FAMILY GRANT PROGRAM

Team Cont;nue fills a niche when supporting families navigating suicide prevention. Therapy as well as the time between in between in-patient and out-patient pschiatric care is a very difficult time to navigate as a family and the Team Cont;nue Foundation is focused on helping families navigate this tricky time.

In 2021, \$11,230 was awarded for 80 Therapy Sessions to 5 families with insufficient insurance.



NANCY BUYLE, ALLIANCE PROFESSIONAL COUSELING

\$3,830 was awarded for 32 therapy sessions to 2 adolescent families with limited or no coverage for therapy programs.



COMMON GROUND

\$2,000 was awarded for general mental health services in Oakland County. Common Ground was at ground zero during the Oxford High School shootings providing mental health support.



THAAR CARE FOUNDATION

\$5,400 was awarded for 48 therapy sessions to 2 adolescents and 1 young adult.

CROSS TOWN RIVALRY GAME

Team Cont; nue raised just over \$3000.
