



Week 3: God's Love for Us

Introduction (1 min)

Begin by asking the kids if they have ever received a gift. Share a brief story about a special gift you received and how it made you feel.

Bible Verse (1 min)

Read Romans 5:8: "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Lesson (1 min)

Explain that the Bible tells us about God's incredible love for us. Even when we make mistakes and do wrong things, God still loves us very much.

Discussion (1 min)

Ask the kids: "Why do you think God sent Jesus to die for us?" Allow them to share their thoughts.

Share with them that God loves us so much that He wanted to make a way for us to be close to Him again, even after we sinned. That's why He sent Jesus to show us His love and to save us.

Activity (1 min)

Hand out small pieces of paper and markers or crayons. Ask the kids to draw a picture that represents God's love for them. It could be a heart, a cross, or something else that reminds them of Jesus' sacrifice.

Prayer (1 min)

Lead a short prayer, thanking God for His amazing love and for sending Jesus to save us.

Encourage the kids to express their own thanks in their prayers.

Conclusion (1 min)

Summarize the lesson: "Remember, no matter what, God loves us so much that He sent Jesus to show us His love and save us. We can always trust in His love and know that we are special to Him."
