9 to 5 Life – Before COVID-19

- Working in an office, not remotely
- Working in close proximity, e.g., clusters
- Regular group meetings, e.g., conference rooms
- Impromptu meetings at desks, in hallways and canteens
- Social activities during and after work
- Water cooler meetings
- Lunch in office canteens
- Lunch gatherings in restaurants



9 to 5 Life – During COVID-19

- Working remotely
- Rare attendance in offices
- Hand washing and sanitizing
- Social distancing
- Face masks
- Taking one's temperature
- Meetings via Zoom, Teams



9 to 5 Life – Post-COVID-19

- Balance between remote and on-site work
- Face mask and hand sanitizer stations
- Scheduled attendance in offices
- Staggered workdays
- New seating arrangements
- Meetings via Zoom, Teams
- Social distancing




9 to 5 Life – Post-COVID-19

- Taking one's temperature
- Hand washing and sanitizing
- Sanitizing of facilities, e.g., door handles, tables, chairs, equipment, canteens
- Facemasks and gloves recycling
- Pen-type devices for touching surfaces, e.g., lift buttons, printers
- Awaiting a vaccine
