At Hatfield Music, we recognize that every student and every family has unique needs. Whether you prefer the consistency of a weekly lesson or the flexibility of scheduling as needed, we offer several learning pathways designed to help you achieve your musical goals.

Studio Membership

Our monthly Studio Membership is the foundation of Hatfield Music. Membership provides students with a reserved weekly lesson time and the opportunity to become an active part of our studio community.

Membership options include:

Private Lessons (all instruments)

Weekly one-on-one instruction for students of all ages. 30 minutes
Memberships starting at \$125/month

Piano Lab (Collaborative Piano)

Collaborative piano classes combining instructor-led learning, ensemble playing, guided practice, and musical games in a small-group setting. 60 minutes

Flexible Lesson Options

For students who need greater scheduling flexibility, Hatfield Music also offers prepaid lesson options.

Lesson Packages

Purchase multiple lessons in advance and schedule individually based on teacher availability. Lesson packages are perfect for homeschool families, busy professionals, and students with changing schedules.

On-Demand Lessons

Need a single lesson? On-Demand Lessons are available for audition preparation, competition coaching, college preparation, or occasional instruction.

Current pricing is available through the Parent Portal or by contacting the studio.

Additional specialty classes, workshops, camps, and enrichment programs are offered throughout the year. Tuition varies by program and will be announced with registration information.

Annual Studio Calendar

Consistency Throughout the Year



At Hatfield Music, we believe students make the greatest progress when learning is consistent. Our studio calendar provides a predictable schedule that balances weekly instruction with holidays, teacher planning, recitals, enrichment opportunities, and studio events—all designed to support the development of well-rounded musicians. Rather than charging by the lesson, Studio Membership reserves your weekly lesson time throughout the year according to the published studio calendar. This allows families to enjoy consistent monthly tuition while providing students with a steady rhythm of musical growth. Our annual calendar is designed to support steady musical growth throughout the year—even during scheduled studio breaks.

Learning Beyond the Lesson

**Music learning doesn't stop
when lessons pause.**

During scheduled studio breaks, teachers may provide optional PracticeSpace assignments to help students maintain momentum. These guided activities reinforce lesson concepts, encourage consistent practice habits, and help students return prepared for the next stage of instruction.

While optional, we encourage students to complete these assignments so music remains an active part of their routine throughout the year.

Attendance & Scheduling

Making the Most of Every Lesson

Consistent attendance is one of the greatest predictors of musical success. Every lesson builds upon the previous one, and maintaining a regular schedule helps students develop confidence, skills, and a lifelong love of music.

Lesson Attendance:

- Students are expected to attend their scheduled lesson each week.
- Lessons begin and end at the scheduled time.
- Late arrivals do not extend the lesson.

Student Absences

If you are unable to attend a lesson, **please provide at least 24 hours' notice through the MyMusicStaff Parent Portal**. Because Studio Membership reserves a recurring weekly lesson time with your teacher, missed lessons are not eligible for rescheduling. When at least 24 hours' notice is provided, students will receive a PracticeSpace assignment or other instructional materials to continue making progress at home. **The Parent Portal is the only official method for reporting student absences.** Notifications given directly to a teacher—including in person, by text, phone, email, or through the student—do not constitute official notice and will not excuse an absence.

Illness

Students who are experiencing fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or other contagious symptoms should remain at home until they have been symptom-free for at least 24 hours (or longer if recommended by their healthcare provider). If an illness develops suddenly on the day of the lesson, please notify the studio as soon as possible through the Parent Portal. Students who miss a lesson due to sudden illness will receive a PracticeSpace assignment or other instructional materials to continue their musical progress from home.

Teacher Absences

If a teacher must cancel a lesson, Hatfield Music will make every effort to provide a substitute instructor, reschedule the lesson, or provide another appropriate instructional experience.

Scheduled Studio Closures

Hatfield Music follows its published Annual Studio Calendar, not the local school calendars. Scheduled holidays and studio closures are communicated in advance through the Parent Portal and online studio calendar.

Scheduling Changes

Requests for permanent lesson time changes should be submitted through the Parent Portal. Changes are based on teacher availability and cannot be guaranteed.

Weather & Emergency Closures

Safety Always Comes First

The safety of our students, families, and teachers is our highest priority. When severe weather or other emergency conditions make travel unsafe or significantly impact studio operations, Hatfield Music may close or modify its schedule at its discretion. Studio closure decisions are based on local conditions affecting the safety of our students, families, teachers, and facility and are not determined solely by local school closures.

Communication

Closure announcements will be communicated through:

- MyMusicStaff Parent Portal
- Email
- Studio social media
- Text message for urgent notifications

During Studio-Wide Closures

Studio-wide emergency closures are built into the annual membership calendar and do not qualify for individual makeup lessons.

When circumstances allow, Hatfield Music may provide alternative instructional opportunities, such as virtual lessons, PracticeSpace assignments, recorded instruction, written practice plans, or other educational resources.

The type of instruction provided will depend on the nature of the emergency and the availability of electricity, internet service, and communication systems.

Extended Closures

If the studio experiences an extended closure, Hatfield Music will communicate a plan for continuing instruction as soon as it is reasonably practical to do so. During widespread disruptions to power, internet, or cellular service, instructional alternatives may be delayed until communication systems have been restored.

Studio Membership reserves your student's place in the annual teaching schedule rather than paying for individual lessons. Just as tuition remains consistent during scheduled holidays and studio breaks, it also remains consistent during studio-wide emergency closures. This approach allows us to continue supporting our teachers, maintain studio operations, and provide a consistent, high-quality music education throughout the year.

Practice & Home Support

Growing Beyond the Lesson

The greatest musical growth happens between lessons. Consistent practice, encouragement at home, and thoughtful preparation help students build confidence, independence, and a lifelong love of music.

A Quality Instrument

Every student should have regular access to an instrument that allows them to practice successfully. Your teacher can recommend appropriate instruments and equipment for your student's age, level, and goals.

Practice Expectations

Practice expectations vary based on each student's age, experience, and goals. Your teacher will provide individualized practice assignments and recommend an appropriate daily routine.

PracticeSpace

As part of Studio Membership, every student receives complimentary access to PracticeSpace, a premium online learning platform provided by Hatfield Music at no additional cost to your family. PracticeSpace extends the learning experience beyond the weekly lesson by providing:

- **Personalized practice assignments**
- **Teacher notes and weekly feedback**
- **Instructional videos and demonstrations**
- **Practice tracking and reminders**
- **Supplemental resources as needed**

Tuition & Enrollment

Investing in Your Musical Journey

At Hatfield Music, we believe billing should be simple, predictable, and transparent. Our tuition and lesson options are designed to provide a high-quality educational experience while offering the flexibility to meet each student's needs.

New Student Enrollment

A one-time New Student Enrollment Fee is due upon enrollment and covers the resources and administrative setup needed to welcome new families to Hatfield Music.

The Enrollment Fee includes:

- Student enrollment and account setup
- Parent Portal and PracticeSpace setup
- Welcome materials
- Student records and studio management software

Discovery Lesson Credit

Students who enroll within 7 days of their Discovery Lesson will have the \$40 Discovery Lesson fee credited toward their New Student Enrollment Fee.

\$50/student or \$75/family

Studio Membership

Studio Membership reserves a recurring weekly class or lesson time on the Annual Studio Calendar. Tuition is billed monthly and is due on the 1st of each month.

30-minute Weekly Private Lessons: Starting at \$125/month

60-minute collaborative piano classes featuring The Learning Lab and The Music Lab, beginning at \$95/month.

Membership Discounts

- Sibling Discount: 5% off tuition for each additional sibling enrolled.
- Multi-Instrument Discount: 5% off tuition for each additional instrument studied by the same student.
- Senior Weekly Lessons (Ages 60+): \$28 per 30-minute lesson, paid weekly. AutoPay is not required.

On-Demand Lesson Packages

On-Demand Lesson Packages are designed for students who need greater scheduling flexibility. Lessons are purchased in advance and scheduled based on teacher availability rather than reserving a recurring weekly lesson time.

Package Details:

- Lessons must be paid in full before scheduling.
- **Students are responsible for scheduling their own lessons through the Parent Portal.**
- Lessons are scheduled based on teacher availability.
- Lesson packages do not reserve a recurring weekly lesson time.
- **Lesson packages expire 6 months from the date of purchase. Any unused lessons remaining after the expiration date are forfeited.**

Single On-Demand Lesson (30 min): \$40

4-Lesson Package: \$152 (\$38/lesson)

8-Lesson Package: \$288 (\$36/lesson)

Senior Weekly Lessons (Ages 60+)

Hatfield Music believes music is for every stage of life. Adults ages 60 and older may reserve a recurring weekly lesson time at a discounted rate of \$28 per 30-minute lesson. Tuition is paid monthly in advance. AutoPay is not required. The studio's 24-hour cancellation policy applies to all Senior Weekly Lessons.

Payments & Billing

Investing in More Than Lessons

Every tuition dollar supports a learning environment where students are encouraged to grow as confident, creative, and well-rounded musicians.

Studio Membership

Studio Memberships, including weekly private lessons and Piano Lab, require enrollment in AutoPay to reserve your student's recurring weekly lesson time. Tuition is billed automatically on the 1st of each month. A valid ACH bank account or debit/credit card must be kept on file in the MyMusicStaff Parent Portal.

Senior Weekly Lessons are exempt from the AutoPay requirement and may be paid at each lesson.

On-Demand Lesson Packages

On-Demand Lesson Packages must be paid in full before lessons may be scheduled.

Accepted payment methods include:

- ACH bank transfer
- Debit card/Credit card
- Cash (accepted prior to scheduling lessons)

Lesson packages are not eligible for monthly billing or payment plans.

Curriculum & Materials

Teachers select curriculum based on each student's age, experience, and musical goals. Required books and materials are purchased through Hatfield Music and will be added to your account as needed. Families will be notified before new materials are ordered.

Recital Fee

The recital fee helps offset the cost of venue setup, printed programs, awards, certificates, decorations, event materials, and other recital-related expenses. Recital fee information is distributed each spring.

Communication

Staying Connected

Clear communication helps lessons run smoothly and keeps students and families informed throughout the year.

PracticeSpace For Learning Between Lessons

PracticeSpace is the primary tool for lesson communication, assignments, and learning between lessons.

Students and families can use PracticeSpace to:

- View lesson assignments
- Read teacher notes and feedback
- Watch instructional videos
- Track practice goals
- Access supplemental learning resources

The MyMusicStaff Parent Portal is your hub for managing your account and Studio Membership.

Response Times

Hatfield Music values clear and timely communication. Messages received during regular business hours are typically returned within one business day. Messages received evenings, weekends, or holidays will be returned during the next business day whenever possible.

To ensure accurate scheduling and recordkeeping, all lesson cancellations, scheduling requests, and account updates should be submitted through the MyMusicStaff Parent Portal rather than by text message or social media.

Studio Etiquette & Safety

Respecting Our Shared Musical Home

Hatfield Music is more than a lesson studio—it's a place where students of all ages come to learn, create, and grow. These simple guidelines help ensure a safe, welcoming, and respectful environment for everyone.

Arrival & Departure

To help ensure the safety of all students, parents or guardians must escort students under the age of 12 into the building and meet them inside at the conclusion of their lesson.

Students should arrive no more than 5-10 minutes before their scheduled lesson. Upon arrival, students should check in with the front desk and remain in the designated waiting area until called by their teacher.

Because lessons are in progress throughout the building, Hatfield Music is not equipped to supervise students who arrive early or remain after their lesson has ended. Please arrive on time and pick up your student promptly.

Respecting the Studio

Our studio is a shared space enjoyed by students and families of all ages. Thank you for treating our instruments, furnishings, and facilities with care so everyone can enjoy a clean, welcoming environment.

Waiting Areas

Families are welcome to enjoy our waiting areas, including games, LEGO®s and reading materials.

Please help us care for these shared spaces by:

- Return games, toys, and books to their designated locations.
- Dispose of trash before leaving.
- Keep food and drinks away from instruments and equipment.
- Walk indoors and use quiet, respectful voices while lessons are in progress.

Stage & Performance Areas

The stage is an important teaching and performance space.

To protect our instruments, equipment, and décor:

- Please do not climb, run, or play on the stage.
- Students may use the stage only with instructor permission or supervision.

Staff Areas

Staff workspaces, offices, storage rooms, and teacher materials are reserved for instructors and staff members. Students and families should not enter these areas unless invited by a member of the Hatfield Music team.

Water & Snacks

Students are encouraged to bring a labeled water bottle to lessons. To help protect our instruments and facilities, food should remain in designated areas and away from teaching spaces.
