









Know What You've Got

Risk Management

Salvage Trolley

The trolley is mounted in a frame that has two fixed wheels and two castered wheels. Moving the trolley requires care - it cannot be pushed sideways.

Dimensions of Trolley:


Height: 90cm Length: 120cm Width: 76cm
