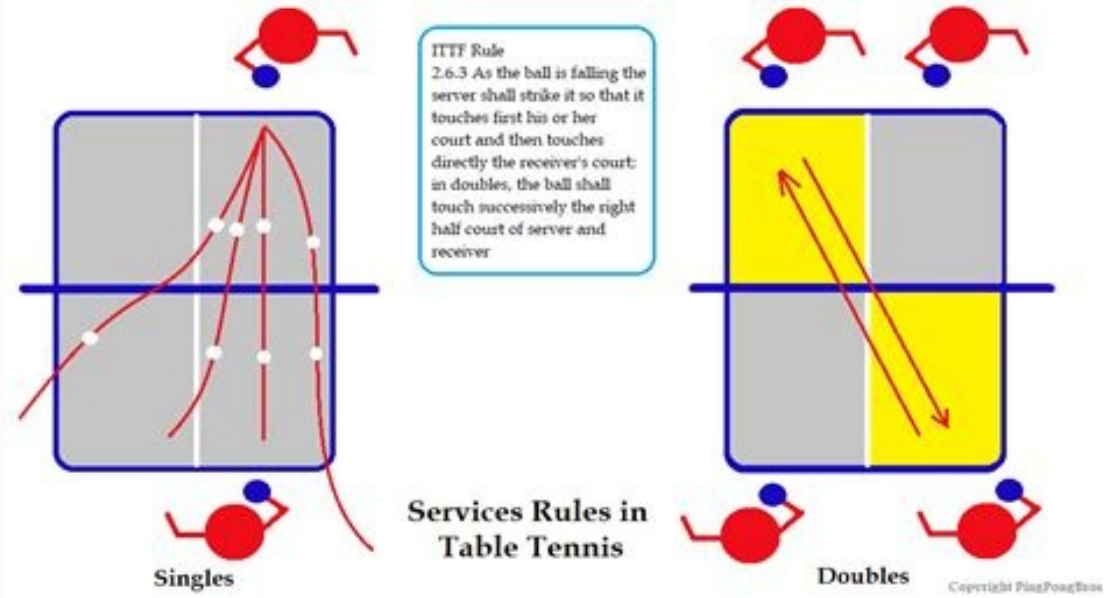

Table Tennis Rules

- ❖ A serve **MUST** bounce on both sides of the table.
- ❖ Players cannot volley the ball (must bounce first).
- ❖ Service changes every 2 points.
- ❖ First to 7 points (must win by 2 clear).
- ❖ A player can serve in **ANY** direction (does not have to be diagonal).
- ❖ A scorer (umpire) must be present during every game.

There are other rules and regulations for international game, but they are added to the following rules and generally apply to simple mortals like us, because we do not play in international conditions. Minor modifications or modifications of the official regulations are offered each year by ETTF and/or its members. A majority of the ITTF AGA will decide whether the new proposals are accepted. The entire association of members can vote and have an equal weight. Usually it happens if they pass the ball, penetrate the net or pour the edge of the table. The point is not lost if the ball touches the net and the rest is allowed, it is considered a repetition and the point is repeated. Do you know how table tennis is played? No, in table tennis you cannot detonate the ball and win a point. The ball should always return to the side of the pair of the table before the opponent can hit the ball. Where to serve table tennis? In a category, you can launch the ball everywhere on the side of the table and then in any area on the opponent's side. In double, the ball must first bounce on the right side of the power table and then on the right side of the main table. How to serve in table tennis? For legal delivery you must launch the ball vertically from the palm of at least 16 cm without causing rotation. The offer should be made from the place behind the final line and above the level of the table. How to score in table tennis?
