## THE PRAYER AWAKES GOD



Jesus' apostles began their journey knowing the route and were familiar with the Sea of Galilee. Men raised around the Sea of Galilee and fishermen who had worked there for years found nothing extraordinary. Crossing was a routine that everyone followed regularly. At the end of a long day at work, Christ fell asleep on his friends' fishing boat. Due to a sudden storm on the lake, waves crashed into the boat, causing such danger that the apostles asked their Lord for his assistance.

Christ demonstrated his power over the natural event and should be recognized as having authority exclusive to God. God made his power and love visible. The disciples ask among themselves after the calming of the sea: "Who can this be that the wind and sea obey him?" The unspoken but obvious answer is that this is Jesus Christ, the Son of God. The tumultuous sea would only be calmed by God, and if Christ is God, he possesses such powers.

Interestingly, Jesus performs his miracle in response to a request. The disciples' prayers cause Jesus to act as he did to prevent the disciple-travelers from drowning.

Awaking their Lord to alert him of impending danger, Jesus quickly performed the miracle and asked his followers: "Why are you so terrified? Why are you lacking in faith?" That is the point of it all: have faith in good times and bad; pray to God when things go well and not so well. But how easy is it to forget that when we are "happy," in the worldly sense of health and wealth, peace and prosperity, or "sad," when trials and distress beset us? Do we always remember to thank God and seek his help?

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: JOHN THE BAPTIST



Jesus called John the greatest of all those who had preceded him: “I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John...” But John would have agreed completely with what Jesus added: “[Y]et the least in the kingdom of God is greater than he” (Luke 7:28).

John spent his time in the desert as an ascetic. He began to announce the coming of the Kingdom, and to call everyone to a fundamental reformation of life. His purpose was to prepare the way for Jesus. His baptism, he said, was for repentance. But one would come who would baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. John was not worthy even to untie his sandals. His attitude toward Jesus was: “He must increase; I must decrease” (John 3:30).

John was humbled to find among the crowd of sinners who came to be baptized the one he already knew to be the Messiah. “I need to be baptized by you” (Matthew 3:14b). But Jesus insisted, “Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness” (Matthew 3:15b). Jesus, true and humble human as well as eternal God, was eager to do what was required of any good Jew. Jesus thus publicly entered the community of those awaiting the Messiah. But making himself part of that community, he made it truly messianic.

The greatness of John, his pivotal place in the history of salvation, is seen in the great emphasis Luke gives to the announcement of his birth and the event itself—both made prominently parallel to the same occurrences in the life of Jesus. John attracted countless people to the banks of the Jordan, and it occurred to some people that he might be the Messiah. But he constantly deferred to Jesus, even sending away some of his followers to become the first disciples of Jesus.

Perhaps John’s idea of the coming of the Kingdom of God was not perfectly fulfilled in the public ministry of Jesus. For whatever reason, when he was in prison, he sent his disciples to ask Jesus if he was the Messiah. Jesus’ answer showed that the Messiah would be a figure like the Suffering Servant in Isaiah. John himself would share in the pattern of messianic suffering, losing his life to the revenge of Herodias.

**Reflection:** John challenges us Christians to adopt the fundamental attitude of Christianity—total dependence on the Father in Christ. Except for the Mother of God, no one had a higher function in unfolding salvation. Yet the least in the Kingdom, Jesus said, is greater than he, for the pure gift that the Father gives. The attractiveness and austerity of John and his fierce courage in denouncing evil stem from the fundamental and total placing of his life within the will of God.

## NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

*Luke 10: After this, the Lord appointed seventy others and sent them on ahead of him, two by two, into every town and place where he himself was about to go. And he said to them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Go your way; behold, I am sending you out...”*



Throughout the last three years, the Church has been in an ecclesial and personal revival centered on Christ and His real presence in the Eucharist.

Now, thousands of pilgrims, like the 70 disciples that Jesus sent out ahead of him in Luke Chapter 10, are coming from the four corners of our country in Eucharistic procession to Indianapolis for the first Eucharistic Congress in 83 years.

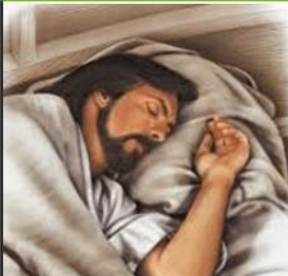

The perpetual silent adoration will be punctuated by a HOLY HOUR each evening at 6:00 PM, including prayers, readings, reflections, and music.

## LA ORACIÓN DESPIERTA A DIOS



Los Apóstoles de Jesús comenzaron su viaje conociendo la ruta y conocían el Mar de Galilea. Los hombres criados alrededor del Mar de Galilea y los pescadores que habían trabajado allí durante años no encontraron nada extraordinario. Cruzar era una rutina que todos seguían regularmente. Al final de un largo día de trabajo, Cristo se quedó dormido en el barco pesquero de sus amigos. Debido a una tormenta repentina en el lago, las olas chocaron contra la barca, causando tal peligro que los apóstoles pidieron ayuda a su Señor.

Cristo demostró su poder sobre el acontecimiento natural y se le debe reconocer que tiene autoridad exclusiva de Dios. Dios hizo visible su poder y su amor. Los discípulos se preguntan entre ellos después de que el mar se calmó: “¿Quién será éste que el viento y el mar le obedecen?” La respuesta tácita pero obvia es que este es Jesucristo, el Hijo de Dios. El mar tumultuoso sólo sería calmado por Dios, y si Cristo es Dios, posee tales poderes.

Curiosamente, Jesús realiza su milagro en respuesta a un pedido. Las oraciones de los discípulos hacen que Jesús actúe como lo hizo para evitar que los discípulos-viajeros se ahogaran.

Despertando a su Señor para alertarlo del peligro inminente, Jesús rápidamente realizó el milagro y preguntó a sus seguidores: “¿Por qué están tan aterrorizados? ¿Por qué os falta fe?” Ese es el punto de todo: tener fe en los buenos y en los malos tiempos; orar a Dios cuando las cosas van bien y no tan bien. Pero, ¿qué tan fácil es olvidar eso cuando estamos “felices”, en el sentido mundano de salud y riqueza, paz y prosperidad, o “tristeza”, cuando nos acosan las pruebas y la angustia? ¿Recordamos siempre agradecer a Dios y buscar su ayuda?
