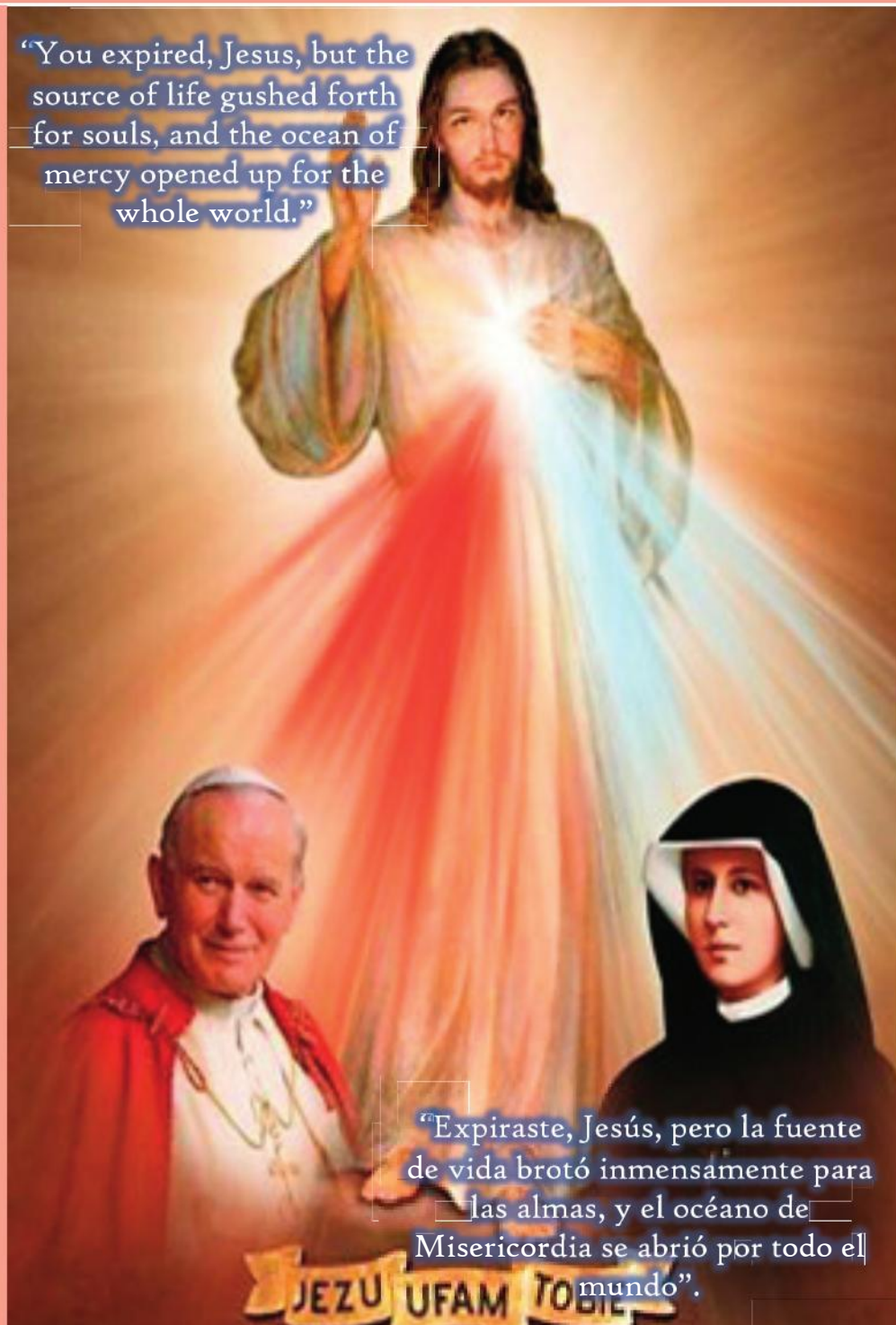

SACRAMENTS - VIVID SIGNS OF HIS DIVINE MERCY



Today, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. The readings point to how God's love and compassion are essential. We sing with the psalmist (Psalm 118) about how God's mercy endures forever! One of the most significant signs of God's mercy is that He sent His only-begotten Son, who suffered crucifixion and death, as our Savior and Messiah. Through His resurrection, He made us participants and gave us eternal life.

In the second reading from the first Letter of St. John, we find three significant signs of the sacraments of Divine Mercy. The water represents our baptism, a manifestation of the purification that only God can give us to liberate us from our original sin. The blood represents the Eucharistic covenant, while the Spirit represents our regeneration. The Bible says, "Whoever believes that Jesus Christ has been begotten by God overcomes the world" (1 Jn 5:1-6). In all our sacraments, we can find God's love and mercy. Through them, we can find salvation, healing, and restoration, which we need for both our present and everlasting life. After Jesus' resurrection, he established the sacrament of reconciliation, which is a sacrament for the excellence of Divine Mercy. The Risen Lord gave his apostles the power to forgive sins, saying, "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained" (Jn 20:19-23).

Attending the sacraments of reconciliation and the Holy Eucharist regularly is necessary for us to share in the Divine Life of Jesus. St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa) presents it this way: "If we pray, we will believe; if we believe, we will love; if we love, we will serve. Only then do we put our love of God into action."

SAINT OF THE WEEK: TERESA OF LOS ANDES



One needn't live a long life to leave a deep imprint. Teresa of Los Andes is proof of that.

As a young girl growing up in the early 1900's in Santiago, Chile, Juana Fernandez read an autobiography of a French-born saint—Thérèse, popularly known as the Little Flower. The experience deepened her desire to serve God and clarified the path she would follow. At age 19, Juana became a Carmelite nun, taking the name of Teresa.

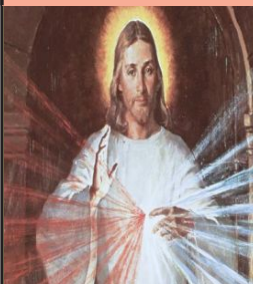
The convent offered the simple lifestyle Teresa desired and the joy of living in a community of women completely devoted to God. She focused her days on prayer and sacrifice. "I am God's," she wrote in her diary. "He created me and is my beginning and my end."

Toward the end of her short life, Teresa began an apostolate of letter-writing, sharing her thoughts on the spiritual life with many people. At age 20, she contracted typhus and quickly took her final vows. She died a short time later, during Holy Week.

Known as the "Flower of the Andes," Teresa remains popular, with an estimated 100,000 pilgrims visiting her shrine in Los Andes each year. She is Chile's first saint, canonized in 1993 by Pope John Paul II.

Reflection: The special graces given to St. Teresa reflect the mysterious wisdom of God at work in individuals, whether young or old. It appears God has his own logic regarding who gets what in the realm of grace. All we can say is, "Praised be the Lord."

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY: ANOTHER NAME FOR THE SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER



For many centuries, the Second Sunday of Easter was named **Low Sunday**, in contrast to the **High Sunday of Easter**.

Additionally, the newly baptized would wear their baptismal gowns during the eight days of the Easter Octave. According to the Catholic Encyclopedia, the Second Sunday of Easter "was consequently known as **Dominica in Albis** (*deponendis*), **the Sunday of the (laying aside of the) white garments**."

In 2000, St. John Paul II canonized the Polish religious mystic Faustina Kowalska and, during his homily, **officially designated the Second Sunday of Easter "Divine Mercy Sunday."**

John Paul II did this to endorse Faustina's private revelations and put more emphasis on Divine Mercy in the 21st century. He explained during his homily, "Divine Mercy reaches human beings through the heart of Christ crucified: 'My daughter, say that I am love and mercy personified,' Jesus will ask Sr. Faustina (Diary, p. 374). Christ pours out this mercy on humanity through the sending of the Spirit, who, in the Trinity, is the Person-Love. And is not mercy love's 'second name' (cf. Dives in misericordia, n. 7) understood in its deepest and most tender aspect, in its ability to take upon itself the burden of any need and, especially, in its immense capacity for forgiveness? Today, my joy is truly great in presenting the life and witness of Sr. Faustina Kowalska to the whole Church as a gift of God for our time...Jesus told Sr. Faustina: '*Humanity will not find peace until it turns trustfully to divine mercy*' (Diary, p. 132)."

The Polish pope then went on to proclaim, "**It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday.'**"

Jesus requested that this Second Sunday of Easter be named "Divine Mercy Sunday" in a vision to St. Faustina that she wrote down in her *Diary*.

*On one occasion, I heard these words: My daughter, tell the whole world about My Inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the divine floodgates through which grace flows are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. **It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy** (Diary 699). Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to our neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to absolve yourself from it (Diary 742).*

SACRAMENTOS - SIGNOS VIVOS DE SU DIVINA MISERICORDIA



Hoy celebramos el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Las lecturas señalan cómo el amor y la compasión de Dios son esenciales. ¡Cantamos con el salmista (Salmo 118) sobre cómo la misericordia de Dios dura para siempre! Una de las señales más importantes de la misericordia de Dios es que envió a su Hijo unigénito, que sufrió la crucifixión y la muerte, como nuestro Salvador y Mesías. A través de su resurrección, nos hizo partícipes y nos dio vida eterna.

En la segunda lectura de la primera Carta de San Juan encontramos tres signos significativos de los sacramentos de la Divina Misericordia. El agua representa nuestro bautismo, una manifestación de la purificación que sólo Dios puede darnos para liberarnos de nuestro pecado original. La sangre representa la alianza eucarística, mientras que el Espíritu representa nuestra regeneración. La Biblia dice: “El que cree que Jesucristo ha sido engendrado por Dios, vence al mundo” (1 Jn 5:1-6). En todos nuestros sacramentos podemos encontrar el amor y la misericordia de Dios; a través de ellos podemos encontrar la salvación, la sanación y la restauración que necesitamos tanto para nuestra vida presente como para la eterna. Después de la resurrección de Jesús, estableció el sacramento de la reconciliación, que es un sacramento por la excelencia de la Divina Misericordia. El Señor resucitado dio a sus apóstoles el poder de perdonar los pecados, diciendo: “A quienes perdonéis los pecados, les serán perdonados, y a quienes retengáis los pecados, les quedarán retenidos” (Jn 20, 19-23).

Asistir regularmente a los sacramentos de la reconciliación y a la Sagrada Eucaristía es necesario para que podamos compartir la Vida Divina de Jesús. Santa Teresa de Calcuta (Madre Teresa) lo presenta de esta manera: “Si oramos, crearemos; si creemos, amaremos; si amamos, serviremos. Sólo entonces ponemos en acción nuestro amor a Dios”.
