SAINT JOAN OF ARC



Prayer

Father in Heaven, Who hast
raised up in an admirable
manner, the virgin of Domremy,

thee and the Holy Spirit liveth

WE BELIEVE IN THE RESURRECTION



The Gospel message for this Third Sunday of Easter recounts one of the most popular stories of Jesus' apparitions to his disciples after his resurrection. It happened on the road to Emmaus. He walked and ate with them, and they recognized him for breaking bread. He wants to inform them that he isn't a ghost but a physical body (a glorified body). He shows us precisely what will happen to our bodies after our resurrection on the last day.

Resurrection is different from reincarnation and resuscitation. Reincarnation means that when a person dies, they will return to life in another form. If he lived a virtuous life, he would be rewarded and become a prince in the next life. Conversely, if he lived a sinful life, he would be punished and transformed into an animal or plant in the afterlife. As Christians, we do not believe in it.

Resuscitation simply means returning to the same life. This occurs in individuals who have been declared clinically dead and have lost all vital signs. He is then brought back to life or resuscitated. There is no chance of a new life. Both life and body will eventually expire and decay.

Resurrection is a totally different experience. There is a new life that is entirely unlike the earthly life. As seen in the Risen Lord, the physical body is the same, complete with the marks of nails on his hands and feet and the wound on his side caused by the spear. He can be physically touched and even eat fish before his disciples. But it is also a completely different body. This glorified body can pass through closed doors and solid walls and have multiple locations (which can be simultaneously present in different places). Time and space are no longer limited, and they cannot die. This body is the one that ascends to heaven to enjoy eternal life.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ANSELM



Indifferent toward religion as a young man, Anselm became one of the Church's greatest theologians and leaders. He received the title "Father of Scholasticism" for his attempt to analyze and illuminate the truths of faith through the aid of reason.

At 15, Anselm wanted to enter a monastery but was refused acceptance because of his father's opposition. Twelve years later, after careless disinterest in religion and years of worldly living, he finally fulfilled his desire to be a monk. He entered the monastery of Bec in Normandy, was elected three years later, and 15 years later, was unanimously chosen abbot.

Considered an original and independent thinker, Anselm was admired for his patience, gentleness, and teaching skills. Under his leadership, the Abbey of Bec became a monastic school, influential in philosophical and theological studies.

During these years, at the community's request, Anselm began publishing his theological works comparable to those of St. Augustine. His best-known work is the book *Cur Deus Homo* ("Why God Became Man").

Against his will, Anselm was appointed archbishop of Canterbury in 1093 at age 60. His appointment was initially opposed by England's King William Rufus, but later, it was accepted. Rufus persistently refused to cooperate with efforts to reform the Church.

Anselm finally went into voluntary exile until Rufus died in 1100. He was then recalled to England by Rufus' brother and successor, Henry I. Disagreeing fearlessly with Henry over the king's insistence on investing England's bishops, Anselm spent another three years in exile in Rome.

His care and concern extended to the very poorest people. Opposing the slave trade, Anselm obtained from the national council at Westminster the passage of a resolution prohibiting the sale of human beings.

Reflection: Like every true follower of Christ, Anselm had to carry his cross, especially in opposition and conflict with those in political control. Though personally a mild and gentle man and a lover of peace, he would not back off from conflict and persecution when principles were at stake.

NOSOTROS CREEMOS EN LA RESURRECCIÓN



El mensaje del Evangelio para este Tercer Domingo de Pascua relata una de las historias más populares de las apariciones de Jesús a sus discípulos después de su resurrección. Sucedió en el camino a Emaús. Caminó y comió con ellos, y lo reconocieron por partir el pan. Quiere informarles que no es un fantasma sino un cuerpo físico (un cuerpo glorificado). Nos muestra precisamente lo que sucederá con nuestros cuerpos después de nuestra resurrección en el último día.

La resurrección es diferente de la reencarnación y la reanimación. La reencarnación significa que cuando una persona muere, volverá a la vida en otra forma. Si vivía una vida virtuosa, sería recompensado y se convertiría en príncipe en la próxima vida. Por el contrario, si viviera una vida pecaminosa, sería castigado y transformado en un animal o una planta en el más allá. Como cristianos, no creemos en ello.

La reanimación significa simplemente volver a la misma vida. Esto ocurre en individuos que han sido declarados clínicamente muertos y han perdido todos los signos vitales. Luego lo devuelven a la vida o lo resucita. No hay posibilidad de una nueva vida. Tanto la vida como el cuerpo eventualmente expirarán y decaerán.

La resurrección es una experiencia totalmente diferente. Hay una nueva vida que es completamente diferente a la vida terrenal. Como se ve en el Señor Resucitado, el cuerpo físico es el mismo, completo con las marcas de los clavos en sus manos y pies y la herida en el costado causada por la lanza. Se le puede tocar físicamente e incluso comer pescado delante de sus discípulos. Pero también es un cuerpo completamente diferente. Este cuerpo glorificado puede atravesar puertas cerradas y paredes sólidas y tener múltiples ubicaciones (que pueden estar presentes simultáneamente en diferentes lugares). El tiempo y el espacio ya no están limitados y no pueden morir. Este cuerpo es el que asciende al cielo para disfrutar de la vida eterna.
