## WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING

### ALL SKATERS MUST HAVE THEIR OWN SKATES

We strongly advise against ordering online. We suggest getting fitted for figure skates at a true skate shop, such as JT Sports on Staten Island. Every skate manufacturer sizes differently, and your skater needs skates with ankle support. Also, all new skate blades will need to be sharpened. Double blades & expandable boots are not permitted. All beginners should wear proper figure skates. (Even those who aspire to play hockey should start on figure skates before switching to hockey skates.)

### HELMET, GLOVES, AND WINTER GEAR

Helmets and gloves are mandatory for all beginners. Multisport, ski or hockey helmets are recommended. Clothing should be warm & comfortable. We suggest snow pants or snow suits for the little ones.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

All skaters must be registered PRIOR to the first day of class they plan on attending. On the first day of a new session, arrive at least 20 minutes early to check-in.

Only registered students are allowed on the ice during skate school hours. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN ELIMINATION OF THE REGISTERED STUDENT FROM THE SKATE SCHOOL PROGRAM.**

Class assignments are subject to change as per the Director.

A parent or guardian must be present in the rink during class time.

## Ice Show 2019

Sunday, May 19th, 2:00PM

- ◆ Skaters will perform group routines choreographed to demonstrate the skills they have learned throughout the season.
- ◆ They will learn their group routine during normal class time.
- ◆ Show fee is \$200, which includes the costume, 5 tickets and Dress Rehearsal.
- ◆ Dress Rehearsal is on Wednesday, May 15th.
- ◆ Extra tickets are \$20 each.

Non-refundable show fee is due, in full, by December 4th, 2018.

**10% DISCOUNT IF PAID BY SEPTEMBER 2018.**

Measurements for costume will only be taken after full show fee payment is made.

## BRIDGE PROGRAM

- ◆ For Skaters Basic 5 & Higher
- ◆ 1 hour of instruction
- ◆ 1/2 hour skating skills, 1/2 hour jumps & spins
- ◆ \$395 for 11 week session
- ◆ Minimum of 5 skaters to hold the class.
- ◆ All Bridge skaters, who have passed Pre-Preliminary MIF test by March 1, 2019, and are registered for full season, will receive a solo in the May show. Pre-selected solo music will be distributed mid-March.
- ◆ Bridge show fee is \$300, which includes 1 group costume, 6 tickets, Group Dress Rehearsal practice & Solo Dress Rehearsal Practice. Due by December 14th, 2018.
- ◆ Group & Solo Dress Rehearsals are on Wednesday, May 15th.
- ◆ Extra tickets are \$20 each.

## TOT LESSONS

Tuesdays 5:45 PM or Fridays 5:00 PM

- ◆ For children 3 & 4 years old.
- ◆ A1/2 hour of one-on-one attention.
- ◆ The fee is \$30 per lesson, and must be paid PRIOR to the skater taking the ice. We accept checks or cash.
- ◆ Fee is \$30 regardless of whether the skater stays on the ice for the full 30 minutes.
- ◆ If the skater does not stay on the ice for the full 30 minutes, another skater/sibling cannot take the lesson for the remainder of the time.
- ◆ Tot skaters must purchase their own figure skates. Hockey skates are not permitted.
- ◆ Tot skaters must have a bike helmet, gloves and snow pants.
- ◆ Tot lessons are by appointment only and can be made by emailing:

- ◆ Once a tot lesson appointment is confirmed (through email), there is a 24 hour cancellation policy. If you do not email to cancel at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled appointment time, payment for the missed lesson is due prior to your next appointment. No exceptions for sickness or weather.
- ◆ Sometimes tot skaters are not mature enough to continue past their first lesson. We will give our professional opinion as to whether you should wait until the child is older or is asking to come back on the ice before scheduling another lesson.
- ◆ When, and if, the instructor feels the tot is physically ready for & mature enough for the group class, the tot will be pro-rated into the current session. (Many tot skaters will need multiple Tot Lessons before they are able to join to group class.)
- ◆ Appointments are limited.
