Dr. P C Manoria spoke on “Dapagliflozin the molecule of the decade.” Three dialogue sessions were moderated by Dr. PC Manoria on “Current issues in diabetes” (Dr. S. R Joshi, Dr. BanshiSaboo, Dr. Rajesh Rajput, Dr. Sushil Jindal), Dialogue on AMI: Flash back and vision ahead with Dr. Ashok Seth(Delhi) as expert, and Demystifying the nuances of hypertension for improving outcomes with Dr. C. Venkata S Ram as the expert. Dr. Pankaj Manoria spoke on “Has the time come to say Bye-bye to Aspirin.” Besides this, several reputed national faculties also delivered talks on “Current issues in cardio-diabetology.”
