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PLAYER PROFILE

- ⚽ Pride Soccer Club is a division of Munford Soccer Association. We govern our own team mission, philosophy, expectations, and budget while also working in conjunction with Munford Parks and Recreation to provide the most quality training to all interested young soccer players and for the benefit of our community.
- ⚽ Evaluations are held to determine the tactical skill, personal drive, behavior, and coach-ability of each players.
- ⚽ All players and coaches are registered through Tennessee State Association. We uphold their guidelines as part of our membership as well as the guidelines noted in the MSA Constitution and Bylaws and Pride Soccer Club behavioral standards. All coaches are licensed through USSF, NSCAA, and/or NFHS, and they follow the youth coaching recommendations given by these respected groups. All coaches and staff are volunteers who dedicate their time and knowledge to each player.
- ⚽ Our focus is on providing a framework that fosters the love of soccer in young players. If your child is invited to play with Pride Soccer Club, we will concentrate on technical ability, tactical awareness, physical fitness, and character building. We will not focus on winning matches. The wins will come when the foundation is firm. Your child will be taught, commended, and corrected. If you are only concerned about your child being the best player and winning matches, this may not be the best fit for you and your child.
- ⚽ This is a competitive team; therefore, all play time in a match will be earned through player effort at practice. Fee payment or the amount of time spent as a member of this team does not guarantee play time. Moving from recreational play is a process; so, encourage your player to practice independently, ask for the coach's opinion, and give best effort at training.
- ⚽ The fee for a new player is \$450. Fees paid will be used for player gear, tournament fees, league fees, state registration, awards, and incidentals. Coaches and staff are not compensated in any way. No other fees are necessary unless you purchase fan gear, participate in optional events, or volunteer to donate items for fundraisers. Fees paid are non-refundable.
- ⚽ A significant amount of time and travel is required as part of this team. Training is several times per week locally, matches will be held one night each week in Collierville at Mike Rose Soccer Complex, and we will participate in two or more tournaments which can be local or require travel. Parents must provide all transportation or car pool and are responsible for all out of town expenses.
- ⚽ If your player is currently rostered for another club team or is planning to play for his/her school team, there are guidelines that need to be followed and met to follow association regulations. Please consult the Club Administrator, Tammy Cotton.
 - I have read and understand the initial information provided by the Club Administrator at evaluations.
 - I understand that this is a competitive club team requiring travel and time commitments.
 - I understand that once the paperwork is filed with the state that NO REFUNDS will be given.
 - I understand that fees paid, and duration of membership DO NOT GUARANTEE play time.
 - I understand that my player CANNOT play for another soccer team while rostered with Pride Soccer Club.
