Fieldstone Show Circuit Rules and Guidelines

- Entries: Please submit entries via email to <http://www.horshowsonline.com/> or email the entry form provided in the prize list to Candice Reece at Candice.Upchurch@yahoo.com Please be sure to include Horse Name, Owner & Rider Name, Classes Entering, Stabling Information, including tack stalls and shavings orders, and horse and rider USHJA numbers. Entries are due by **Tuesday, October 8, 2024**, A \$25 late fee can be applied on entries received later than Wednesday, October 9th at 7:00PM. Stall requests received after 7:00 PM on Wednesday, October 9th, are subject to a stall increase of \$25 per stall.
- Class Fees: All Classes \$20 Day Stall Fee \$35 Stall Fee: \$100 Shavings: Included with stall fee
- Fees: Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$10 per day. An EMT will be on the grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$10 office/\$5 awards fee will be charged a total of \$15 per entry horse/rider combination. A \$5 USHJA Fee will be charged for all entries competing in USHJA divisions/classes. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. **USHJA Outreach memberships are FREE and can be signed up for at the show or online at <https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach>!**
- USHJA Outreach Program: Fieldstone Show Circuit is a recognized USHJA Outreach Affiliate Organization and qualifies for USHJA Outreach points for Zone 7. Read more about the USHJA Outreach program and get your free membership, visit their website at: <https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach>
- Coggins: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be email with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Stalls: Stalls are 12'x12' permanent box stalls and will be available noon Friday through Sunday. A \$35 grounds fee will be charged for any horse not competing. No outside shavings are allowed.
- Arenas: 1 Arena is 150'x 250' and the second arena is 100' x 225' the third arena is 100'x 150', all weather sand footing.
- Schooling: Open schooling will be available Saturday, October 12th, from 12:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. It will also be available Sunday morning from 6:30 a.m. until the times stated on the schedule. If time allows, there will be 15-minute schooling breaks between fence heights.
- Limit Divisions: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.
- Cross entries: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18". Riders in Short Stirrup 18" may only cross-enter into Limit Beginner 18". Riders competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross-enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.
- Awards: All classes receive a first-place Prize and six ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.
- Attire: Formal show attire is required in all classes. Jumper riders are permitted to wear polo shirts. Polo shirts with collars are allowed at shows June-August. No chaps allowed. Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.
- Dogs: NO OUTSIDE DOGS ALLOWED
- FSC Classes: These are Open to any horse/rider combination. They are not recognized by USHJA or NTHJC and do not accumulate points for either organization.
- Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries.
- Management reserves the right to combine or scratch classes/divisions.
- WARNING: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
- RESPONSIBILITY NOTICE: Submission of an entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless show officials and Fieldstone Park management against any claim, demands, costs, and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death, ("Harm"). I AGREE to hold harmless and release the USHJA and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the USHJA or the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the USHJA or the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the USHJA and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.
