



Week 5: Calling on the Lord

Lesson: Calling on the Lord (2 minutes)

Opening: Begin by asking the kids if they've ever needed help from someone. Explain that just like we call on our parents or friends when we need help, we can also call on Jesus when we need help or want to be saved.

Bible Verse: Romans 10:13 – "For, 'Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'" (1 minute)

Discussion: (2 minutes)

Ask: "What do you think it means to 'call on the name of the Lord'?"

Explain: Calling on the name of the Lord means talking to Jesus, asking Him for help, and putting our trust in Him. It's like having a special conversation with Him, knowing that He is always there to listen.

Share: You can share a personal story or example of a time when you called on Jesus for help or comfort.

Application: (1 minute)

Ask: "Can you think of a situation where you might want to call on Jesus?"

Encourage: Let the kids know that no matter what they're facing, they can call on Jesus for strength, comfort, guidance, and salvation.

Prayer: (1 minute)

Lead a simple prayer, inviting the kids to repeat after you: "Dear Jesus, thank you for always being there for us. Help us remember that we can call on your name anytime we need you. Amen."

Closing: (1 minute)

End the lesson with a reminder that calling on Jesus is a special way to connect with Him, and that He loves hearing from us.
