


VIZOOVET for Cats

"I used them on a trial basis for one of my cats ("Doc") with FHV damaged lids and eyes. They have been very good for his eyes. His lids are less swollen and red, his eyes look clear and moist, the drops don't leave a gooey residue, and they are easy to use. The bottle contains enough drop to last for 4 applications per eye, so for a whole day. If I had to describe Doc's reaction I would say that they are soothing for him."

I've been using a lipid-based drop designed for meibomian gland disfunction which was also working well. Before that a hyaluron drop. The Vizoovet drops have some advantages over both of these. However I will initially go half and half with the MGD drops and the Vizoovet drops because with his MGD he produces no lipid in his tear drops. I drop his eyes four times a day (and warm compress them twice a day). Thank you so much! Lin Z
