Scholarship Amount: One per year \$1,000.00 (paid in 2 installments of \$500 per semester)

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicant must plan to enroll in college.
- Applicant must be a member of one of the BSMA Churches in good standing.
- **Applicant** must submit the completed application by the deadline:
 - ◆ Application must be postmarked, emailed or uploaded by April 1st.
 (no applications received after April 1st will be considered.)
- **Applicant** must present a "B" overall grade point average.
- **Applicant** must submit a written reference from his/her Pastor or Departmental Leader within his/her church.
- **Applicant** must submit a written essay about his/her chosen field of study and its potential benefits to the community. (approximately 1½ typed pages)
- <u>Scholarship recipient must</u> attend the Community Thanksgiving Service (*November*) or forfeit the <u>2nd installment</u> (\$500 in January) of the awarded scholarship.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

The Alliance Scholarship recipient will be chosen based on:

- A) Application directions and application contents.
- B) Grade point average [High School Transcript].
- C) Participation in his/her church.
- D) Written essay content quality and grammar.
- E) Verbal interview with the Selection Committee (if necessary).

PROCEDURE:

- The applicant must obtain the <u>Scholarship Application Form</u> from the BSMA Website at <u>www.BarrettAlliance.org</u> or your BSMA Church Representative or Pastor.
- ◆ The Application must be postmarked, emailed or uploaded by April 1st; along with the following: a Referral Letter from the Pastor or Department Leader of her/his Church, the Applicant's Essay, and a copy of the High School Transcript.
- The Selection Committee will review the applications, transcript, referral letter and essay and select finalists for verbal interview.
- The Selection Committee will choose from the finalists, the Scholarship Recipients of the BSMA Scholarship.
- When the recipient has enrolled in college and presents a tuition receipt to the BSMA, he/she will receive a check for \$500.00 for the first semester of enrollment.
- If the recipient attends the BSMA Community Thanksgiving Service, when he/ she has enrolled in college for the second semester, and presents a tuition receipt to the BSMA, she/he will receive the second check in the amount of \$500.00.
