Time Commitment

Operations staff attends field rehearsals daily during the week from 6:30p-8:00p as well as traveling with the band to performances on the weekend. Other times may be necessary outside of field rehearsal to conduct inventory and prepare for performances and travel. Exact schedules are set with the staff upon selection. Students should make sure they do not have evening classes.

Compensation

The internship is **unpaid**. However, students working with the band program are typically provided a book allowance that is added to your bill. All travel related expenses are paid for by the Department of Bands. Required attire is also provided. Operations staff receives field credentials for home and away games to work with the GD staff. Students are required to sign up for MUSI 300 and will receive academic credits/grade for participation.
