Finally, relax in the coastal city of Hurghada, where you can soak up the sun and snorkel in the crystal-clear waters of the Red Sea. This itinerary offers the perfect mix of history, culture and adventure for an unforgettable trip.



CAIRO



Day 01: Arrival Cairo

Upon your arrival at Cairo airport, our representative will be there to assist you with all the necessary international procedures, such as visa, passport control, and customs. They will also ensure a fast exit from the airport. You'll be accompanied to your hotel in a private air-conditioned vehicle for a comfortable and hassle-free transfer.



Day 02: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum and Shopping

After breakfast, departure with the guide to visit the enigmatic place that possesses one of the wonders of the ancient world, the pyramids of King Khufu and of Kings Khafre and Menkaure. The tour will end next to the Sphinx. Then, visit the Papyrus Institute to learn about the technique of making boats, shoes, and paper from the papyrus plant. Later, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. You will also visit the Egyptian Museum where you will find the treasures of the pharaohs and the golden treasure of the boy king, Tutankhamun. Return to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.



Day 03: Philae Temple | Unfinished Obelisk

Breakfast and early transfer to Cairo airport for the flight to Aswan. Arrival and assistance by our representative. Visit the famous Temple of the goddess Isis on Philae Island in the Nile. Next, visit the Unfinished Obelisk, an ancient monument that was never completed due to a crack in the granite. Learn about the methods used to carve the obelisk and the history behind its creation, Check-in to the boat lunch and Dinner on board.



Day 04: Abu Simbel | Kom Ombo

After breakfast, you will start the tour to visit Abu Simbel and marvel at the enormous temples of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari, both renowned figures in ancient Egyptian history. Following the visit, lunch will be served on board as the journey continues towards Kom Ombo. Here, you will have the opportunity to explore the temple dedicated to the gods Sobek and Horus, who were depicted as a crocodile and a falcon, respectively. After the visit, return to the boat for an oriental dinner and a fantasy party. The boat will then navigate towards Edfu, where you will spend the night.



EDFU & LUXOR

Day 05: Visit of the temples (Edfu, Luxor & Karnak temple)

After breakfast, you will depart by carriage to visit the Temple of Edfu, a well-preserved Greco-Roman temple dedicated to the god Horus. It is the second-largest temple in Ancient Egypt, surpassed only by the Temple of Karnak in Luxor. Upon returning to the boat, lunch will be served, and the journey will continue towards Luxor. You will visit the temples of Luxor and Karnak, with the latter being dedicated to the god Amun and serving as the primary place of worship in Egypt during the New Kingdom. The temple was embellished by pharaohs for over two millennia, while the construction of the Luxor Temple was primarily promoted by Amenhotep III and Ramses II. Visiting these temples will transport you to the fascinating world of the gods, which was once accessible only to high priests and pharaohs. Following the visit, enjoy dinner and spend the night on board.



Day 06: Valley Of The Kings | Temple Of Hatshepsut | Colossi Of Memnon

After breakfast, you will depart to visit the west bank, also known as "the Necropolis of Thebes." Here, you will explore the Valley of the Kings, a rocky valley where pharaohs such as Tutankhamun were buried in hypogea adorned with stunning paintings and accompanied by lavish funerary objects. With a backdrop of desert ravines, you will see the majestic funerary temple of Hatshepsut, consisting of a series of terraces and porticos adorned with vivid relief pillars. The Colossi of Memnon, twin statues standing at around eighteen meters high, protected the main entrance of the mortuary temple of Amenhotep III. Later, depart to Hurghada by bus. The journey will take approximately four hours. Upon arrival in Hurghada, we will check into our hotel to spend next two nights.



Day 07: Free day

Wake up at your leisure and enjoy a delicious breakfast at your hotel in Hurghada, Spend the morning lounging on the beach, soaking up the sun and enjoying the beautiful views of the Red Sea. Take a dip in the crystal-clear waters and try some water activities such as snorkeling or scuba diving to explore the vibrant marine life. Enjoy a refreshing drink or a light lunch at one of the beachside restaurants or cafes. In the afternoon, continue your relaxation with a massage or spa treatment at the hotel, or simply relax by the pool. End your day with a delicious dinner and some live entertainment at a local restaurant or bar.

After enjoying your breakfast, you'll check out of your hotel you will depart at the scheduled time to Hurghada airport to catch a flight to Cairo International Airport, upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel and will check-in for the night in Cairo.
