## Red teaming

- Military war-gaming planning tool
- Blue team (friend) vs. Red Team (foe)
- Process to challenge and prove plans
- Objective identified, plan devised
- Red team:

O Examine plan
O Identify points of failure/weakness
O Counter-tactics

- Planners:

O Revise, Red team repeat, revise etc

- Objective:

O Reduce risk/ Secure outcome

- Implement plan.


## RnCP Red teaming \& business consultants continuity

- Two purposes
- 1. Same context as military origins (check existing plan for POFs) Should involve:

O Planners (people who wrote the plan)
O Response team members
O Anyone with required technical expertise or interest

- 2. Engagement tool

O Scenario for an identified risk/threat
O Representatives from different departments
O Work through the scenario
O What you would be doing? Who would you be talking to? What needs to happen?
O What do you need to know to respond effectively?

## Red teaming conclusion

- Direct Benefits:

O Demonstrates gaps and defines 'need'
O Creates awareness
O Involves key stakeholders in the process (budget-holders, responders, wider staff)
O Identifies threats, risks and points of failure
O Identifies strategic and operational priorities
O Demonstrates organistion/agency interdependencies
O The only cost is time (and not very much time!)

- Wider benefits:

O Team building
O Better appreciation of other departments' priorities
O Breaks down silo working.
