## FAMILY OF THE LORD



The Gospel today shows us how to relate more profoundly to Jesus.

As he was teaching at the synagogue, someone informed him that his mother and cousins had arrived, probably to persuade him to rest and eat. But Jesus, apparently disregarding them, asked, "Who are my mother and my brothers?" (v. 33). Then, looking at his listeners, he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. [For] whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother" (vv. 34-35).

For Jesus, family and blood were vital. His love for Mary, his mother, his disciples, and all of humanity demonstrates that we are brothers and sisters of Him, but it is also a key to being a very close member. For Jesus, the best way to become his family is by obeying and following the will of God. Being obedient to God is the ideal way to truly be close to Him.

St. Thomas Aquinas (XIII century) says, "Obedience unites us so closely to God that in a way transforms us into Him so that we have no other will but His. If obedience is lacking, even prayer cannot be pleasing to God." When we obey God, we fuse our will to His will and practically and intimately become one with Him. Such is the example shown to us by the Blessed Mother. Her absolute "fiat," meaning "Let it be done," to God's will throughout her life effectively united her with God, thus transforming her from being a simple maiden of Nazareth into the "Woman Clothed with the Sun."

## OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

### INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF STUDENTS RECEIVING THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

Parents of students who are receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on September 14: There is a **mandatory** meeting on **Thursday, August 29, at 6:00 PM (note time change)** in the church. If you cannot attend, please make sure someone can attend in your place. Important information will be distributed at this meeting.

1. **For Confirmation prep students who just received their First Holy Communion on Saturday, May 18**, your preparation for Confirmation continues after the summer recess. Your classes resume on Thursday, August 22, at 6:00 PM and will be every Thursday through September 5.
2. **Summer Project:** All students preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, September 14, must complete the assigned Summer Project. The completed work for the Summer Project must be returned upon arrival at the Confirmandi Retreat on Saturday, September 7. *Check with your child to ensure they possess a copy of the Summer Project document. If not, call the Religious Education Office to make arrangements to pick up a copy.* Completion of this project will be factored into the final evaluation of a student's readiness to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.
3. **Confirmation Retreat:** All students preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, September 14, **must** attend the Confirmandi Retreat on Saturday, September 7. The retreat will begin at 8:30 AM and end after the 4:00 PM Mass. **All Confirmandi will attend this Mass. Attendance at the Retreat will be factored into the final evaluation of a student's readiness to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.**

**PROPER DRESS FOR CONFIRMANDI & SPONSORS:** The most important aspect of what to wear to church on the day of Confirmation is to keep the word "**modesty**" in mind. You are not to wear anything not appropriate for Church. You are not attending a dance party.

#### For the males:

- Suits or sports jacket (blazer) with a shirt, with or without a tie, would be most appropriate. If this is not possible, a shirt (any color) with buttons, collar, and sleeves is to be worn.
- Dress pants are to be worn.
- No ripped jeans and no tops with any type of writing on them.
- No sandals, slippers, sneakers, or work boots are to be worn. (Western boots are acceptable.)

#### For the females:

- Modest-looking dress with a hem that ends no shorter than just above the knee is most appropriate. If a dress is not possible, a skirt (with its hem ending no shorter than just above the knee) or dress pants would also be appropriate.
- Blouses must be modest in appearance, as they must be appropriate for church.
- No ripped jeans and no tops with any type of writing on them.
- No sneakers, slippers, or work boots are to be worn.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: BARNABAS



Barnabas, a Jew of Cyprus, comes as close as anyone outside the Twelve to being a full-fledged apostle. He was closely associated with St. Paul—he introduced Paul to Peter and the other apostles—and served as a mediator between the former persecutor and the still suspicious Jewish Christians.

When a Christian community developed at Antioch, Barnabas was sent as the official representative of the church of Jerusalem to incorporate them into the fold. He and Paul instructed in Antioch for a year, after which they took relief contributions to Jerusalem.

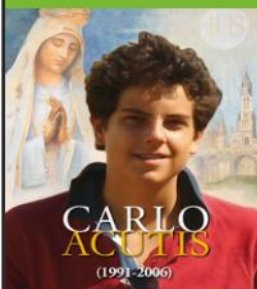
Later, Antioch officials sent Paul and Barnabas, now clearly seen as charismatic leaders, to preach to the Gentiles. Enormous success crowned their efforts. After a miracle at Lystra, the people wanted to sacrifice them as gods—Barnabas being Zeus, and Paul, Hermes—but the two said, “We are of the same nature as you, human beings. We proclaim good news that you should turn from these idols to the living God.”

But all was not peaceful. They were expelled from one town, they had to go to Jerusalem to clear up the ever-recurring controversy about circumcision, and even the best of friends can have differences. When Paul wanted to revisit the places they had evangelized, Barnabas wanted to take along his cousin John Mark, author of the *Gospel*, but Paul insisted that since Mark had deserted them once, he was not fit to take along now. The disagreement that followed was so sharp that Barnabas and Paul separated: Barnabas took Mark to Cyprus, and Paul took Silas to Syria. Later, they were reconciled—Paul, Barnabas, and Mark.

When Paul stood up to Peter for not eating with Gentiles for fear of his Jewish friends, we learn that “even Barnabas was carried away by their hypocrisy” (see Galatians 2:1-13).

**Reflection:** Barnabas is spoken of simply as one who dedicated his life to the Lord. He was a man “filled with the Holy Spirit and faith. Thereby, large numbers were added to the Lord.” Even when he and Paul were expelled from Antioch in Pisidia—modern-day Turkey—they were “filled with joy and the Holy Spirit.”

## CARLO ACUTIS TO BE FIRST MILLENNIAL SAINT



Pope Francis has recognized a miracle attributed to the intercession of Blessed Carlo Acutis, paving the way for him to become the first millennial saint. The Italian computer-coding teenager who died of cancer in 2006 is known for his great devotion to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

The recognition of the second miracle attributed to Acutis’ intercession makes it possible that Acutis could be canonized during the Catholic Church’s 2025 Jubilee Year.

In a decree on May 23, Pope Francis approved the miraculous healing of a 21-year-old girl from Costa Rica named Valeria Valverde, who was near death after seriously injuring her head in a bicycle accident while studying in Florence in 2022. After the girl underwent an emergency craniotomy to reduce intracranial pressure, the family was told that her situation was very critical and that she could die at any moment, according to the Vatican’s Dicastery for the Causes of Saints.

Six days after the accident, Valeria’s mother went on a pilgrimage to Assisi to pray for the healing of her daughter at the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, leaving a written note. On that same day, Valeria began to breathe on her own, and on the following day, she recovered the use of her upper limbs and partly recovered her speech. Valeria was discharged from the intensive care unit ten days after her mother’s pilgrimage. She underwent further tests that showed that the hemorrhagic right temporal cortical contusion in her brain had completely disappeared. Contrary to medical predictions, Valeria spent only one week in physical therapy. On September 2, 2022, two months after her accident, she went on a pilgrimage to Carlo Acutis’ tomb in Assisi with her mother to celebrate her complete healing.

**The First Millennial Saint:** Born in 1991, Acutis is the first millennial to be beatified by the Catholic Church.

Shortly after his first Communion at seven, Carlo told his mother: “To always be united to Jesus: This is my life plan.” To accomplish this, Carlo sought to attend daily Mass as often as possible at the parish church across the street from his elementary school in Milan. Carlo called the Eucharist “my highway to heaven,” and he did all in his power to make this presence known. His witness inspired his own parents to return to practicing the Catholic faith and his Hindu au pair to convert and be baptized.

Carlo was a tech-savvy kid who loved computers, animals, and video games. His spiritual director has recalled that Carlo was convinced that the evidence of Eucharistic miracles could be persuasive in helping people to realize that Jesus is present at every Mass. Throughout two-and-a-half years, Carlo worked with his family to put together an exhibition on Eucharistic miracles that premiered in 2005 during the Year of the Eucharist proclaimed by Pope John Paul II and has since gone on to be displayed at thousands of parishes on five continents.

Many of Carlo’s classmates, friends, and family members have testified how he brought them closer to God. Carlo was very open and not shy about speaking with his classmates and anyone he met about the things he loved: the Mass, the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, and heaven.

## FAMILIA DEL SEÑOR



El Evangelio de hoy nos muestra cómo relacionarnos más profundamente con Jesús.

Mientras enseñaba en la sinagoga, alguien le informó que su madre y sus primos habían llegado, probablemente para convencerlo de que descansara y comiera. Pero Jesús, aparentemente sin hacerles caso, preguntó: “¿Quiénes son mi madre y mis hermanos?” (v. 33). Luego, mirando a sus oyentes, dijo: “Aquí están mi madre y mis hermanos. [Porque] el que hace la voluntad de Dios, ése es mi hermano, mi hermana y mi madre” (vv. 34-35).

Para Jesús, la familia y la sangre eran vitales. Su amor por María, su madre, sus discípulos y toda la humanidad demuestra que somos hermanos y hermanas de Él, pero también es la clave para ser un miembro muy cercano. Para Jesús, la mejor manera de llegar a ser su familia es obedeciendo y siguiendo la voluntad de Dios. Ser obediente a Dios es la forma ideal de estar verdaderamente cerca de Él.

Santo Tomás de Aquino (siglo XIII) dice: “La obediencia nos une tan estrechamente a Dios que de alguna manera nos transforma en Él, de modo que no tenemos otra voluntad que la suya. Si falta la obediencia, ni siquiera la oración puede agradar a Dios”. Cuando obedecemos a Dios, fusionamos nuestra voluntad con la Suya y prácticamente e íntimamente llegamos a ser uno con Él. Tal es el ejemplo que nos muestra la Santísima Virgen. Su absoluto “fiat”, que significa “hágase”, a la voluntad de Dios a lo largo de su vida la unió efectivamente con Dios, transformándola de una simple doncella de Nazaret a la “Mujer Vestida del Sol”.

Padres de estudiantes que recibirán el Sacramento de la Confirmación el 14 de septiembre: Hay una reunión **obligatoria el jueves 29 de agosto a las 6:00 PM** (tenga en cuenta el cambio de hora) en la iglesia. Si no puede asistir, asegúrese de que alguien pueda asistir en su lugar. En esta reunión se distribuirá información importante.

1. **Para los estudiantes que preparan la Confirmación y que acaban de recibir su Primera Comunión el sábado 18 de mayo**, su preparación para la Confirmación continúa después del receso de verano. Sus clases se reanudan el jueves 22 de agosto a las 6:00 p.m. y serán todos los jueves hasta el 5 de septiembre.
2. **Proyecto de Verano:** Todos los estudiantes que se preparan para recibir el Sacramento de la Confirmación el sábado 14 de septiembre deben completar el Proyecto de Verano asignado. El trabajo terminado para el Proyecto de Verano debe ser devuelto a su llegada al Retiro Confirmandi el sábado 7 de septiembre. *Consulte con su hijo para asegurarse de que posea una copia del documento del Proyecto de Verano. De lo contrario, llame a la Oficina de Educación Religiosa para hacer arreglos para recoger una copia. La finalización de este proyecto se tendrá en cuenta en la evaluación final de la preparación del estudiante para recibir el Sacramento de la Confirmación.*
3. **Retiro de Confirmación:** Todos los estudiantes que se preparan para recibir el Sacramento de la Confirmación el sábado 14 de septiembre **deben** asistir al Retiro de Confirmandi el sábado 7 de septiembre. El retiro comenzará a las 8:30 AM y terminará después de la misa de las 4:00 PM. *Todos los Confirmandos asistirán a esta Misa. La asistencia al Retiro se tendrá en cuenta en la evaluación final de la preparación del estudiante para recibir el Sacramento de la Confirmación.*

**VESTIMENTA APROPIADA PARA CONFIRMANDI Y PADRINOS:** El aspecto más importante de qué ponerse para ir a la iglesia el día de la Confirmación es tener en cuenta la palabra "**modestia**". No debes usar nada que no sea apropiado para la Iglesia. No vas a asistir a una fiesta de baile.

#### Para los machos:

- Lo más apropiado sería un traje o chaqueta deportiva (blazer) con camisa, con o sin corbata. Si esto no es posible, se debe usar una camisa (de cualquier color) con botones, cuello y mangas.
- Se deben usar pantalones de vestir.
- Nada de jeans rotos y sin tops con ningún tipo de escritura.
- No se deben usar sandalias, pantuflas, zapatillas de deporte o botas de trabajo. (Las botas occidentales son aceptables).

#### Para las hembras:

- Lo más apropiado es un vestido de aspecto modesto con un dobladillo que no termine más corto que justo por encima de la rodilla. Si un vestido no es posible, una falda (con el dobladillo terminado no más corto que justo por encima de la rodilla) o pantalones de vestir también serían apropiados.
- Las blusas deben ser modestas en apariencia, ya que deben ser apropiadas para la iglesia.
- Nada de jeans rotos y sin tops con ningún tipo de escritura.
- No se deben usar zapatillas, pantuflas o botas de trabajo.
