☐ Train work group members in suicide prevention best practices	Create a written list of contact information for local crisis centers, community mental health agencies, etc.	Develop or collect materials on suicide prevention (informational flyers, brochures, etc.)	☐ Distribute awareness materials throughout the community	□ Plan and hold suicide prevention events (walks, etc.) □ Work with community partners to hold educational trainings in the community, such as Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) or Question, Persuade, Refer (QPR)
☐ The National Suicide Prevention Hot-line, local crisis center, or local community mental health agencies are possible resources for information	□ Reach out to any local Suicide Prevention Coalitions, NAMI groups, etc. for possible collaboration	□ Ensure all materials reflect best practices from reputable suicide prevention resources	□ Provide local news outlets with information on suicide prevention, and/or information on how to report on deaths by suicide
