**HOLIDAYS and SPECIAL DAYS
PARENTING TIME SCHEDULE
(adopted 8/22/16)**

Holiday parenting time is intended to supersede regularly scheduled parenting time. This schedule shall be followed as an Order of the Court unless parties agree, in writing, to modify.

The following holidays shall be alternated between the parties each year. Unless otherwise indicated, those holidays shall run from 10:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

		Spring Break To be divided equally – Mother having the first half on even years and Father having the second half on even years. In odd years, Father will have the first half and Mother will have the second half. For example, if spring break consists of eight (8) days, Mother shall have the children during the first four (4) days and Father shall have the children during the last four (4) days in an even year.

Father shall have first half on even years and Mother second half on even years. Mother shall have first half on odd years and Father second half on odd years.</p>
Mother	Father	New Year's Eve, December 31 st , 6:00 p.m. to New Year's Day, January 1 st at noon.

Child's Birthday to be alternated (Parent not enjoying parenting time on the child's birthday shall have the child from 7:00pm to 9:00pm, unless otherwise agreed by the parties)

Halloween (trick or treat) – To be alternated on a year by year basis, with Father having child(ren) on odd years and Mother having child(ren) on even years.
