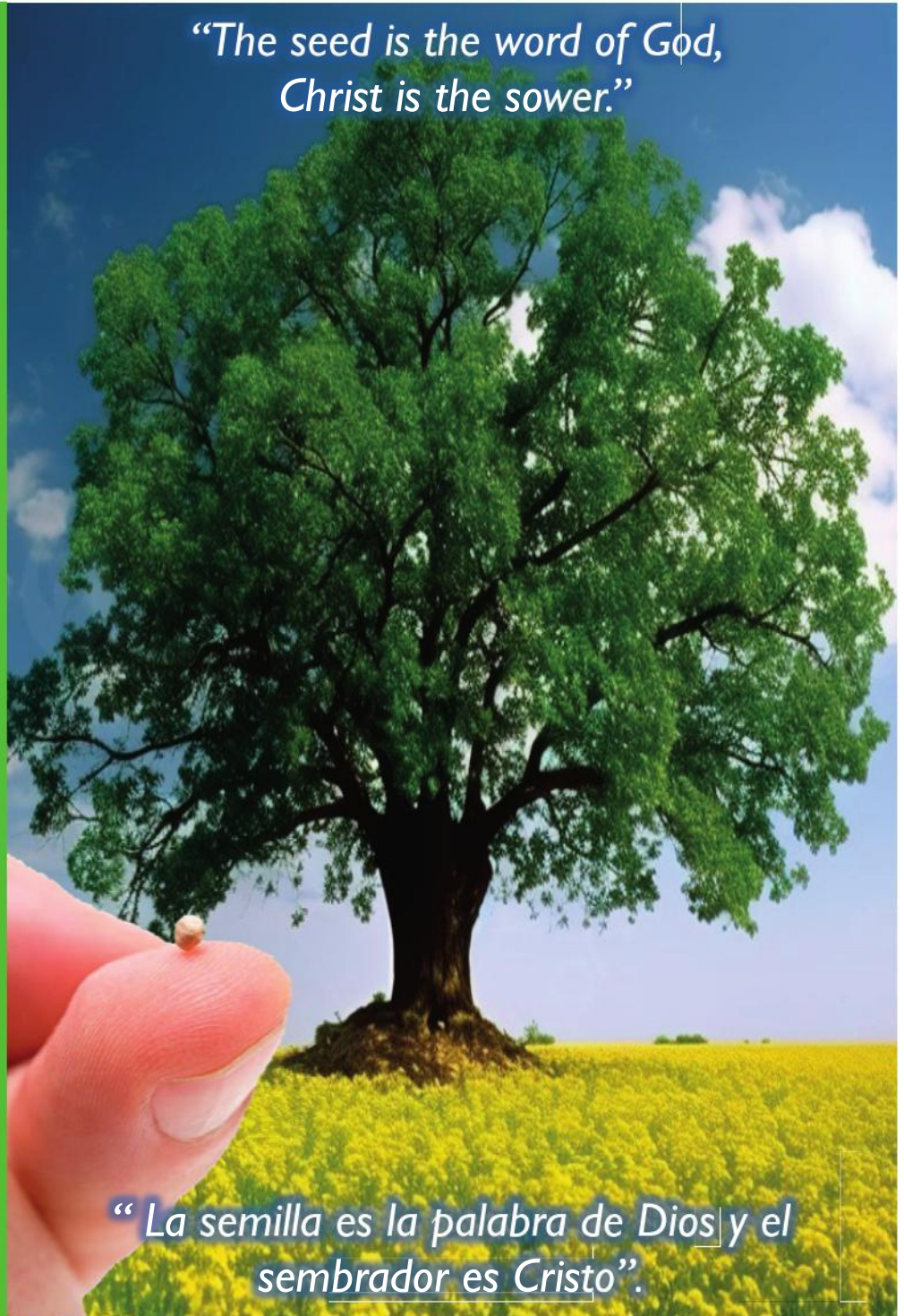

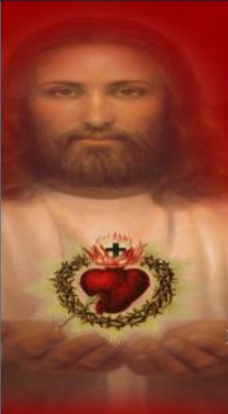

## THE SEEDS OF FAITH



The Gospel for this Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time presents two parables or explanations from Jesus about the Kingdom of Heaven. Through the simplicity of His words, the Lord teaches us that we can work together to receive the goodness that comes to us from Heaven. He is in charge of the seed of our faith. After it is placed in our lives, we must plant and take very good care of it, and it will produce a lot of fruit for our salvation. The kingdom he has invited us to is both simple and peaceful. Anyone who has sincerity in their heart can seek it. Sowing a seed of faith in Christ is the most straightforward way to enter it. This is the key.

Hence, in the second parable, the mustard seed, the smallest seed, refers to our faith. "If you have faith like a grain of mustard seed...nothing will be impossible for you" (Mt 17:20). This includes entering the kingdom of God. However, it is important to note that the authenticity of our faith must be tested (James 1:3; 1 Peter 1:7).

Faith grows, and when it does, it achieves great things. As it matures, it directs us towards Christ and, consequently, his kingdom. Our faith also draws others to Christ and his Church, a visible sign of God's kingdom on earth. As Christ says, "The birds of the air come to take shelter under its branches."

How does our faith draw others to Christ? When we demonstrate or bear a grand testimony of our individual and collective faith, the result is excellent. The ability to touch and transform lives is possible.

## OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

### REGISTRATION FOR THE 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR RESUMES TUESDAY, JUNE 18

Registration days are Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday from 10:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Classes are filling up, and some are nearing their legal capacity. Once they reach their capacity, we cannot add students.

Just a Reminder: Parents, if your child has been Baptized and has already received their First Holy Communion, they have an obligation to attend Mass every week, just as you do, assuming you have been Baptized and have received your First Holy Communion. (If you have not, consider entering our OCIA program). Do not keep your children from attending!

If you haven't attended Mass in a while, you must go to Confession. The same goes for your children. There is no better way to thank God than attending Mass and receiving the Eucharist!

### FOR PARENTS OF STUDENTS RECEIVING THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

If your child is receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, September 14, you must attend a meeting on Thursday, August 29, at 6:00 PM (note the time change) in the church. If you cannot attend, please make sure someone can attend in your place. Important information will be distributed at this meeting.

1. Summer Project (Requirement for all Confirmation prep students who received their First Holy Communion on Saturday, May 18, your preparation for Confirmation continues after the summer recess. Your classes resume on Thursday, August 22, at 6:00 PM and will be every Thursday through September 5.
2. Summer Project (Requirement for all Confirmation Students): All students preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, September 14, must complete the assigned Summer Project. The completed work must be returned upon arrival at the Confirmandi Retreat on Saturday, September 7. Completion of this project will be factored into the final evaluation of a student's readiness to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they do not have a copy, contact the office!
3. Confirmation Retreat: All students preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, September 14, must attend the Confirmandi Retreat on Saturday, September 7. The retreat will begin at 8:30 AM and end after the 4:30 PM Mass. All Confirmandi will attend this Mass. Attendance at the Retreat will be factored into the final evaluation of a student's readiness to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

**SAINT OF THE WEEK: ALOYSIUS GONZAGA**



The Lord can make saints anywhere, even amid the brutality and license of Renaissance life. Florence was the “mother of piety” for Aloysius Gonzaga despite his exposure to a “society of fraud, dagger, poison, and lust.” As a son of a princely family, he grew up in royal courts and army camps. His father wanted Aloysius to be a military hero.

At age seven, Aloysius experienced a profound spiritual quickening. His prayers included the Office of Mary, the Psalms, and other devotions. At age nine, he came from his hometown of Castiglione to Florence to be educated. By age 11, he was teaching catechism to poor children, fasting three days a week, and practicing great austerities. When he was 13 years old, he traveled with his parents and the Empress of Austria to Spain and acted as a page in the court of Philip II. The more Aloysius saw of court life, the more disillusioned he became, seeking relief in learning about the lives of saints.

A book about the experience of Jesuit missionaries in India sparked his interest in joining the Society of Jesus, and in Spain, his decision solidified. This marked the beginning of a four-year struggle with his father. Despite the influence of eminent churchmen and laypeople who tried to convince Aloysius to follow a 'normal' path, he stood firm in his resolve. Eventually, he triumphed, renounced his right to succession, and was welcomed into the Jesuit novitiate.

Like other seminarians, Aloysius was faced with a new kind of penance—that of accepting different ideas about the exact nature of penance. He was obliged to eat more and to play with the other students. He was forbidden to pray except at stated times. He spent four years studying philosophy and had St. Robert Bellarmine as his spiritual adviser.

In 1591, a plague struck Rome. The Jesuits opened a hospital of their own. The superior general himself and many other Jesuits rendered personal service. Aloysius caught the disease because he nursed patients, washed them, and made their beds. A fever persisted after his recovery, and he was so weak he could scarcely rise from bed. Yet he maintained his great discipline of prayer, knowing that he would die three months later within the octave of Corpus Christi at the age of 23.

**Reflection:** As a saint who fasted, scourged himself, sought solitude and prayer, and did not look on the faces of women, Aloysius seems an unlikely patron of youth in a society where asceticism is confined to training camps of football teams and boxers, and sexual permissiveness has little left to permit. Can an overweight and air-conditioned society deprive itself of anything? It will do so when it discovers a reason, as Aloysius did. The motivation for letting God purify us is the experience of God loving us in prayer.

## LAS SEMILLAS DE LA FE



El Evangelio de este Undécimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario presenta dos parábolas o explicaciones de Jesús sobre el Reino de los Cielos. A través de la sencillez de Sus palabras, el Señor nos enseña que podemos trabajar juntos para recibir el bien que nos llega del Cielo. Él está a cargo de la semilla de nuestra fe. Después de que sea colocado en nuestras vidas, debemos plantarlo y cuidarlo muy bien, y producirá muchos frutos para nuestra salvación. El reino al que nos ha invitado es sencillo y pacífico. Cualquiera que tenga sinceridad en su corazón puede buscarla. Sembrar una semilla de fe en Cristo es la forma más sencilla de entrar en ella. Ésta es la clave.

Por eso, en la segunda parábola, la semilla de mostaza, la semilla más pequeña, se refiere a nuestra fe. “Si tenéis fe como un grano de mostaza... nada os será imposible” (Mt 17,20). Esto incluye entrar al reino de Dios. Sin embargo, es importante señalar que la autenticidad de nuestra fe debe ser probada (Santiago 1:3; I Pedro 1:7).

La fe crece y, cuando lo hace, logra grandes cosas. A medida que madura, nos orienta hacia Cristo y, en consecuencia, hacia su reino. Nuestra fe también atrae a otros a Cristo y su Iglesia, señal visible del reino de Dios en la tierra. Como dice Cristo: “Las aves del cielo vienen a refugiarse bajo sus ramas”.

¿Cómo nuestra fe atrae a otros a Cristo? Cuando demostramos o damos un gran testimonio de nuestra fe individual y colectiva, el resultado es excelente. La capacidad de tocar y transformar vidas es posible.
