





# Masai Mara National Reserve

One of our favorite places to look for wildlife in Kenya is the Masai Mara National Reserve. That's because the wildlife here is incredible, with big cats (lions, leopards and cheetahs) and elephants among the highlights. There's a very good chance you'll also see giraffes, buffaloes, wildebeests, zebras, hippos, hyenas, and, of course, impalas. And bring your binoculars, because more than 500 species of birds have been recorded in the reserve. It's a place of beautiful savannah landscapes as well, with lots of acacia trees.



## Activities Day 3

→ Transfer by Road, **Argyle Grand Hotel Nairobi Airport** via **Narok** to **Emayian Luxury Camp**

### Afternoon

## Activity Day 4

### All Day

→ Full Day Game Drive in the Masai Mara takes you deep into the heart of the savannah where every hour brings a new moment. You spend the day tracking lions, watching elephants move in family groups, spotting giraffes against the horizon, and pausing by the river to see hippos and crocodiles. Lunch in the bush gives you a quiet break in the middle of the wild and by sunset you feel like you have lived a whole story in a single day.





**Afternoon**


