Pre-Teen Lego Camp (A)



What?

Participants will take their individual projects home on the final day of the camp. Each camper will have the opportunity to also build various group projects and several Lego themed games and contests. Campers Technic is a line of Lego that is comprised of advanced models with more complex movable arms, such as machines with wheels, in addition to the simpler brick-building properties of normal LEGO. It should be noted that Lego Technic kits are more expensive than traditional Lego kits and is reflected in the cost.

Why learn computer programming?

Programming fosters creativity, reasoning, and problem solving. The programmer gets the opportunity to create something from nothing, use logic to turn programming constructs into a form that a computer can run, and, when things don't work quite as well as expected, use problem solving to figure out what has gone wrong. Programming is a fun, sometimes challenging activity, and the skills learned from it can be useful and fun.

In our Digital Arts and Coding Camp the kids will be able to create their own video games and puzzles with an easy-to-learn programming language that has some really useful features for a beginning programmer.
