## *An Inside Look from our Residence Manager*

There is a place at Life Haven for every woman to serve. **Our greatest volunteer need presently is in-home volunteers.** The purpose of having someone in the home with the residents is to provide an immediate contact person in case a need arises.

Whether you are working a short shift or an overnight shift the volunteer room is where you will begin your stay in the Life Haven home. **The volunteer room is your personal area while you're serving as an in-home volunteer.** It's a place to pray, read, knit, do schoolwork on the computer, and if you are staying overnight it serves as a bedroom.

While you are in the Life Haven home, **you may spend your time as you choose.** Some ladies prefer to spend the majority of their time with the residents, others prefer to be a quiet, steady presence ready to help if needed. There is no one way to serve in this capacity. The experience will be unique for each individual volunteer.
