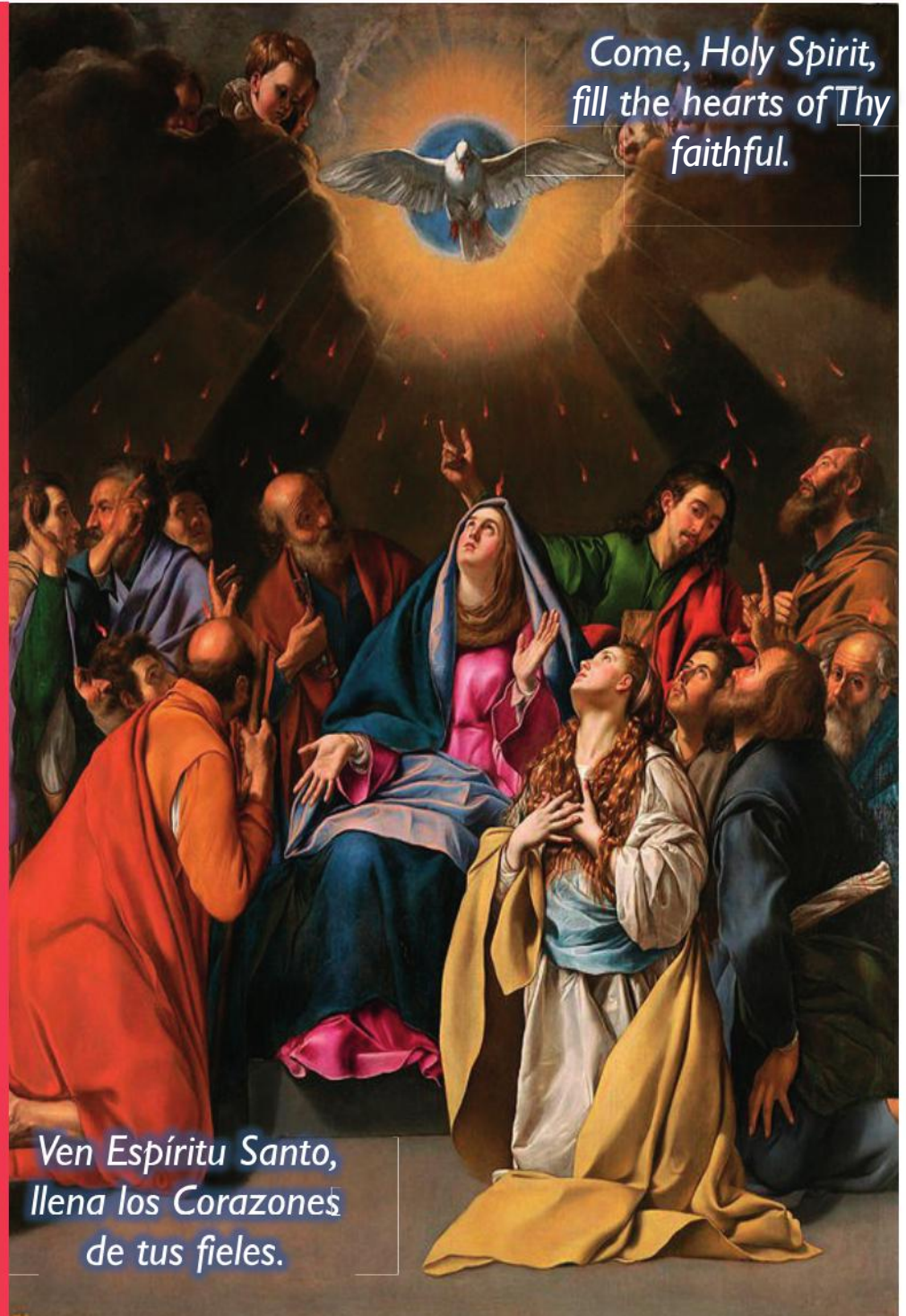

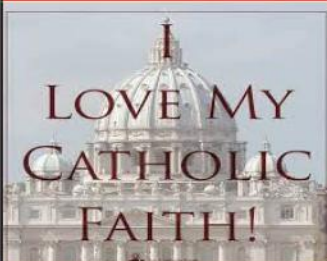

Today, we mark the end of Easter with the celebration of Pentecost. Pentecost was originally a Jewish harvest festival called "Shavuot." It is also the Festival of Weeks, commemorating the receipt of the Torah at Mount Sinai fifty days after the exodus from Egypt. For this reason, there were many people from all over in Jerusalem.

In Greek, Pentecost means fifty (pente) days after the Resurrection of the Lord. The apostles obeyed the Lord's command to stay in Jerusalem together and in prayer (Acts 1:4). Even though they were afraid and hiding from the Roman authorities, they were enthusiastic about the word of God and experiencing the love of Jesus, their Master. Jesus promised them the Holy Spirit, who would forever change their lives and the lives of many. Indeed, one day, the Holy Spirit came to them and transformed their fears into courage and ignorance into knowledge. With the power of heaven, they were prepared to share the good news of salvation with everyone.

Look at Peter's transformation after receiving the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. When the Sanhedrin questioned Jesus, Peter denied him, and out of all the apostles, only John was present at the crucifixion. But now Peter was transformed by receiving the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. He was not afraid anymore; he was fearless. Later, after Pentecost, he was brought before the Sanhedrin and warned not to preach about Jesus (Acts 4). After being released by the Sanhedrin, he resumed preaching. We can say that Peter became unrecognizable. When we see Peter's enormous transformation, we must ask ourselves, "What Peter am I now? The one that was afraid or the one that was fueled by the Holy Spirit?"

Are we proud to be Catholic? If we answer yes, it means we have received the power of the Holy Spirit and are ready to be true disciples of the Lord.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: PHILIP NERI



Philip Neri was a sign of contradiction, combining popularity with piety against the background of a corrupt Rome and a disinterested clergy: the whole post-Renaissance malaise.

At an early age, Philip abandoned the chance to become a businessman, moved to Rome from Florence, and devoted his life and individuality to God. After three years of philosophy and theology studies, he gave up any thought of ordination. The following 13 years were spent in a vocation unusual at the time—that of a layperson actively engaged in prayer and the apostolate.

As the Council of Trent (1545-63) was reforming the Church on a doctrinal level, Philip's appealing personality was winning him friends from all levels of society, from beggars to cardinals. He rapidly gathered around himself a group of laypersons won over by his audacious spirituality. Initially, they met as an informal prayer and discussion group and served poor people in Rome.

At the urging of his confessor, Philip was ordained a priest. He soon became an outstanding confessor, gifted with the knack of piercing the pretenses and illusions of others, though always charitable and often with a joke. Philip arranged talks, discussions, and prayers for his penitents in a room above the church. He sometimes led "excursions" to other churches, often with music and a picnic.

Some of Philip's followers became priests and lived together in community. This was the beginning of the Oratory, the religious institute he founded. Their life featured a daily afternoon service of four informal talks, with vernacular hymns and prayers. Giovanni Palestrina, one of Philip's followers, composed music for the services. The Oratory was finally approved after suffering through accusations of being an assembly of heretics, where laypersons preached and sang vernacular hymns!

Philip's advice was sought by many of the prominent figures of his day. He is one of the influential figures of the Counter-Reformation, mainly for converting to personal holiness many of the influential people within the Church itself. His characteristic virtues were humility and gaiety.

After spending a day hearing confessions and receiving visitors, Philip Neri suffered a hemorrhage and died on the feast of Corpus Christi in 1595. He was beatified in 1615 and canonized in 1622. Three centuries later, Cardinal John Henry Newman founded the first English-speaking house of the Oratory in London.

**Reflection:** Many wrongly feel that such an attractive and jocular personality as Philip's cannot be combined with an intense spirituality. Philip's life melts our rigid, narrow views of piety. His approach to sanctity was truly Catholic, all-embracing, and accompanied by a good laugh. Philip always wanted his followers to become not less but more human through their striving for holiness.

### MAY, MONTH OF OUR BLESSED MOTHER MARY

#### How Is the Month of Mary Celebrated?

May, dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, is marked by various special devotions and celebrations highlighting Mary's role as the Mother of God and her immaculate heart. Here are just a couple of ways how modern Catholic communities around the world observe this sacred month within the Liturgical calendar:

#### Crowning Ceremony

A significant highlight is the crowning ceremony of Mary's statue, symbolizing her as Queen of Heaven and Earth. This ceremony is usually accompanied by a procession, prayers, and music, emphasizing her royal dignity and the Christian piety she inspires. It is a vivid, communal expression of love and veneration.

#### Daily Recitation of Marian Prayers

One of the most common practices during the Month of Mary is the daily recitation of Marian prayers. This includes the Rosary, which meditates on the life of Mary and Jesus Christ, reflecting on their virtues and mysteries. Many faithful find this practice a way to seek special graces and deepen their connection to the divine.





Hoy marcamos el final de la Pascua con la celebración de Pentecostés. Pentecostés fue originalmente una fiesta judía de la cosecha llamada "Shavuot". También es el Festival de las Semanas, que conmemora la recepción de la Torá en el Monte Sinaí cincuenta días después del éxodo de Egipto. Por eso había mucha gente de todas partes en Jerusalén.

En griego, Pentecostés significa cincuenta (pente) días después de la Resurrección del Señor. Los apóstoles obedecieron el mandato del Señor de permanecer juntos en Jerusalén y en oración (Hechos 1:4). Aunque tenían miedo y se escondían de las autoridades romanas, se entusiasmaban con la palabra de Dios y experimentaban el amor de Jesús, su Maestro. Jesús les prometió el Espíritu Santo, que cambiaría para siempre sus vidas y las de muchos. De hecho, un día, el Espíritu Santo vino a ellos y transformó sus miedos en valor y su ignorancia en conocimiento. Con el poder del cielo, estaban preparados para compartir las buenas nuevas de salvación con todos.

Mire la transformación de Pedro después de recibir el Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. Cuando el Sanedrín cuestionó a Jesús, Pedro lo negó y, de todos los apóstoles, sólo Juan estuvo presente en la crucifixión. Pero ahora Pedro fue transformado al recibir el Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. Ya no tenía miedo; él ahora era valiente. Más tarde, después de Pentecostés, fue llevado ante el Sanedrín y se le advirtió que no predicara acerca de Jesús (Hechos 4). Después de ser liberado por el Sanedrín, reanudó la predicación. Podemos decir que Pedro se volvió irreconocible. Cuando vemos la enorme transformación de Pedro, debemos preguntarnos: "¿Qué Pedro soy yo ahora? ¿El que tuvo miedo o el que fue impulsado por el Espíritu Santo?"

¿Estamos orgullosos de ser católicos? Si respondemos que sí, significa que hemos recibido el poder del Espíritu Santo y estamos listos para ser verdaderos discípulos del Señor.
