## THE GREAT TARMAC'S HALF-ASKED HISTORY

Tuscarawas seems to roll off the tongue - once you figure out how to pronounce it - and it was named by the Lenape (the "Grandfathers") of the native people who came to Ohio from the eastern seaboard of Maryland. The Europeans called the tribe the Delaware and they played host at first to the French fur traders and missionaries who were constantly at odds with the newer arriving English and German settlers. During the "French-Indian War" versus the British in 1763 they were divided as to who to side with as well as in the American Revolution (1776-1783) and the War of 1812.

Some say Tuscarawas means "open mouth" in reference to the river while others claim it to be known as "old town." The peace-loving natives would gather on the banks as the scores of pioneers arrived and quietly say "Tuscarawas, Tuscarawas" and solemnly waved at the noisy and contentious crowd. Through untiring and extensive research we have finally translated the Lenape "Tuscarawas" to mean "we hope you're just passing through here."
