

Data

- Wahnetta has a population of approximately 5,100.
- The Mexican and other Hispanic population is 64.7 %.
- 37.7 % of this population is under 18 years of age.
- Wahnetta is rural – surrounded by 2.4 square miles of agricultural land.
 - Per capita income is \$ 8,433.
 - The median income is \$ 22,349.
 - Meaning 29.1% below poverty level.
 - Wahnetta Elementary School is 78.5% Hispanic compared to 28.5% in the greater Winter Haven area.

Social Justice and Opportunities

Wahnetta is located in eastern Polk County in Winter Haven. It is a part of the United Methodist East Central District.

We cover five prioritized needs of the community for the development of the people and families with educational and social outreach programs. The ministries of children, teenagers and families will be empowered through these support ministries at work.
