of the Holy Eucharist, the Priestly Order, and the commandment of Love.

## THE PLACE OF REPOSE (HOLY THURSDAY)

A procession is formed in which the Blessed Sacrament, accompanied by torches and incense, is carried through the church to a place of repose prepared in a part of the church or chapel suitably decorated.

The faithful are invited to continue adoration before the Blessed Sacrament for a suitable length of time during the night, according to local circumstances. After Midnight, the adoration should take place without solemnity.

## SUNRISE MASS (EASTER SUNDAY)

In the Gospel narrative, **Jesus rises from the dead early on Sunday morning**. There is no mention of the exact time when Jesus rose, but he had already left the tomb by the time some of his disciples came there.

St. John narrates: "On the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early in the morning while it was still dark, and she saw the stone rolled away from the tomb. Peter and the other disciple went to the tomb. The two ran together, but the other disciple ran ahead faster than Peter and reached the tomb first. He bent down and saw the bandages on the ground" (John 20).

The symbolism of this tradition is very clear, as it **celebrates the rising of the Son**, the true **Light of the World**, at the moment when the rays of the sun begin to shatter the darkness of night.

We want to express our gratitude to all our parishioners for their support in the recent Orange & Flower Festival at St. Ann's. We are truly blessed by your presence and cooperation!

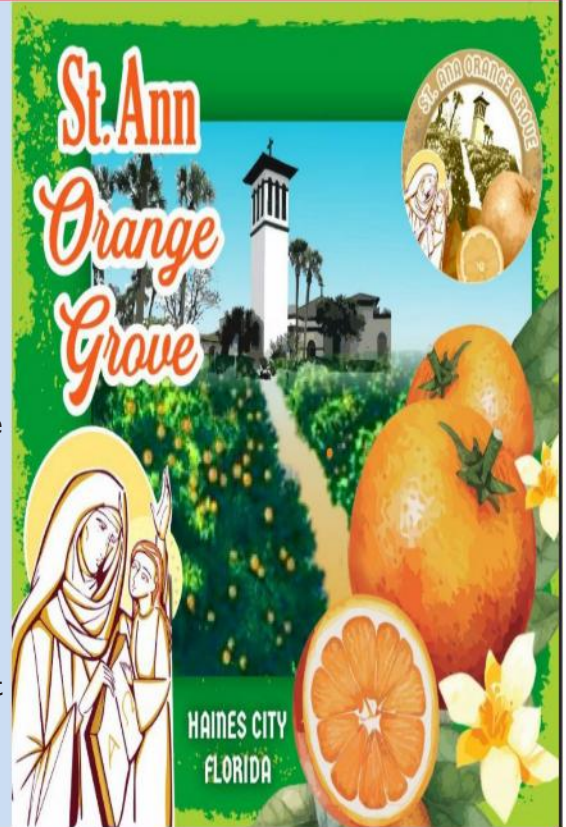

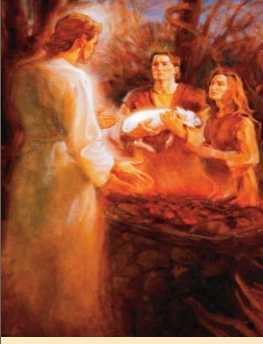
In the past few months, Lucciano has been in contact with the vocations director in the Diocese of Orlando, and it has been recommended that he submit his application to the seminary.

## OBEDIENTES AL PADRE



Hoy es Domingo de Ramos, también conocido como la Pasión de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Este año escuchamos la Pasión del Señor según Marcos. Este evangelio contiene muchos detalles que los otros evangelistas omitieron, y sus relatos contienen detalles diferentes.

El Evangelio de Marcos contiene acontecimientos históricos, en particular la parte de la Pasión del Señor relatada en uno de los libros escritos por el historiador Josefo en el siglo I.

Marcos describe la dramática entrada de Jesús a la Ciudad Santa de Jerusalén. Considere cómo lloró por la ciudad y supo que sería crucificado. No podemos imaginar sus sentimientos al ser acogido y proclamado rey, sabiendo que pronto sería condenado a muerte. ¿Te imaginas lo que se siente al entrar al lugar donde morirás? Por divino que fuera, Jesús también era verdaderamente humano. Sentía lo mismo que sentiríamos nosotros si estuviéramos en esa situación. Considerando el dolor, la brutalidad y la humillación de la ejecución en aquellos días, era aún peor.

El evangelio de Marcos nos hace pensar en sus sufrimientos y caminar con él en la contemplación de cuán grande es su amor por nosotros. Siendo Dios, aceptó la humillación y el sufrimiento por nuestra salvación. Aceptó su Pasión con toda clase de ofensas y agravios que se incluían, pero fue fiel a su misión y obediente a su Padre Celestial.

El Evangelio tiene muchos personajes que participaron en su Pasión y condenación. Algunos de ellos caminaron y sufrieron con Él durante esa horrible parte de Su vida, como María, Su madre, Simón de Cirene, Verónica, la mujer de Jerusalén y María Magdalena. Pero otros tuvieron una manera extraña de acompañar a Jesús al Calvario, como Pedro, que lo negó. Algunos discípulos desaparecieron por completo de la imagen y algunos se convirtieron en sus acusadores a pesar de ver sus señales y maravillas.

Preguntémonos ¿qué compañía seremos para Jesús en su camino al Calvario?

## MISA DEL ALBA (DOMINGO DE PASCUA)

En la narración del Evangelio, Jesús resucita de entre los muertos el domingo por la mañana temprano. No se menciona la hora exacta en que Jesús resucitó, pero ya había salido de la tumba cuando algunos de sus discípulos llegaron allí.

San Juan narra: "El primer día de la semana va María Magdalena de madrugada al sepulcro cuando todavía estaba oscuro, y ve la piedra quitada del sepulcro. Pedro y el otro discípulo, se encaminaron al sepulcro. Corrían los dos juntos, pero el otro discípulo corrió por delante más rápido que Pedro, y llegó primero al sepulcro. Se inclinó y vio las vendas en el suelo" (Juan, 20)

El simbolismo de esta tradición es muy claro, ya que celebra la resurrección del Hijo de Dios, la verdadera Luz del Mundo, en el momento en que los rayos del sol comienzan romper la oscuridad de la noche.

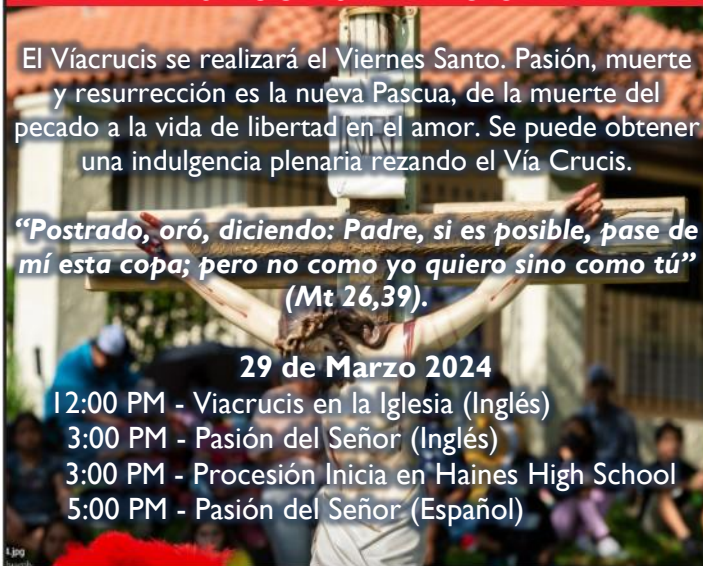
## ESTACIONES DE LA CRUZ
