Michael James Gossner, a lifelong resident of Lower Bucks County, Pennsylvania, passed away on July 6, 2025, at the age of 71.

Mike was born at Hamilton Air Force Base in Marin County, California, and raised in the Quincy Hollow section of Levittown where he cultivated lifelong friendships and a strong sense of community. He graduated from Neshaminy High School in 1972 and attended Bucks County Community College.

He built a successful career in Sales, starting early with Budd Company and ultimately retiring from Lifetouch Shutterfly. His retirement “work” included volunteer assistant baseball coach for Holy Ghost Prep, baseball instructor and coordinator at EL1, and PIAA high school soccer referee. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and Sons of the American Legion. Known for his authenticity, sense of humor, and ability to connect with others, Mike was a positive force.

A sports enthusiast and baseball lifer, Mike was an avid fan, coach, instructor, and mentor to countless players and fellow coaches. He had been an associate scout for the Kansas City Royals and Baltimore Orioles, had served as president of the All-American Amateur Baseball Association (AAABA), and was owner-manager of the AAABA Philadelphia franchise. His enthusiasm for the game was infectious and his knowledge was boundless. Mike had a natural ability to connect with others and always chose to see the good. His impact on those he shared the field with will last generations.

Mike was happiest spending time with family and friends, being outside in the sun, or singing and dancing to his favorite tunes. He enjoyed relaxing on the beach or by the pool, dinners and vacations with family and friends, and playing golf with his brother and childhood buddies in their Tuesday golf league.

Mike was the devoted husband and best friend to Mary Romsperg; beloved son of Dyanne Alexy, the late Bob Alexy, and the late Robert Gossner; the proud and loving father to Michael Stephen Gossner (Margaret), with whom he shared a unique and special bond; loving Poppy to his cherished grandchildren, Michael Christopher, Emma Rose, Grace Elizabeth, and Nicholas James; loyal big brother to Jeffrey Gossner (Regina), Robin Brodsky (Glenn), and Christopher Alexy (Krista); Crazy Uncle Mike to his nieces, nephews; and a fun, outgoing, and great friend to many.
