

Preparing for your first Track Day

Before You Arrive

Contact [MoE](#) and then create a [Motorsportreg.com](#) account to **Register** for the **Instructed Novice** run group. Install fresh brake pads and tires, check all fluids are topped up and clean.

You Must bring a completed [TECH FORM](#) (Click for link to downloadable PDF).

A SNELL 2015 or newer certified helmet is required. At NJMP events Only, Helmets can be rented at the [General's Store](#). Confirm availability and store hours Prior to the event at (856) 327-7206. Open face helmets are only allowed in cars with OEM airbags installed and the top enclosed (Not in open top convertibles). Legible numbers at least 8" high must be displayed on both sides of the car, painter's tape is fine.

Factory seat belts are ok. Installed race harnesses, must be up to date. FIA harnesses are good until the end of the year that is stamped on the tag. All other harnesses expire 2 years after their "Born On" date.

Harnesses without any tags or 4 point harnesses will not be accepted.

All convertibles must have permanent rollover protection (No "Pop-Ups") and pass the [Broomstick Test](#).

You must wear long pants and closed toe shoes on track (NO shorts).

What To Bring

- Tech sheet
- Long Pants
- Closed Toe Shoes
- Helmet (SNELL 2015 or Newer)
- Car Numbers (Painter's Tape)
- Water
- Windshield cleaner
- Torque wrench
- Sunscreen
- Extra clothing layers
- Chair
- Tire pressure gauge

When You Arrive

-Arrive **Early**, find a parking spot and remove ALL loose objects. Registration opens at 7:10.

-Submit your completed and signed [Tech Form](#) at registration.

Sign the event waiver and get your wristband from Moe to complete registration.

You must complete registration before any Tech inspection of your car.

Tech Inspection

-Remove all loose objects (Including the floor mats). Place the objects outside of your car in your parking area.

-Numbers: Place numbers on both sides of your car, usually on the door with painter's tape.

-Helmet: Put your helmet in your car and drive to the tech inspection area.

Before you Drive on track

-Lug nuts: Check they are tight

-Tire pressure: Check manufacturer's recommended setting

-Clean your windshield

Attend the Drivers' Meeting at 8:15 -

Mandatory for everyone who wants to Drive in the event.

MoE will cover important Track and event Safety requirements.

After the drivers' meeting, go to the classroom to learn about Track Safety and High Performance driving

concepts. All drivers registered as **Instructed Novice** will be paired with a driving instructor in the classroom.
