

Lady Chapel Roof



The orange buckets are packed away, no longer collecting raindrops or donations for the leaking roof above the Lady Chapel.

After nearly a year of fundraising and receipt of a grant from Valencia Communities Fund work was able to commence February this year and is all complete, keeping the Lady Chapel dry and the building structure protected from water damage.



The lead roof coverings had deteriorated over the years allowing water to seep underneath as well as well as pointing to flashing areas along the castellations.





With the lead removed, any damage from water ingress was able to be addressed as part of the works.
