Where does the money go that we used to buy our snacks?

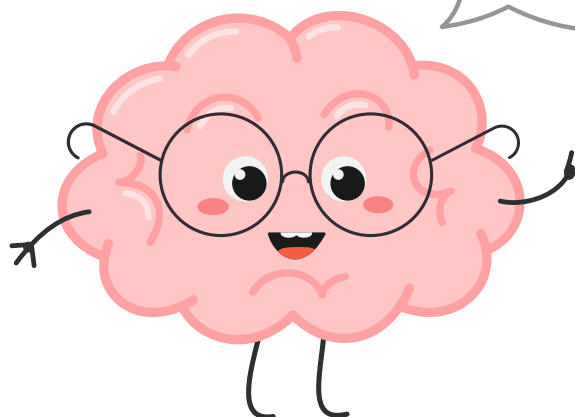
The money goes to you guys, actually. We take the money from the snacks and go buy more snacks. And from our newsletter club, we want to thank you for all these years you've been working here!

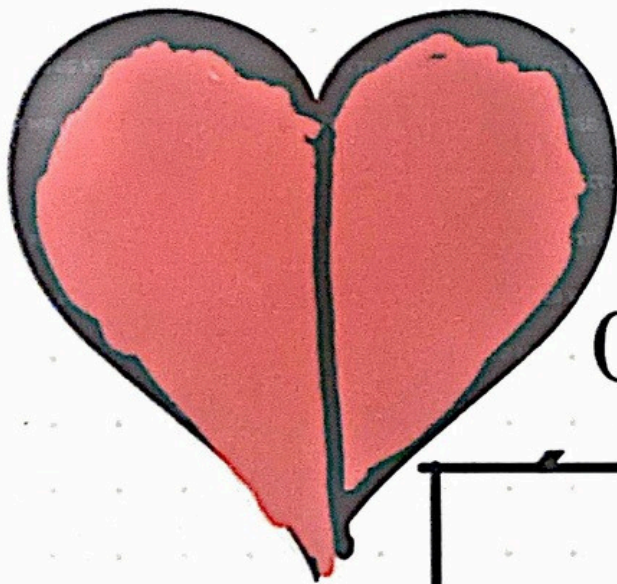

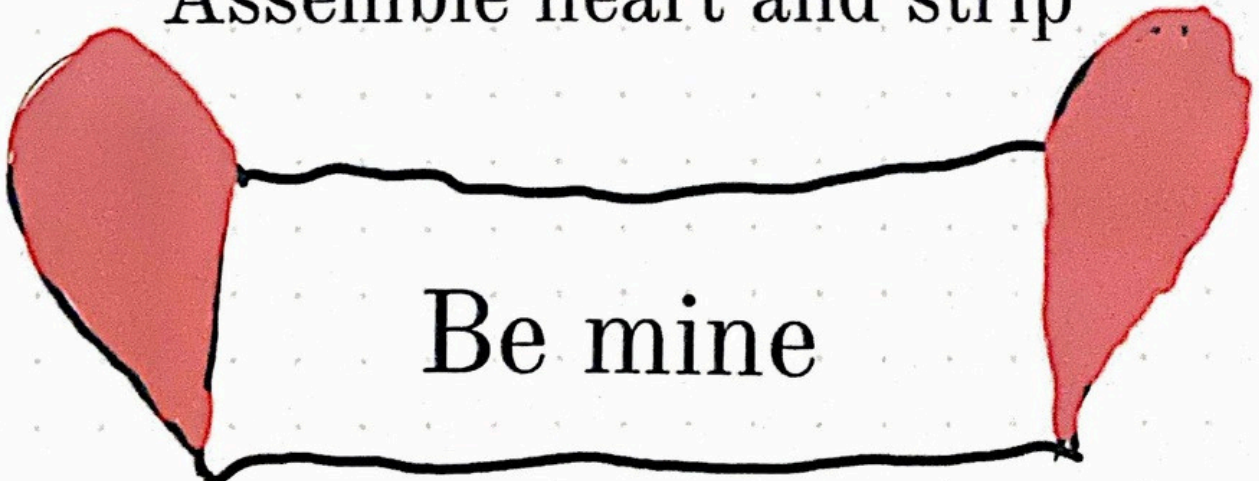
Cut heart in half
