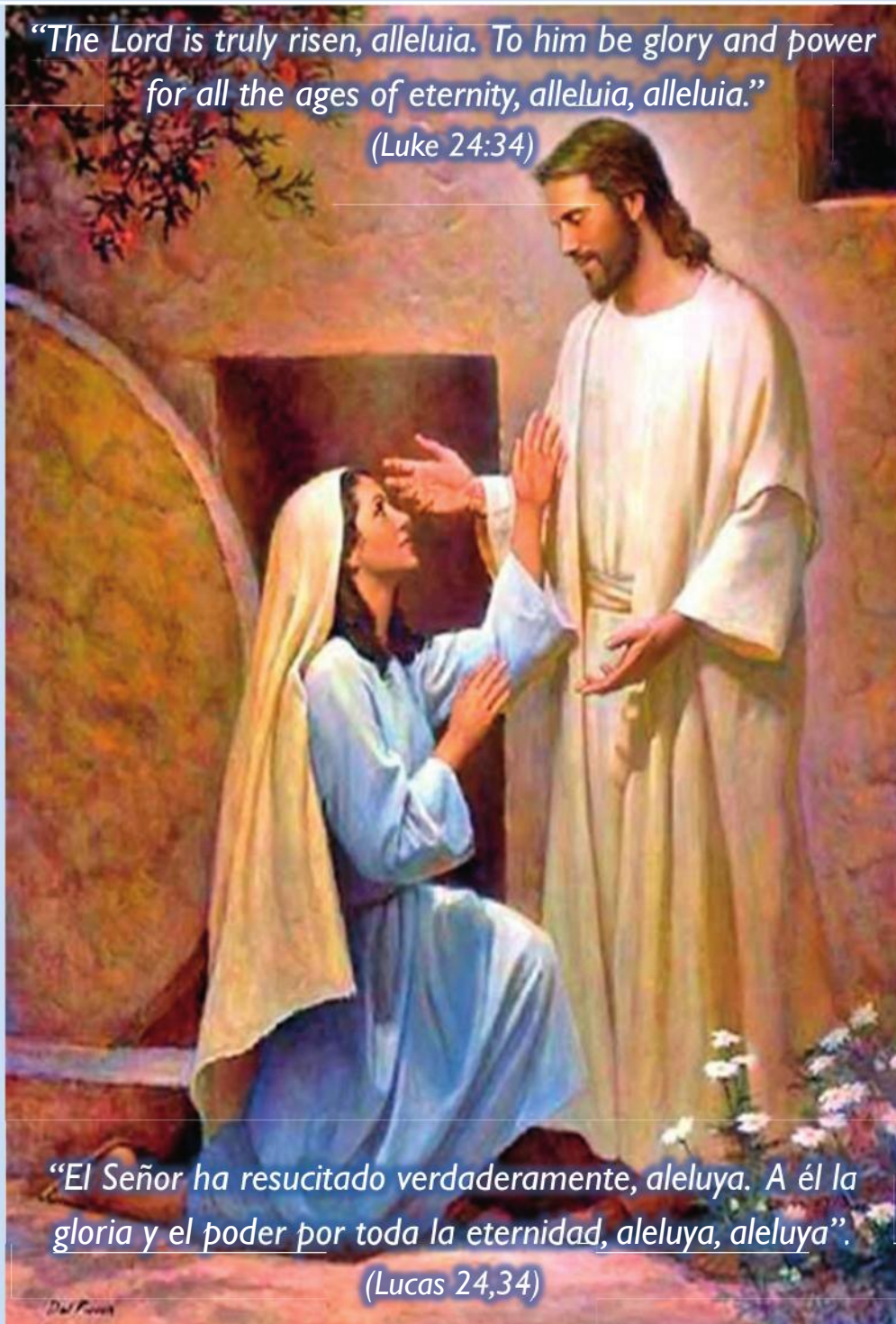

## THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK



According to the Gospel of John (20:1), the first apparition of Jesus after his glorious Resurrection occurred on the first day of the week (Sunday). John again confirms that the same day after Saturday, the disciples were together in the afternoon with the doors locked for fear of the Jews. Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you" (Jn 20:19). With his apparitions, our Lord Jesus inaugurated the new consecration of Sunday to Him. It would be a day to rest from our regular duties and offer Him praise and glory. This new experience forever changed the perspective of the day reserved for the Lord, changing the Sabbath to the first day of the week (Sunday). The early Christians began to view Sunday as the day of the Lord, where they all come together to celebrate the living Lord.

A document from the late first century or early second century, the *Didache* or *Teaching of the Apostles*, refers to Sunday as "the Lord's Day of the Lord." This unusual phrase, "the Lord's Day of the Lord," seems to mean that the early Church understood that Jesus himself instituted the change of worship from Sabbath to the Lord's Day, the Lord's Day of the Lord (*Didache* §14). In the New Covenant, the day holy to God is the day of Jesus' Resurrection.

For us, it is a joy to celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ every Sunday. Our presence in the celebration of the Eucharist is a faithful testimony of our happiness because Jesus is Risen! His Resurrection is the victory we participate in; his triumph is ours, and we only have one way to celebrate and fill our hearts with hope, dedicating part of our resting time to be with our Lord. We are his body, and He is our head. We long for where our head is, and we, his body, would like to be there one day.

Let us celebrate His Resurrection with gladness until the day that the Lord calls us to be with him forever in heaven.

### SPECIAL NOTE:

**For parents of CURRENT 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Students:** Second Grade is the most appropriate grade for your child to receive their First Holy Communion.

**For parents of children currently in the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade:** It is strongly recommended that you enroll your child in our Special two-year Confirmation Prep program for those entering 6<sup>th</sup> Grade. Participation in a two-year program leading to the sacrament of Confirmation is the most appropriate way to prepare for the sacrament.

**For parents of children currently in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> Grade:** Do not wait until your child enters high school to have them receive the sacrament of Confirmation, and, for some, this also includes Holy Communion. Your children's high school years are very busy. While receiving the sacraments should be a priority, many choose sports over receiving the sacraments. When pushed into such a situation, the delay in receiving the sacraments can extend into adulthood.

## MERCY SUNDAY

On April 9, 2023, as our parish was in the middle of the celebration of Easter Sunday, the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection, we witnessed a manifestation of faith of great magnitude.

During our 12:00 PM Mass at the outside altar, a multitude of people spread throughout our gardens, and the experience of the resurrected was enveloping our parish into a Communion of the Faithful that had gathered throughout the Lenten preparation, Holy Week, and Easter Sunday in different celebrations. On this particular day, we had two celebrations simultaneously, one inside the church and one at the outside altar—"different" celebrations that became one. As St. Ann Parish, we come together to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord.

During the outside Mass, at the moment of the distribution of the Eucharist, the extraordinary ministers went out and distributed Holy Communion to the faithful. Unfortunately, one of the Hosts fell to the ground during the distribution. The immediate reaction of the parishioner was to pick it up and consume it.

However, the protocol that we have on these occasions is to cover the place where the incident occurred with a purificator and, with the proper veneration to the real Body of Christ in the Eucharist, clean the area with Holy water and clean towels to make sure that no particles of the Body of Christ stay behind.

The place where the Host was dropped was in the grassy area. It was covered with the purificator, and while the Holy water was gathered with towels, other faithful remained on site, with the minister of the Eucharist venerating the place where the Host was dropped.

What happened after is a beautiful sign of love and mercy from Christ to our community and the world. The purificator covering the site where the Host was dropped started shaping a figure in what appears to be blood, a circled figure that resembles the Host. The Body of Christ began taking form in the purificator right in front of the eyes of many of our parishioners, in a manifestation that impacted many of us.

Some cried while others were shaking in amazement. Right in the middle of the feast of the Resurrection of the Lord, He showed us He is alive, and did not stay in the tomb.

**We invite you to join us next weekend (April 6-7) for the exposition of the Eucharistic Miracle at the outside altar after all Masses.**



## DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY



In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know that feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000.

The Lord expressed His will concerning this feast in His first revelation to St. Faustina. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in her Diary, entry 699:

*My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire the Feast of Mercy to be a refuge and shelter for all souls, especially poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls approaching the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. All the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened on that day. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul's relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy.*

St. Faustina recorded 14 revelations from Jesus concerning His desire for this feast.

Nevertheless, Divine Mercy Sunday is NOT a feast based solely on St. Faustina's revelations. Indeed, it is not primarily about St. Faustina, nor is it altogether a new feast. The Second Sunday of Easter was already a solemnity as the Octave Day of Easter. The title "Divine Mercy Sunday" does, however, highlight the meaning of the day.

### Easter Octave:

Liturgically, the Easter Octave has always been centered on the theme of Divine Mercy and forgiveness. Divine Mercy Sunday, therefore, points us to the merciful love of God that lies behind the whole Paschal Mystery—the whole mystery of the death, burial, and Resurrection of Christ—made present for us in the Eucharist. In this way, it also sums up the whole Easter Octave.

As Pope John Paul II pointed out in his Regina Caeli address on Divine Mercy Sunday, 1995, "The whole octave of Easter is like a single day," and the Octave Sunday is meant to be the day of "thanksgiving for the goodness God has shown to man in the whole Easter mystery."

*"I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy."*

## EL PRIMER DÍA DE LA SEMANA



Según el Evangelio de Juan (20,1), la primera aparición de Jesús después de su gloriosa Resurrección ocurrió el primer día de la semana (domingo). Juan nuevamente confirma que el mismo día después del sábado, los discípulos estaban juntos por la tarde con las puertas cerradas por miedo a los judíos. Jesús vino y se puso en medio de ellos y dijo: "La paz esté con vosotros" (Jn 20,19). Con sus apariciones, nuestro Señor Jesús inauguró la nueva consagración del domingo a Él. Sería un día para descansar de nuestros deberes habituales y ofrecerle alabanza y gloria. Esta nueva experiencia cambió para siempre la perspectiva del día reservado para el Señor, cambiando el sábado al primer día de la semana (domingo). Los primeros cristianos comenzaron a ver el domingo como el día del Señor, donde todos se reunían para celebrar al Señor vivo.

Un documento de finales del siglo I o principios del II, la Didaché o Enseñanza de los Apóstoles, se refiere al domingo como "el Día del Señor". Esta frase inusual, "el Día del Señor", parece significar que la Iglesia primitiva entendió que Jesús mismo instituyó el cambio de adoración del sábado al Domingo, el Día del Señor (Didajé §14). En el Nuevo Pacto, el día santo para Dios es el día de la Resurrección de Jesús.

Para nosotros es una alegría celebrar cada domingo la Resurrección de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. ¡Nuestra presencia en la celebración de la Eucaristía es testimonio fiel de nuestra felicidad porque Jesús ha resucitado! Su Resurrección es la victoria de la que participamos; su triunfo es el nuestro, y sólo tenemos una manera de celebrar y llenar de esperanza nuestro corazón, dedicando parte de nuestro tiempo de descanso para estar con nuestro Señor. Nosotros somos su cuerpo y Él es nuestra cabeza. Anhelamos dónde está nuestra cabeza, y nosotros, su cuerpo, quisiéramos estar allí algún día.

Celebremos con alegría Su Resurrección hasta el día en que el Señor nos llame a estar con él para siempre en el cielo.

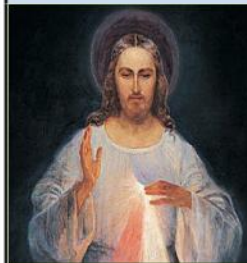
