IMPACTS OF 2017

OUR MOBILE CLINIC From different communities, FBF Medical Staff have treated 3,700 patients including sexual transmitted diseases and child malnutrition prevention.

EDUCATION 160 children benefited from the school program from different communities.

FOOD PROGRAM 7,351 were fed from our NO ONE STAYS HUNGRY program.

ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM 103 started the program in October all of them are making progress.

SMALL BUSINESS SOLUTION (Ti Machann Program) as we are not receiving funds from any organizations to satisfy our demands, FBF Executive Director funded 15 little merchants to start their own business. And the program is doing well.
