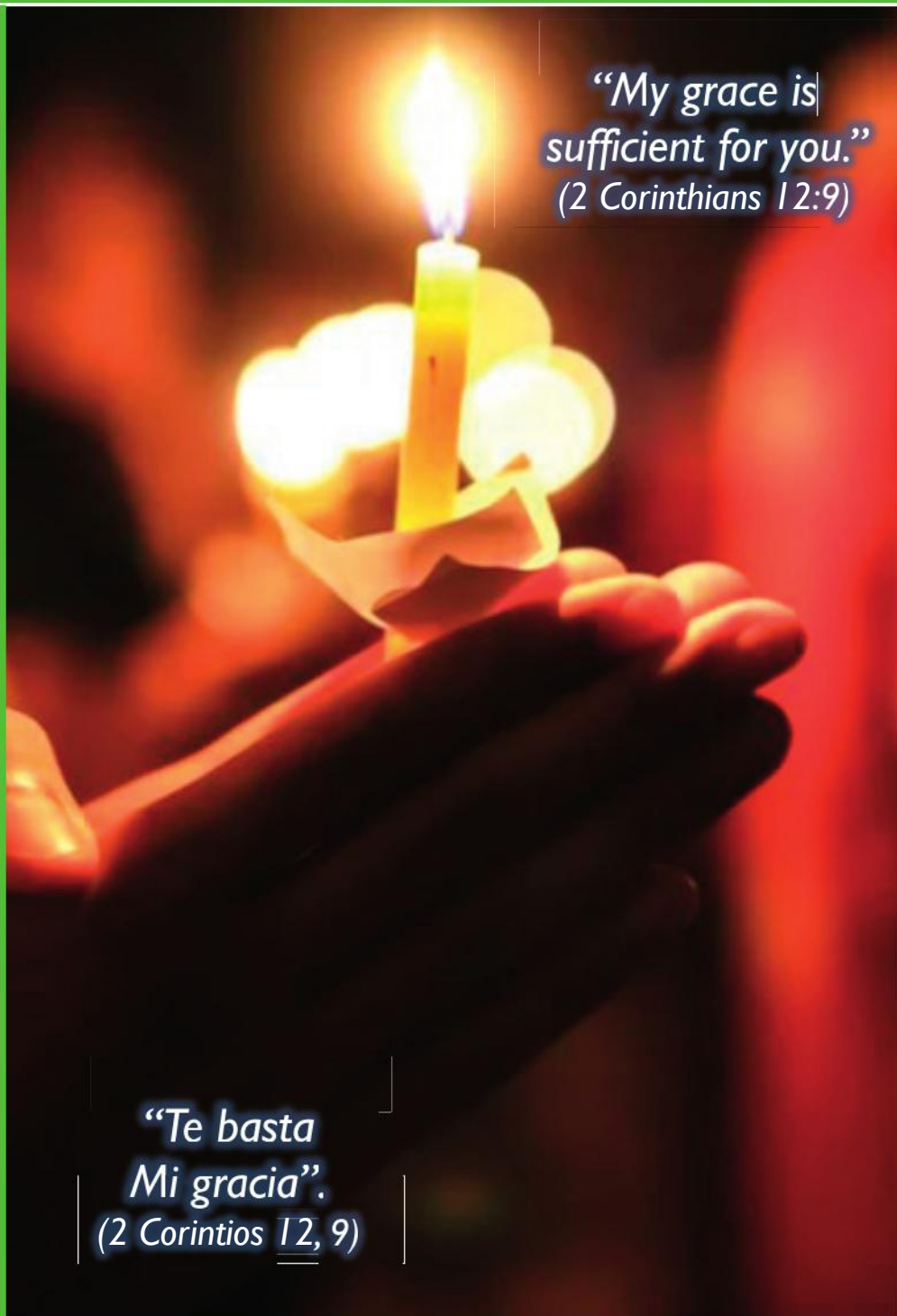

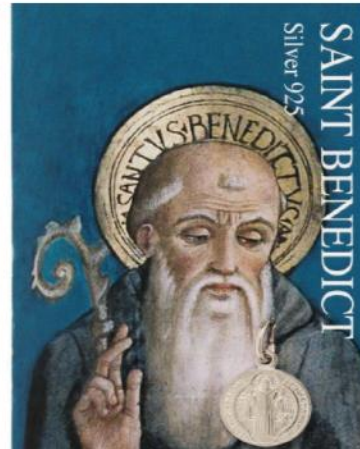

## FAITH TRANSFORMS OUR LIVES



In Mark's Gospel (5:21-43) last week, we heard about two miracles in which faith is the protagonist. One miracle is a perfect example of the prayer of intercession, Jairus asking for health for his daughter. The other healing is a real miracle for the woman with hemorrhages. The woman was healed, and the child was saved from death.

What steps will allow us to take advantage of that healing touch? What are some ways we can touch Jesus? What are the ways He can touch us? Can we no longer receive healing from Jesus? Of course, we can! Jesus can do it through His Spirit. It was the reason why the Holy Spirit came

on Pentecost. Jesus can touch and may be touched in the Spirit. We literally touch Jesus when we receive Him in the Eucharist, and He becomes one with us. His body and blood circulate throughout our entire body; our blood becomes one with His blood. A great miracle! We will see the glory of God in our lives if we believe and place our needs in the hands of the Lord. Faith has a profound effect on our lives. We are compelled to stop our sufferings and fill our hearts with confidence and hope, knowing that if we connect with Jesus, we will be saved.

Jesus will also heal us if we touch Him or allow ourselves to be touched. Like the sick woman and Jairus, we must have faith in Him.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: BENEDICT



Unfortunately, no contemporary biography of a man who has exercised the greatest influence on monasticism in the West was written. Benedict is well recognized in the later Dialogues of St. Gregory, but these are sketches to illustrate miraculous elements of his career.

Benedict was born into a distinguished family in central Italy, studied in Rome, and was drawn to monasticism early in life. At first, he became a hermit, leaving a depressing world—pagan armies on the march, the Church torn by schism, people suffering from war, and morality at a low ebb.

He soon realized he could not live a hidden life in a small town any better than a large city, so he withdrew to a cave high in the mountains for three years. Some monks chose Benedict as their leader for a while but found his strictness not to their taste. Still, the shift from hermit to community life had begun for him. He had an idea of gathering various families of monks into one “Grand Monastery” to give them the benefit of unity, fraternity, and permanent worship in one house. Finally, he began to build what was to become one of the most famous monasteries in the world—Monte Cassino, commanding three narrow valleys running toward the mountains north of Naples.

The gradually developed rule prescribed a life of liturgical prayer, study, manual labor, and living together in a community under a common abbot. Benedictine asceticism is known for its moderation, and Benedictine charity has always shown concern for the people in the surrounding countryside. During the Middle Ages, all monasticism in the West was gradually brought under the Rule of St. Benedict.

Today, the Benedictine family is represented by two branches: the Benedictine Federation, encompassing the men and women of the Order of St. Benedict, and the Cistercians, men and women of the Order of Cistercians of the Strict Observance.

**Reflection:** The Church has been blessed through Benedictine devotion to the liturgy, in its celebration with rich and proper ceremony in the great abbeys, and through the scholarly studies of many of its members. Liturgy is sometimes confused with guitars or choirs, Latin or Bach. We should be grateful to those who preserve and adapt the genuine tradition of worship in the Church.

## THE POPES AND THE POWER AND SIGNIFICANCE OF THE ST. BENEDICT MEDAL



The St. Benedict Medal, recognized by the Catholic Church, possesses great power of exorcism and liberation from demonic influences. However, it is essential to understand that its efficacy does not lie solely in its physical appearance or the engraved prayer, as this would fall into superstition. Rather, the true power of the medal resides in Christ Himself, who grants it to the Church through the fervent disposition of those who use it.

### **The Origins and Miraculous Healing Associated with the Medal:**

Originating from ancient times, the effectiveness of the St. Benedict Medal or Cross deserves special attention. Its popularity surged in the second decade of the 11th century when a man named Brunone, residing in Alsace, was miraculously healed from a severe illness after being presented with the aforementioned Medal. Following his recovery, Brunone became a Benedictine monk and was later elected Pope, taking the name Leo IX (later canonized as a saint). In 1742, Pope Benedict XIV approved the Medal and granted indulgences to those who carried it with faith.

### **Deciphering the Symbolism on the Front and Back of the Medal:**

The front of the Medal portrays an image of St. Benedict at its center. In his right hand, he holds a cross, symbolizing the saving power of Christ and the evangelizing work of the Benedictines throughout the centuries. To his right, a broken cup signifies the rebellious monks who attempted to poison St. Benedict but failed when he made the sign of the cross over it. On his left, a raven holds a poisoned loaf of bread, another failed attempt on the saint's life.

Above St. Benedict's head is "*Crux Sancti Patris Benedicti*" (Cross of the Holy Father Benedict). Surrounding the edge are the words: "*Ejus en obitu nostro praesentia muniamus*" (May we be strengthened by his presence in our hour of death.). Beneath his feet, the letters "*EX SM CASINO MDCCCLXX*" (From the holy Monte Cassino, 1880) are inscribed.

The reverse side of the Medal features a large cross as its dominant symbol. Each of the cross's four sides contains the initials: "*C.S.P.B.*" (*Crux Sancti Patris Benedicti*), meaning "*Cross of the Holy Father Benedict.*" In the vertical line of the cross, the initials "*C.S.S.M.L.*" (*Crux Sacra Sit Mihi Lux*) signify "*May the Holy Cross be my light,*" while the initials "*N.D.S.M.D.*" (*Non Draco Sit Mihi Dux*) in the horizontal line express "*May the devil not be my guide.*"

Around the border, starting from the top and progressing clockwise, are the initials of the exorcism prayer:

"*V.R.S.*" (*Vade Retro Satana*): "*Begone, Satan*" "*N.S.M.V.*" (*Non Suade Mihi Vana*): "*Do not suggest to me vain things*" "*S.M.Q.L.*" (*Sunt Mala Quae Libas*): "*What you offer is evil*" "*I.V.B.*" (*Ipse Venena Bibas*): "*Drink your own poison.*"

The prayer concludes with "*PAX*" (Peace). Thus, the prayer recites as follows: "*May the Holy Cross be my light, and may the devil not be my guide. Begone, Satan. Do not suggest to me vain things. What you offer is evil. Drink your poison. Peace.*"

La otra curación es un verdadero milagro, para la mujer con hemorragias la mujer fue sanada y el niño fue salvado de la muerte.

¿Qué pasos nos permitirán aprovechar ese toque sanador? ¿Cuáles son algunas maneras en que podemos tocar a Jesús? ¿Cuáles son las maneras en que Él puede tocarnos? ¿Ya no podemos recibir sanidad de Jesús? ¡Por supuesto que podemos! Jesús puede hacerlo a través de Su Espíritu. Fue la razón por la cual el Espíritu Santo vino en Pentecostés. Jesús puede tocar y puede ser tocado en el Espíritu. Literalmente tocamos a Jesús cuando lo recibimos en la Eucaristía y Él se vuelve uno con nosotros. Su cuerpo y sangre circulan por todo nuestro cuerpo; nuestra sangre se vuelve una con Su sangre. ¡Un gran milagro! Veremos la gloria de Dios en nuestras vidas si creemos y ponemos nuestras necesidades en manos del Señor. La fe tiene un efecto profundo en nuestras vidas. Nos vemos obligados a detener nuestros sufrimientos y llenar nuestros corazones de confianza y esperanza, sabiendo que si nos conectamos con Jesús, seremos salvos.

Jesús también nos sanará si lo tocamos o dejamos que nos toque. Como la mujer enferma y Jairo, debemos tener fe en Él.
