Reading: Luke 14: 7-14

⁷ When he noticed how the guests chose the places of honour, he told them a parable. ⁸ 'When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not sit down at the place of honour, in case someone more distinguished than you has been invited by your host; ⁹ and the host who invited both of you may come and say to you, "Give this person your place", and then in disgrace you would start to take the lowest place. ¹⁰ But when you are invited, go and sit down at the lowest place, so that when your host comes, he may say to you, "Friend, move up higher"; then you will be honoured in the presence of all who sit at the table with you. ¹¹ For all who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.'

¹²He said also to the one who had invited him, 'When you give a luncheon or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or rich neighbours, in case they may invite you in return, and you would be repaid. ¹³ But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. ¹⁴ And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you, for you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous.'

Reflection on Luke 14: 7-14

This morning we have a lesson on the value of humility – Jesus helps us to see the need we have to choose the last places, - that is to seek littleness and hiddenness: humility. The poor, those who count for nothing could never repay an invitation to dinner – thus Jesus showed his preference for the poor and excluded those who are the privileged of the Kingdom of God, and transmits the fundamental message of the Gospel- which is to serve our neighbour for the love of God.
