## CHRIST HAS OPENED THE WAY TO HEAVEN FOR US



Every Sunday or when celebrating a Solemnity in our Catholic Church, we profess in the Creed: “He ascended into Heaven.” The ascension of Christ is the fulfillment of God’s Divine plan. It is how Jesus, upon returning to the Father, left behind his words and works as teaching and testimony for our salvation on earth. Jesus did not end his mission when he went to heaven. He still accompanies his Church, and when we celebrate the mystery of his redemption, we do so with Him and in memory of Him. As Jesus is now with God in glory, so Jesus is with us now in Spirit: “*Lo, I am with you always*” (Mt 28:20).

In the celebration of the feast of the Ascension, we recognize one aspect of Jesus’ glorious resurrection, which is exalted. Jesus, who sits at the right hand of the Father, reigns in Heaven and on earth. In church, we make this proclamation when we profess our faith together and say that the Lord is “seated at the right hand of the Father,” meaning that He is solely responsible for the ongoing plan of salvation through the Holy Spirit, regardless of time, space, or culture. The Ascension means that Jesus, who completed His salvific suffering for our salvation, is now with his Father in glory. Being seated at the right hand of the Father is the fulfillment of “the prophet Daniel’s vision concerning the Son of Man: ‘To him was given dominion and glory and kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed’” (CCC #664).

Christ has opened the way to heaven for us (CCC #661). “Jesus Christ, the head of the Church, precedes us into the Father’s glorious kingdom so that we, the members of his Body, may live in the hope of one day being with him forever” (CCC #666).

“Jesus Christ, having entered the sanctuary of heaven once and for all, intercedes constantly for us as the mediator who assures us of the permanent outpouring of the Holy Spirit” (CCC #667).

### REMINDERS FOR PARENTS OF STUDENTS PREPARING TO RECEIVE THEIR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION ON SATURDAY, MAY 18, 2024

1. Rehearsal for First Holy Communion is on Wednesday, May 15, at 7:00 PM in the Church. **The meeting is mandatory, and at least one parent must attend.**
2. The Mass for First Holy Communion will be on Saturday, May 18, at 10:00 AM.
3. **All students receiving their First Holy Communion must arrive at the Social Hall no later than 8:30 AM.**
4. Parents and other family members will not be sitting with their child. There are no assigned seats for family members. Please prepare to arrive early as seating is limited, and the church pews fill quickly.

### PARENTS OF STUDENTS SCHEDULED TO RECEIVE THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2024

**ALL** students scheduled to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, September 14, your classes will continue until the last week of May.

For those students preparing for Confirmation and receiving their First Holy Communion on Saturday, May 18, your preparation for Confirmation continues after the summer recess. Classes resume on Thursday, August 22, at 6:00 PM and will be every Thursday through September 5.

### AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT ABOUT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION!

We are offering Continuing Formation classes for those children who have already received their First Holy Communion and will be enrolled in Grades 3, 4, 5, or 6 in the fall. Faith Formation is a life-long activity for all of us, regardless of age. Help your children grow into faith-filled practicing adult Catholics!

**Continuing Faith Formation classes will be offered in two separate formats:**

1. **HOME-STUDY:** This format requires coursework to be completed at home and a student’s required attendance at a once-a-month in-school class. Classes will be every first Sunday of the month during the academic year, beginning at 11:15 AM and ending at 12:30 PM.
2. **TRADITIONAL IN-SCHOOL CLASS:** This format requires weekly in-school class attendance every Saturday. Classes will begin at 10:00 AM and end at 11:15 AM.

All classes are in the Fr. Carlos Building. **The Continuing Faith Formation classes fee is only \$35 per student.** Registration for these classes will be at the same time as the registration for all other classes.

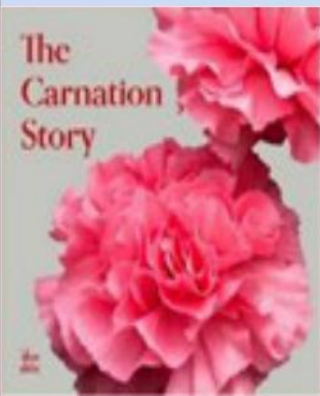

## THE CARNATION STORY



The carnation is one of the oldest cultivated flowers known since Greek and Roman times. According to some legends, the Greek botanist Theophrastus gave the flower its scientific name: dianthus, a combination of the Greek words dios, which means divine and anthos, the word for flower.

Moms and grandmothers alike can thank Philadelphia activist Anna Jarvis for the carnation tradition—and even the holiday itself. On May 10, 1908, Jarvis sent hundreds of white carnations, her late mother's favorite flower, to her hometown church in West Virginia for a celebration honoring all mothers. That same day, she hosted a similar event in Philadelphia.

Over the next few years, as the number of Mother's Day celebrations across the county increased, so did the popularity of the white carnation, which came to symbolize a mother's love. (Thanks to Jarvis' campaigning, Mother's Day became a national holiday in 1914 under President Woodrow Wilson.)

Decades later, another person living in the White House made carnations even more fashionable: Mamie Eisenhower. Callahan says the trendy first lady popularized the "peppermint" carnation—a flower with elegant red and white stripes.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: OUR LADY OF FATIMA



Between May 13 and October 13, 1917, three Portuguese children—Francisco and Jacinta Marto and their cousin Lucia dos Santos—received apparitions of Our Lady at Cova da Iria near Fatima, a city 110 miles north of Lisbon. Mary asked the children to pray the rosary for world peace, for the end of World War I, for sinners, and for the conversion of Russia.

Mary gave the children three secrets. Following the deaths of Francisco and Jacinta in 1919 and 1920, respectively, Lucia revealed the first secret in 1927. It concerned devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The second secret was a vision of hell. When Lucia grew up, she became a Carmelite nun and died in 2005 at 97.

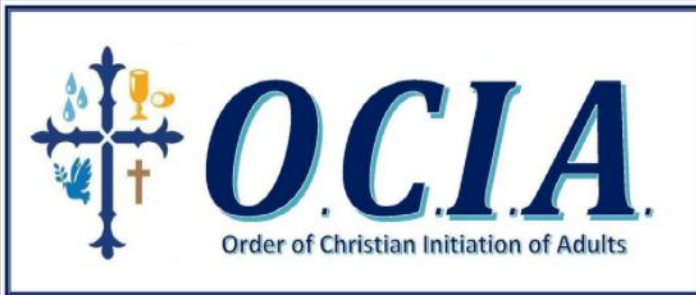
Pope John Paul II directed the Holy See's Secretary of State to reveal the third secret in 2000. It spoke of a "bishop in white" who was shot by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows into him. Many people linked this vision to the assassination attempt against Pope John Paul II in St. Peter's Square on May 13, 1981.

The feast of Our Lady of Fatima was approved by the local bishop in 1930, and was added to the Church's worldwide calendar in 2002.

**Reflection:** The message of Fatima is simple: Pray. Unfortunately, some people—not Sister Lucia—have distorted these revelations, making them into an apocalyptic event for which they are now the only reliable interpreters. They have, for example, claimed that Mary's request that the world be consecrated to her has been ignored. Sister Lucia agreed that Pope John Paul II's public consecration in St. Peter's Square on March 25, 1984, fulfilled Mary's request. The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith prepared a June 26, 2000, document explaining the "third secret."

Mary is perfectly honored when people generously imitate her response, "Let it be done to me as you say" (Luke 1:38). Mary can never be seen as a rival to Jesus or the Church's teaching authority, as exercised by the college of bishops united with the bishop of Rome.

## CRISTO NOS HA ABIERTO EL CAMINO AL CIELO



Cada domingo o al celebrar una Solemnidad en nuestra Iglesia Católica, profesamos en el Credo: “Subió al Cielo”. La ascensión de Cristo es el cumplimiento del plan Divino de Dios. Es así como Jesús al regresar al Padre dejó atrás sus palabras y obras como enseñanza y testimonio para nuestra salvación en la tierra. Jesús no terminó su misión cuando fue al cielo. Él todavía acompaña a su Iglesia, y cuando celebramos el misterio de su redención, lo hacemos con Él y en memoria de Él. Así como Jesús está ahora con Dios en gloria, así Jesús está ahora con nosotros en Espíritu: “He aquí, yo estoy con vosotros siempre” (Mt 28:20).

En la celebración de la fiesta de la Ascensión reconocemos un aspecto de la gloriosa resurrección de Jesús, que es exaltado. Jesús, que está sentado a la diestra del Padre, reina en el cielo y en la tierra. En la iglesia, hacemos esta proclamación cuando profesamos nuestra fe juntos y decimos que el Señor está “sentado a la diestra del Padre”, lo que significa que Él es el único responsable del plan continuo de salvación a través del Espíritu Santo, sin importar el tiempo, espacio o cultura. La Ascensión significa que Jesús, quien completó Su sufrimiento salvífico por nuestra salvación, ahora está con su Padre en gloria. Estar sentado a la diestra del Padre es el cumplimiento de “la visión del profeta Daniel acerca del Hijo del Hombre: ‘A él le fue dado dominio, gloria y reino, para que todos los pueblos, naciones y lenguas le sirvieran; su dominio es un dominio eterno, que no pasará, y su reino, uno que no será destruido’” (CIC #664).

Cristo nos ha abierto el camino al cielo (CIC #661). “Jesucristo, cabeza de la Iglesia, nos precede en el reino glorioso del Padre para que nosotros, miembros de su Cuerpo, vivamos con la esperanza de estar un día con él para siempre” (CIC #666).

“Jesucristo, habiendo entrado una vez para siempre en el Santuario del cielo, intercede constantemente por nosotros como mediador que nos asegura la efusión permanente del Espíritu Santo” (CIC #667).
