Safety Guide lines for Archery Shooters

- O not intentionally shoot arrows into the ground.
- Only point your bow at the intended target.
- Never nock an arrow until the intended target is clear of other shooters.
- Stay on designated paths.
- Output Description Services Services
- If returning to look for lost arrows place a marker or your equipment in front of the target.
- Adults MUST supervise children at all times.
- Draw weight should be such that shooters are able to draw and aim their bow with control and without undue physical discomfort.
- Always insure that equipment is in good working order.
- Do not hesitate to ask for help or advice from other experienced club members if you need assistance or are unsure about any aspect of the safety of your equipment.
