


## **2023-2024 Workshops**

In our second year of empowering families, Children Ready to Learn provided interactive workshops, books, and essential tools to empower parents to use fun and engaging new strategies to develop their children's literacy, math, and social-emotional skills. We engaged parents and caregivers of 4- and 5-year-olds, using the Ready! for Kindergarten curriculum to equip families with the resources they need for their children's success.

### **Workshop Highlights**

- Children Ready to Learn partnered with the Kent School District to offer free workshops, books, toys, and resources to parents of incoming kindergarteners at Panther Lake Elementary School
- We hosted 1 orientation and 3 parent workshops in June and July 2024
- 11 families registered for the workshops
- 9 families attended the workshops
- 77% of families attended all 4 sessions



## 2023-2024 Impact

Our workshops successfully achieved the goal of teaching parents new games and activities that promote early literacy, math, and social-emotional development. Participants received free books, toys, and resources designed to support purposeful play and educational enrichment.

Feedback from parents highlighted the impact of these efforts:

- The workshops were rated "Excellent" for their organization and the quality of information provided.
- The tools and resources distributed were deemed "Very Useful" by attendees.
- Opportunities to connect with other parents were considered "Very Valuable."
- Child-care activities while parents attended the workshops were also rated "Excellent," contributing significantly to children's social-emotional readiness for kindergarten.

Overall, parents reported increased knowledge and confidence in supporting their children's educational journey, underscoring the success of our programs in empowering
