

Tabletop YYC is dedicated to providing a harassment-free and enjoyable convention experience for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age or religion. We expect attendees to follow these guidelines while they are within the venue. Convention attendees in violation of these rules may be given a warning or expelled from the conference without a refund at the discretion of the convention organizers.

Harassment

We do not tolerate harassment of convention attendees, staff, or venue security in any form.

Harassment includes, but is not limited to:

- Verbal comments that reinforce social structures of domination related to gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, or religion
- Sexual images in public spaces
- Deliberate intimidation, stalking, or following
- Harassing photography or recording
- Sustained disruption during demos or events
- Inappropriate physical contact
- Unwelcome sexual attention
- Advocating for, or encouraging, any of the above behaviors

Games With Adult Themes

We recognize some games are geared toward adults and therefore contain mature themes and specific content that may be deemed offensive to others. We ask that attendees exercise caution when playing these sorts of games, making sure to pay attention to their surroundings and ensuring that all participants in a game are comfortable with the subject matter. Staff or volunteers may ask you to discontinue any game that we deem to be disruptive to the event or its attendees.

Enforcement

Attendees who are asked to stop any behavior are expected to comply immediately. If an attendee engages in behavior which violates these rules, convention organizers retain the right to take any actions needed to keep the event a welcoming environment for all attendees including issuing a warning to the offender or removing the offender from the convention with no refund.

Event organizers may take action to address and/or prevent anything designed to, or with the clear impact of, disrupting the event or making the environment hostile for any attendees.

Reporting

If someone makes you or anyone else feel unsafe or unwelcome, please report it as soon as possible to a convention staff member or volunteer.

Library Rules:

- Only approved primary badge holders may sign out games from the library.
- Please be respectful of the games. Treat them as if they were your own.
- Please make sure to do a piece “check” as soon as you are done playing the game (look on the floor around your table).
- If you find pieces for other games, drop them off at the library table
- Please do not have games checked out for more than 4 hours or if you are not playing it. If we see games sitting around we will return them to the library.
- Games are not allowed to be taken outside of the hotel and only played in the gaming halls.
- Try to pack a game as you found it. We want to make games easy to set up for the next players.
- When checking a game back in, please let us know if there were missing items.
- After checking your game back in, please place the game back on the shelf where you found it.
- If you need dry erase markers, note pads, pens, or poker chips they are at the library table.
- Use the coloured Dice on your table to signal:
 - -Blue: Players wanted with the pips up indicating how many you need
 - -Pink: Teacher wanted
 - -Purple: Game with a host ready to teach you the game
