
NATURE

- existing furniture and fireplace offered no focal point









Design concept



FIREPLACE FOCAL POINT


To accent the fireplace, we paired the existing wall color with a deep caramel color from our palette based on a fabric selection that coordinated with existing fabrics




SUNROOM
