LOVE ONE ANOTHER



On this Fifth Sunday of Easter, we meditate on the words of Jesus after the betrayer, Judas Iscariot, left the upper room in which Jesus and his disciples were celebrating the Passover, and He was giving them the commandment of love; “I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another” (Jn 13:34).

John’s Gospel does not speak of the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper as it did in the Synoptic Gospels. Instead, Jesus made a different action, to wash the feet of his disciples, which for John was a way to teach the disciples how they must treat one another and how the first in the community needed to be the first to serve his brothers.

After Judas left, the Lord explained the act of washing his disciples’ feet, ending with the announcement that the Son of Man would be glorified at that precise moment. We shall contemplate and understand better this theme of the Glory of the Son of Man in the narrative throughout the Passion by John. Jesus will be glorified in his death and resurrection, but his disciples will glorify him by fulfilling their love for each other.

Sometimes when we talk about love, we idealize its concept and then only in the beauty and sentimental part of love; however, the love that the Lord is talking about involves service, giving, and sacrifice. The most remarkable example is Jesus himself, who gave his life for the life of the world.

Jesus tells the disciples that everyone will know that they are his disciples because of the love they manifest for one another. This description of the early Christian community is repeated in the Acts of the Apostles: “See how they love one another.” Christian love is the stamp of authentication of Christianity. We see this through the witness of the martyrs and the example of the lives of the saints. We see it in the holy women and men who live and love daily, making small and great sacrifices for others.

Are we ready to be better disciples of the Lord? Do we like to make a significant difference as Catholics inviting others to believe in the Lord with the commandment of love?

Recently, thanks to your generosity, the Parish has been able to:

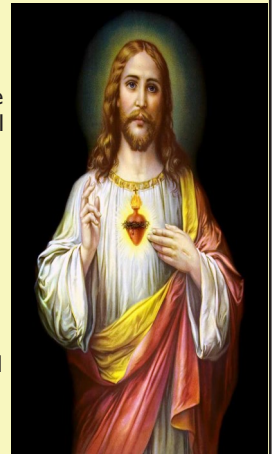
- Service A/C units in the church and other buildings.

Every May, the Columbiettes across the nation open their May business meeting with prayers and a crowning of their patroness, Mary, the Mother of Jesus.

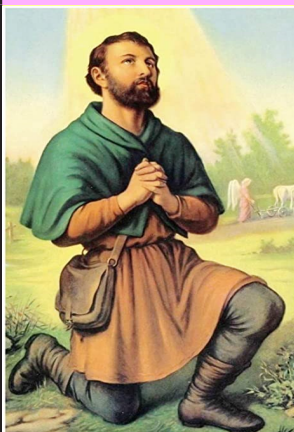
This weekend, the Columbiettes share their tradition with the Parish as they sponsor our crowning of Mary at the **10:00 AM Mass**.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ISIDORE THE FARMER



Isidore has become the patron of farmers and rural communities. In particular, he is the patron of Madrid, Spain, and of the United States National Rural Life Conference.

When he was barely old enough to wield a hoe, Isidore entered the service of John de Vergas, a wealthy landowner from Madrid, and worked faithfully on his estate outside the city for the rest of his life. He married a young woman as simple and upright as himself who also became a saint—Maria de la Cabeza. They had one son, who died as a child.

Isidore had deep religious instincts. He rose early in the morning to go to church and spent many a holiday devoutly visiting the churches of Madrid and surrounding areas. As he walked behind the plow, he communed with God all day long. His devotion, one might say, became a problem, for his fellow workers sometimes complained that he often showed up late because of lingering in church too long.

He was known for his love of the poor, and there are accounts of Isidore's supplying them miraculously with food. He had a great concern for the proper treatment of animals.

He died May 15, 1130, and was declared a saint in 1622, with Saints Ignatius of Loyola, Francis Xavier, Teresa of Avila, and Philip Neri. Together, the group is known in Spain as "the five saints."

Reflection:

Many implications can be found in a simple laborer achieving sainthood: Physical labor has dignity; sainthood does not stem from status; contemplation does not depend on learning; the simple life is conducive to holiness and happiness. Legends about angel helpers and mysterious oxen indicate that his work was not neglected and his duties did not go unfulfilled. Perhaps the truth emerges: If you have your spiritual self in order, your earthly commitments will fall into order also. "[S]eek first the kingdom [of God] and his righteousness," said the carpenter from Nazareth, "and all these things will be given you besides" (Matthew 6:33).

AMARSE LOS UNOS A OTROS



En este Quinto Domingo de Pascua, meditemos las palabras de Jesús después de que el traidor, Judas Iscariote, saliera del aposento alto en el que Jesús y sus discípulos celebraban la Pascua, y Él les daba el mandamiento del amor; “Os doy un mandamiento nuevo: que os améis unos a otros. Como yo os he amado, así también vosotros debéis amaros los unos a los otros” (Jn 13,34).

El Evangelio de Juan no habla de la institución de la Eucaristía en la Última Cena como lo hace en los Evangelios Sinópticos. En cambio, Jesús hizo una acción diferente, lavar los pies de sus discípulos, lo que para Juan era una forma de enseñar a los discípulos cómo debían tratarse unos a otros y cómo los primeros en la comunidad debían ser los primeros en servir a sus hermanos.

Después de que Judas se fue, el Señor explicó el acto de lavar los pies de sus discípulos, finalizando con el anuncio de que el Hijo del Hombre sería glorificado en ese preciso momento. Contemplaremos y comprenderemos mejor este tema de la Gloria del Hijo del Hombre en el relato a lo largo de la Pasión de Juan. Jesús será glorificado en su muerte y resurrección, pero sus discípulos lo glorificarán cumpliendo su amor mutuo.

A veces cuando hablamos de amor, idealizamos su concepto y luego solo en la parte bella y sentimental del amor; sin embargo, el amor del que habla el Señor involucra servicio, entrega y sacrificio. El ejemplo más notable es el mismo Jesús, que dio su vida por la vida del mundo.

Jesús les dice a los discípulos que todos sabrán que son sus discípulos por el amor que se manifiestan unos a otros. Esta descripción de la comunidad cristiana primitiva se repite en los Hechos de los Apóstoles: “Mirad cómo se aman”. El amor cristiano es el sello de autenticación del cristianismo. Vemos esto a través del testimonio de los mártires y el ejemplo de la vida de los santos. Lo vemos en las mujeres y hombres santos que viven y aman diariamente, haciendo pequeños y grandes sacrificios por los demás.

¿Estamos listos para ser mejores discípulos del Señor? ¿Nos gusta hacer una diferencia significativa como católicos invitando a otros a creer en el Señor con el mandamiento del amor?

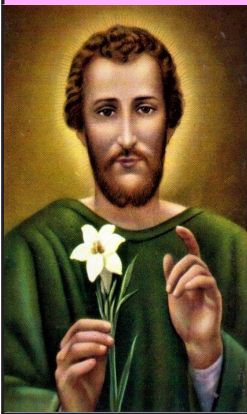
4. Padres de niños de la clase de la Sra. Wanda (Aula 2) o de la clase de la Sra.

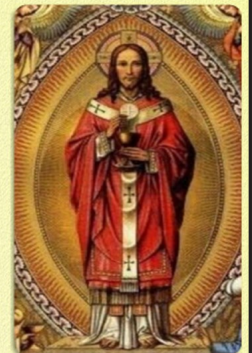
