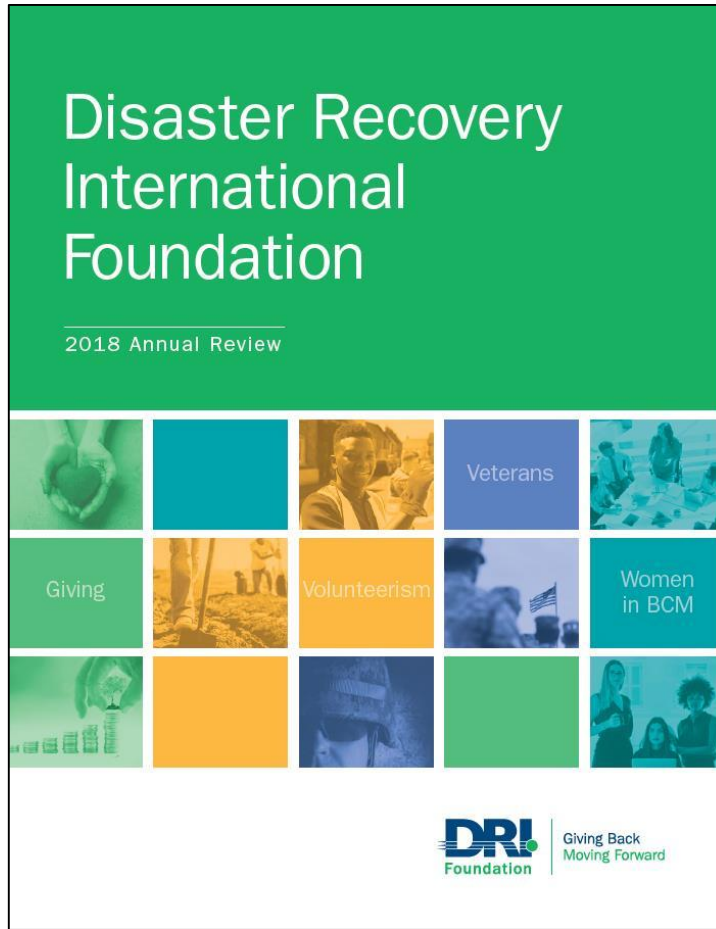

SOME CONCLUSIONS

1. CONSOLIDATION OF BC, DR, CRISIS & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT INTO RESILIENCE MANAGEMENT HAS SPEEDED UP IN 2019
2. RISK AND SECURITY RARELY REPORT INTO OF A RESILIENCE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT - BUT RESILIENCE SOMETIMES REPORTS TO RISK MANAGEMENT
3. RESILIENCE ISSUES ARE NOW CONSIDERED PRIMARILY VIRTUAL, CYBER, TECHNOLOGY RELATED. TRADITIONAL PHYSICAL CONCERNS HAVE BECOME LESS CENTRAL TO ROLE.
4. THERE ARE CONCERNS THAT SENIOR MANAGEMENT ARE AT RISK OF PUTTING THEIR BUSINESSES AT RISK BY NOT MANAGING A CRISIS SITUATION WELL.
5. THE HIGH COST OF PENAL AND REMEDIAL ACTION IN THE CASE OF DATA BREACH (FOR EXAMPLE UNDER GDPR) HAS BEEN MORE WIDELY RECOGNIZED.
6. REGULATED FIRMS SCORE BETTER ON MOST RESILIENCE METRICS COMPARED WITH NON-REGULATED FIRMS.
7. RESILIENCE PROFESSIONALS SHARE CORE SKILLS BUT BEYOND THAT THE MAIN RISKS AND CONCERNS ARE QUITE SECTOR SPECIFIC.

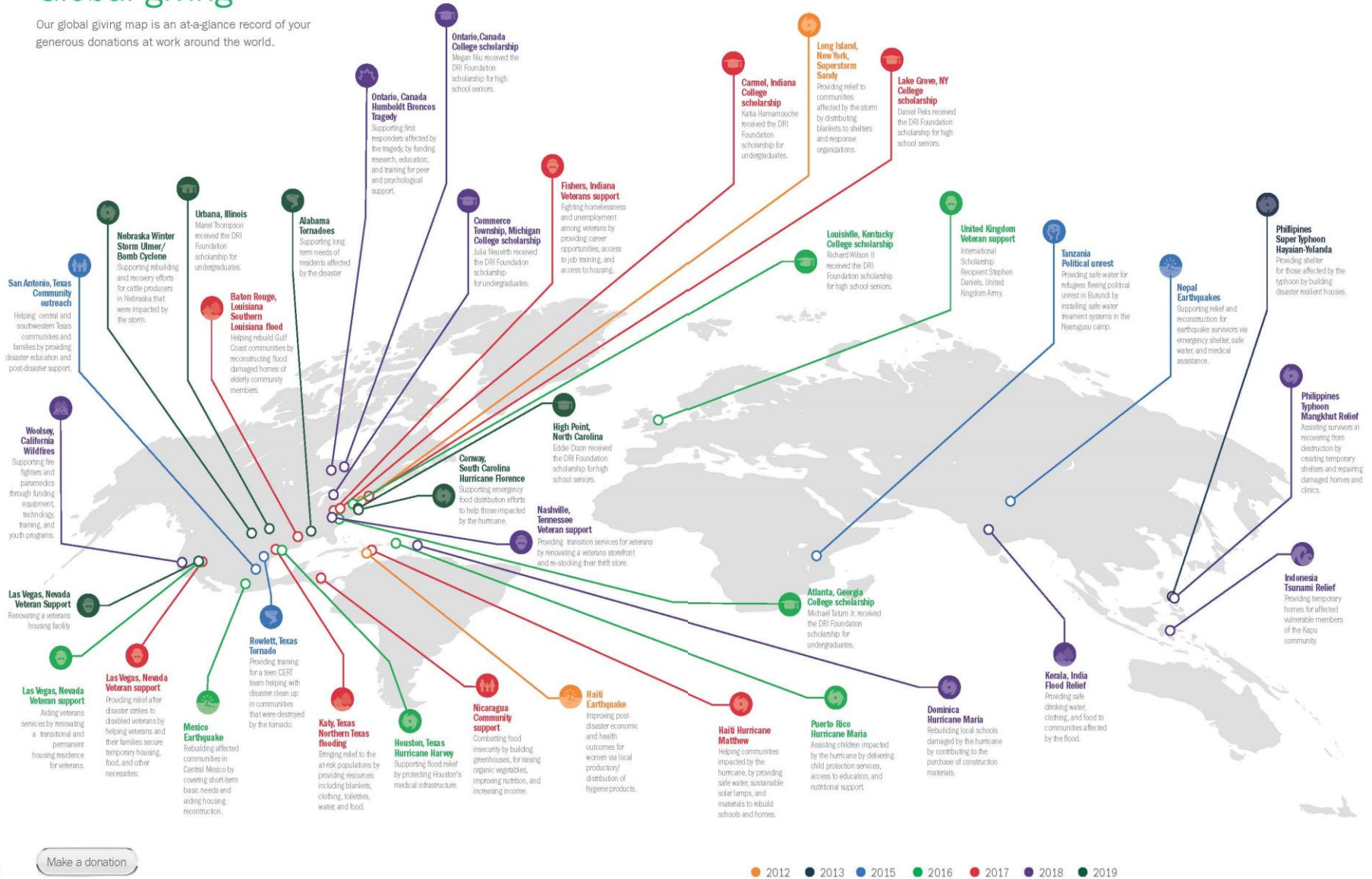
